1. Reference your letter No 5000.1(HAC)/A/1 dated 22 Sep 95. The recce team from this Coy and representatives of Milobs sector 5A visited the site concerned on 06 Oct 95.

2. The recce team noted that the existing bridge is a 50 ft double - single Bailey bridge at Nyamutera. The existing bridge is presently resting on stone masonry abutment. One of the abutment is in very bad shape. This abutment requires urgent attention. The second abutment has also developed a crack, which in due course of time will be a cause of concern.

3. The details of abutment are as under :-

- (a) Width - 8.0 m
- (b) Height - 4.0 m (above water level)
- (c) Length - 5.0 m

4. As an immediate solution to the problem, it is suggested that one bay each may be added on both the sides of the bridge. This will enable the bridge to rest on hard surface. Latter on the abutment can be repaired. As a second option the bridge should be delaunched and to be launched again after repairing/constructing abutments.



1. As you know, the last Saturday I went to visit Misericorde Orphanage in Cyangugu recently relocated, from APEEDUC (Kamembe) to Novicat Cyangugu.

2. It was for me a great pleasure to present your gifts to the children and I am here to say again, thank you for your cooperation.

3. Regarding some observations made during the visit, I detected some things that is necessary to correct, for sure we can't do all but is good to know and perhaps some improvement could be found.

4. About food, attached is a copy of a letter sent to WFP, they promised to do something.


5. About accommodation, the place is good and easy to clean, ventilated and seem to be sufficient for the children, but each 5 or 6 sleep in 3 mattresses, there are no bedsheets and with some mattresses covered in plastic, the children have to sleep with their skin in contact with this covers getting up totally wet with the consequent danger for their health.

6. Regarding health cares and hygiene, there are no mosquito nets and no beds, the children do not wash their hands before eating and do not have cutlery. They eat sitting on the floor or standing in front of the few tables. The kitchen is so precarious.

7. About the skin illness they have SCABIES and fungus. Some of them were suffering from malaria and I saw them very thin in general in relation with my last time at the orphanage (20 April).

8. The orphanage is sponsored by Medecins du Monde, which background is excellent and also worked very hard in Nyamesheke and Kibogora orphanage, but some additional help is required.

9. Thank you very much and congratulations for your sensibility and silent work.
