Have just seen text my last telegram to you from Elisabethville and apologise for it being badly garbled. You may have gathered that the point being made was that any judgement on Maitra's remarks depended upon the context and nature of conversations from which alleged interview was contrived. I did not hand Figaro's message directly to Clos because he did not appear again, but it was given to Bulloch of the Daily Telegraph in a sealed envelope, since Bulloch claimed he was meeting Clos in Elisabethville that afternoon. I am sending herewith text of an extract from a letter sent by the US Consul at Elisabethville to Senator Dodd. This is, of course, not repeat not for publication, but on a private basis you may show it to the editorial board to support my contention. Quote from letter dated December 24 follows: QUOTE I recall that you had several conversations with Colonel Maitra, the commanding officer of the Gurkha battalion during your stay in Katanga. He tells me that he was able to debunk a number of "Gurkha atrocity stories" to your apparent satisfaction. I thought you might be interested in the Colonel's present popularity. He was outstanding during the recent fighting in rescuing beleaguered civilians, and he was principally responsible for the safe passage of the bulk of Americans in Elisabethville through fighting areas to the safety of the airport, from which they departed in the nick of time. Since the cessation of firing (this is not a formal cease fire, as you probably know), Maitra has worked 16 to 20 hours a day helping restore water and electricity, sparing civilians from pillaging by Balubas and others, and taking in refugees (Europeans included) who have lost their homes. I know that he has risked his life repeatedly in these endeavors. Belgian residents here are particularly appreciative of his efforts and are talking about arranging for a Belgian decoration for him. UNQUOTE End of quote from US Consul's letter.

SITUATION REPORT. The former Provincial President of ORIENTALE, Mr MANZIKALA, who is currently under UN protection at STAN, tried to commit suicide 30 Nov. He was saved by the guards and is now better mentally. LUNDULA arrived KINDU 1230Z hours 1 Dec and conferred with local authorities. Details of conference are awaited here. At BUKAVU on night 30 Nov, KHAZOUN (ONUC CAO) and MILLER (ONUC staff member) were arrested by ANC. At the ANC HQ, where they were detained, the ANC demanded of their officer to kill the two. The officer pleaded for them and saved them but they were warned that ONUC cars approaching ANC HQ would be shot at without warning. The Gend in the whole of KATANGA are reported to be on a "General Alert". One Gend Company was deployed near the Church area in the vicinity of the LIDO at E'VILLE 1830B hours 30 Nov. Villagers and priests are leaving the area. One heavy gun was placed in the church and ammunition for it is being dumped. ONUC E'VILLE is taking up the question of the withdrawal of this Company and the gun, by peaceful means, with the KATANGA Government. A UN OTTER aircraft was fired upon and hit (one bullet in body of airplane) by the Gend near KABEYA MAJI (25 miles North of NYUNZU) 1 Dec. Capt Roger MCCORLEY, 35 IRISH Bn, ^{who} was in the plane was slightly injured in the left wrist and knee. The aircraft landed safely at A'VILLE. The Gend are reported to have a standing patrol of 30 men at road junction MITWABA MULONGO-MANONO, and road A'VILLE-MANONO. This is presumably to prevent ANC advance/infiltration.

A UN patrol report states that villagers in village KANTEBEE (7 km from MANONO on road MANONO-A'VILLE) have thinned out due to harassment by the Gend. Local sources at A'VILLE indicate that the Gend post near KABEYA HAJI has been reinforced. Some armed Gend were observed moving in area MITWOBE (10 km outside KAMINA) at 1115 B hours 30 Nov. The Gend disappeared on approach of UN patrol that was sent to search the area. Situation at E'VILLE still tense.

- A. I cannot tell you that.
- Q. Who did the briefing?
- A. I cannot tell you the name.
- Q. Were they white or Congolese?
- A. Some were white and some were black.
- Q. What did your mission specify?
- A. They told me that a man was to be executed and that's all.
- Q. Did they give you the name of the man?

A. No, they simply said that a person who was to be met at the airport was to be executed..... The person I was ordered to execute may have been Lumumba, I do not know. I had already shot him when a few days after they published a story that Lumumba had escaped..... The person who is alleged to have escaped in a black car was a decoy.

Q. Is there not a possibility that the person you have executed may have been a decoy?

A. Yes, it is possible but I do not think so.

Q. Could you take me to the place where you executed this person?

A. Yes I could, it is on the road to Jadotville.

Q. What did you shoot this person with?

A. With a 9-mm. pistol.

Q. What happened to the body?

A. I do not know and I do not think you will ever find the body.

Q. You could not have just left the body there.

A. No, we wrapped the body in a blanket, put it in the boot of the car and about one or two km. down the road I was transferred into a waiting army jeep, I do not know what happened to the body. I took the order in writing..... I have never killed a man unless the order to do so is given in writing.

Q. Did you get the order in writing when you were told to execute Lumumba?

A. Yes, I took the order in writing.

Q. Did that order say that you will execute Lumumba?

14 VA 263

A. No, the order did not mention Lumumba's name but that I was to execute a prisoner who was to be met at the airport. That order was signed.

Q. Signed by whom?

A. I cannot tell you.

Q. Do you still have it?

A. Yes, it is still with me, not here on my person, but in a small steel box somewhere in Katanga. I can even show you that when I leave the Congo. You can only see it but you can't keep it. UNQUOTE

2. Chalmers also gave a description of the route from Eville airport to the house where the deed was committed and described the prisoner as having been "in a bad state as a result of the beatings he had previously received, and was helped out of the car".⁽³⁾ He further referred to an earlier plan to carry Lumumba to Luputa in South Kasai by plane, which was abandoned because the Kalonjists had heard it and would have killed Lumumba themselves and "they" could not afford that. Chalmers refused to explain who "they" were.

3. Clear impression created by Chalmers on our Military Information officers as well as interrogating officers is that he is mentally unstable and eager for publicity. His background clearly indicates that he is a professional mercenary who had served in French Foreign Legion and had fought for Castro in Cuba. He came to Congo in August 1960, joined Katangese Gendarmerie in January 1961 and was arrested in Manono on 28 August 1961. He is a willing talker and seems to be boastful of his "achievement" as related above.

(2)
4. We have strongest reservations regarding his credibility. He has strong reasons for wanting to return to Eville to get personal possessions and attend to personal affairs before repatriation and therefore may be trying to take us on a wild goose chase. During interrogation he persistently refused to mention by whom the order of execution was signed but stated that document was in a steel box "somewhere in Katanga" and that he would show the document to ONUC officials if he is permitted to retrieve the box with other personal effects. His description of alleged scene of crime could well be result of newspaper descriptions and stories which circulated freely during the months following Lumumba's death and cannot be regarded as substantiation of his confession.

5. After careful consideration of content of statements, as well as of assessment of his truthfulness, we came to conclusion that his testimony was unreliable without further testing. However, we were prepared to take him to Eville under escort and give him opportunity of retrieving his possessions including steel box with alleged document. His interrogation was completed only on 14 September by which time the military situation in Eville prevented us from carrying out this plan. Even after cease-fire political and military tension was such that we ran the serious risk of Chalmers escaping while in Eville. After exchange of prisoners was completed and Protocole of cease-fire had been ratified, we had decided to take Chalmers to Eville but his attempted escape on Saturday night confirmed our belief that his whole story was nothing more than a ruse to enable him to get to Eville where his escape might have been more successfully attempted. It is now more than likely that he will deny any knowledge of Lumumba's death as we are told by British

Consul, with whom he had been in contact for short period after his escape on Saturday night, that he fears the international inquiry into crime to which he had confessed.

6. You will also note the risk involved in sending Chalmers in present circumstances to Geneva since there is no authority for us to detain him in Switzerland or elsewhere en route and it is not impossible that in present frame of mind he may make another bid to make good his escape. It is also most likely that he may be unwilling to testify. ⁽¹⁾ Commission may wish to decide for itself in light of all these circumstances. If it decides that Chalmers should be interrogated afresh in Leo before despatch to Geneva please cable without delay decision of Commission as well as interrogatory considered desirable. Pending such information from you we will hold Chalmers and inform British Consul, who has pressed for early repatriation of Chalmers in view of Saturday's incident, that we are holding him pending Commission's views.

Re your 248. As requested by Commission Adoula has been informed by ~~K~~hiari of necessity for obtaining early reply. A reply will be forthcoming before long but you appreciate that Government is just now pre-occupied with Katanga problem. Adoula, Gizenga and Bomboko returned from Belgrade only on Saturday. As soon as we receive any information regarding Government's decision you will be informed.

Information you give about Weber is apparently based on misunderstanding of Knecht's statements. Weber was never adviser to Lumumba but was adviser to Tshombe and Katanga Government. ONUC at no time sent Weber to Elisabethville. In the general exodus of Belgian advisers from Katanga last month Weber left for Belgium and is no longer in the Congo. Please inform members of above facts.
