



THE BOURGEMASTRE OF THE COMMUNE REPORTED TO THE TEAM THAT THERE HAVE BEEN CASES OF PRESENCE OF UNKNOWN PERSONS AMONG THE HUTU HOUSEHOLD. HOWEVER THE RPA HAVE BEEN TASKED TO CARRY OUT CORDON AND SEARCH AT RANDOM IN THE SECTORS OF THE COMMUNE. NO ARRESTS HAVE BEEN MADE SO FAR IN THIS CONNECTION.
