Following figures obtained from IGO are believed approximate and all are dissident persons accounting to no authority with the exception of the Polish and Yugoslav Military Poles, 110, all ex consular diplomatic and government officials, 110 working with Polish Red Cross, 240 employed by British Military camp in Egypt, 120 Yugoslavs at Elarish military camp and 230 Yugoslav Military on guard duties Suez Canal area all of whom will become dissident if discharged. UNRRA has no refugees outside of camps.
