
Dear Mr. Svensäter,


Dear Jan,

The purpose of this letter is to follow up on previous discussions with Marie Tuma and formally invite you to deliver the 2013 Anna Lindh Lecture at the Raoul Wallenberg Institute and Lund University on the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2013.

As you know from your previous involvement as former chairperson of the Anna Lindh Memorial Foundation, the Institute, in 2005, took the initiative of highlighting human rights matters through an annual public lecture to be given by a distinguished scholar, politician, diplomat or international to-level civil servant. In order to pay homage to Anna Lindh, her memory and what she represents, the lecture is named after her – the Anna Lindh lecture. - 2010 Dr. Hans Blix, former Director General of IAEA and former Swedish Minister for Foreign Affairs
- 2011 Mrs. Hina Jilani, Director of AGHDS Legal Aid Clinic Cell and former UN Special Rapporteur on Human Rights Defenders
- 2012 Dr. Danilo Türk, former President of the Republic of Slovenia


