SUBJECT: REGISTRATION OF D. PS. INCLUDING PHOTOGRAPHING.

Dr. Gusmano from the Office of Dr. Migliori of the Ministry of the Interior, called at my office late yesterday evening reference the inclusion of Folio di Soggiorno verification numbers in our picture-taking in connection with the registration of D.Ps.

It was pointed out to Dr. Gusmano that since the Folio di Soggiorno numbers were incomplete no real purpose would be served in including them on the photograph. I further pointed out that the major question of determining the position of D.Ps. and refugees in Italy had yet to be decided. This was a matter that would be undoubtedly taken up by the I.R.O. Preparatory Commission when it met with the Italian Government to consider the status of D.Ps in this Country.

It was agreed by Dr. Gusmano that it would be just as well if our registration and picture-taking remain exclusively a means by which we would control the D.P. strength for ration issue identification purposes. Dr. Gusmano stated that he would explain our position to Dr. Migliori.

Dr. Gusmano left my office indicating complete accord with our position.

SUBJECT: CAMP SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT NEEDS:

1. Reference the supply and equipment requisitioning procedure which requires Field Units to consider these needs on the 15th of each month for the period covered by the ensuing month, Camp Directors and D.P. Field Officers will communicate by telephone, to be confirmed by cable and or memorandum, with Rome Headquarters on requests to cover particular supply and or equipment needs that were not included in the regular monthly requisition.

(Of course, Field personnel responsible for the preparation of requisition will, in consultation with their programming staff members, endeavor to include in their requisition all the foreseeable items and services as required for the ensuing month in order to avoid emergencies.)

2. Should emergencies develop please deal directly with this Headquarters. If the request covers items and services that we do not have available, the Headquarters Supply Office will concern itself to negotiate with AJDC or any other agency, should that be found necessary.

3. In conclusion, no Field Officer may negotiate directly with Field Personnel of other agencies on any matter that concerns UNRRA, particularly where equipment and supplies are concerned, unless prior authority and clearance has been effected by this Headquarters with the Rome H.Q. office of the agency with which we are dealing.

4. Please ensure that this statement is clearly understood by all members of your staff, including Voluntary Agency Personnel.

5. Your Camp Committee is to be informed of our policy and procedure as outlined in this memorandum.

6. We are sending a copy of this memorandum to the Headquarters of AJDC requesting that our position be made clear to their Field Personnel.

7. Please acknowledge receipt and understanding of this memorandum.

Subject: POLICY STATEMENT - INFORMATION TO U.S. CONSULATES

1. The following will serve you as guidance in all cases where U.S. Consular Offices approach you in order to obtain information on displaced persons under your care:

- a) No information will be given without the consent of the individual concerned.
- b) With the consent of the D.P. in question, you are authorized to give confidential information on:
 - (i) State of health
 - (ii) Communicable diseases
 - (iii) V.D.
 - (iv) Delinquency record
- c) No information will be given which involves possible discrimination relating to race, religion or political views.
- d) In cases where the D.P. does not consent to your onforwarding confidential information as outlined in para. (a), you are, however, authorized to notify the U.S. Consulate to that effect.

2. Copies of all correspondence pertaining to the above will be forwarded to the Chief, D.P. Operations (Italy) - copy to Director, Division of Registration & Resettlement.

3. The American Consular Authorities have been informed of this policy statement.
