



DATE: 11 September 1995

1. Yesterday the Prefect of Gitarama requested us for assistance in moving scholar materials from Gitarama Town to some communes of this Prefecture (see Annex A for details).
2. Previously we also received some other requests for transportation, namely:
 - (1) Nyabikenke Bourgmestre's request (see Annex B) for transporting of three tons of fertilizers from Kigali to Nyabikenke Commune (7292);
 - (2) transporting of food from Kigali to Nyakabanda Commune (6597) for the benefit of "Groupe Scolaire";
 - (3) Runda Commune Bourgmestre's request to transport building material for housing construction from Sholi Sector (9379) to the Commune Office (9882);
 - (4) moving building material from one location to another within the Commune of Nyabikenke (7292) for the benefit of Nyabikenke branch of "Association de Parents pour la Scolarisation".
3. We have to ask you for consideration of these requests and making arrangements for providing transportation means.
4. Since some of the cargoes are in the stocks in Kigali, it seems to be reasonable to use the trip of the trucks from Kigali to Gitarama for transporting those cargoes. For that purpose the applicants should send their representatives to Kigali for accompanying their cargoes. Please notify us of your preparations in good time to let us make necessary arrangements with the local officials.
5. I am waiting for your reply.

Dear Sir, the Responsible of Humanitarian Assistance

Following your visit to the "Development Center of Kabuga" in Taba Commune, Prefecture of Bitarama, you are aware that the urgent interest/priority of the region (as far as current humanitarian tasks are concerned) is to have a transit road.

Among our projects we can mention the following:

Health Center, Sewing training school for girls, school for professional brick kilns (fabrication of bricks) for our projects, assistance to orphans of Taba and Shyorongi Communes, welding and carpentry workshop and supply of drinking water. Therefore there is a requirement of improvement of the road Muyenzi - Cyogo - Kabuga (13 kms in whole). This will

facilitate the carrying out of all the projects necessary for the welfare of the local population. Notice that this project was stopped by the war (see the attached note concerning the road)

~~Due to the importance of that road~~

When we came back to Rwanda after the war, in Last October, we carried out a lot of work which cost us 951.345 RWF (salaries, various materials and transport, see the attached note), it's worth mentioning that we did this because of the importance of the road.

We would like to pursue the tasks but this would be difficult in case we are not assisted. It is difficult for us to rent a lorry/truck because the transport price is very expensive for us.

In order to go on carrying out these important tasks related to "Humanitarian Assistance" we require the following: 1. Lorry/Truck

- a) for the transportation of laterite to 6 kms from the road.
- b) for the transportation of timbers already existing before the war for the repair of 4 small bridges.
- c) for the transportation of roughstones/rubb so as to end the tasks concerning small bridges.

2) A small levelling machine to compact the soil (grader or compactor)

On our behalf we undertake to pay the salaries of 50 workers who will load the truck, carry out other various tasks and 6 masons and their 10 helpers (assistants). Also, I would also like to point out here that we have a well experienced supervisor of works and that we will be able to buy cement and iron bars for the achievement of some works by ourselves.





SUBJECT : PLANNING OF HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

1. As I explained at the Monthly Humanitarian Meeting on Fri 15 Sep 95, you are requested to submit to HAC before 27 Sep 95 your proposed plan of Humanitarian Assistance for the period 1st October - 31 December 1995 for CHAO's approval.
2. These assistance must consist of the following:
 - a. Assistance that can be provided with available resources within the sector.
 - b. Assistance that is beyond the capability of the sector and requires UNAMIR resources.
3. In determining these assistance, one would have to consider his priorities in view of the limitations of UNAMIR resources. Example of priorities may be as follows:
 - a. Orphans
 - b. Widows
 - c. Returnees
 - d. Health & Education
 - e. Minor repairs.
4. It should be noted that since UNAMIR has scarce resources for humanitarian activities the following should not be included:
 - a. Assistance to organizations which have available resources ie. UNHCR, WFP UNICEF etc.
 - b. Assistance involving Brown & Roots labour.
 - c. Assistance involving supply of generators, water supply and the building of baily bridges.
5. It must be understood that UNAMIR is not capable of providing all the necessary assistance to the Rwandese Government in view of the fact that it has limited resources. You are therefore asked to be cautious in the drawing of the proposed plan.
6. A careful planning is necessary to make an accurate selection of targets and to direct the efforts and completion of tasks to where they are most needed.

7. A specimen of what is required from all Sector Hum Offrs is attached as Annex A.

1. The generator at the Kibuye hospital does not work and is in urgent need of repair. This week we have experienced power outages frequently which resulted in unnecessary loss of services and could have resulted in unnecessary loss of life. For example this week a cesarian delivery was underway at night when the power went out and the delivery was completed by candle light. In addition perishable medications and medical test equipment require a reliable uninterrupted source of power.

2. This hospital has attempted to have this generator repaired or replaced through their normal administrative channels without success for the past one year. MSF and SDR are the NGO's which run this hospital.

3. It is requested that UNAMIR provide a replacement 10 kw generator immediately and the technical support required to get back up power running. The existing generator has been inspected by MSF technical services section but they did not determine exactly what was required to repair the existing generator. They expect it will need a major overhaul and may be beyond economical repair. Technical support from UNAMIR is also requested to attempt to repair the old generator after the new generator is in place.

4. This generator is a high priority in the Kibuye prefecture and if UNAMIR could complete this project it would provide an excellent service to our citizens and secondly improve our credibility in supporting our new mandate and improve our relations in this prefecture. This generator has been unserviceable for too long and action is required immediately.

1. The Humanitarian Team of Sector 1A had recently attended a meeting with NGOs at Nyamata, there were two requests for assistance recieved from them. The details of these are as follows:

(a). Provision of Water at Ngenda Prison. It was requested that UNAMIR assists in the provision of a water bladder and its resupply of water twice a week for Ngenda Prison, which houses approximately 170 inmates. There is currently no means of supplying water to the prisoners except by their relatives. A 10000 ltr bladder being refilled twice a week would meet the requirement.

(b). Improvement of Tracks. It has been requested by the reps of UNHCR and Human Rights that a 100 yards stretch of the road South of the bridge over Nyabarongo River (GR 0972) needs to be repaired on priority as this stretch of road becomes extremely slippery with rains. This has been verified on ground and it is strongly recommended for consideration by HAC at UNAMIR HQs. There are approximately 1000 vehicles of UNHCR and other NGOs using this road per week, this figure is likely to increase with more returnees coming in from Burundi at Rutete and other areas.

2. It is requested that the above mentioned points be favourably considered for action. Decision taken on the same may please be communicated for our subsequent follow up action.

Dear Lt. Col. Fox,

Further to our conversation of 30 August, please find enclosed a copy of our Summary of Activities and Priority Requirements document. I would be grateful if you could let me know whether UNAMIR could assist UNHCR with the following items:

Tents: As you know, we are expanding Nkamira transit centre to double its capacity. Present capacity is 1,500. We are also opening a transit centre at Byumba town for a capacity of 1,000 people. We wonder whether UNAMIR could assist us with tents, which could be used either to accommodate people to the above-mentioned capacity, or as health post or warehouses at the centres.

Water bladders and water tankers: As per the attached document, we would need 10 water bladders (of 45,000 litres preferably) for the existing transit centres and entry points in Western Rwanda. Likewise, we would need 5 water tankers (18,000 litres preferably) to supplement our two-tanker fleet.

Generators: If at all possible, we wonder whether UNAMIR would be in a position to give UNHCR four generators for Gisenyi, Cyangugu, Butare and Nyagatare (preferred voltage 5 to 10 KVA). If it is not possible to receive them as donations, we would be grateful to borrow them for several months.

Bulldozer: We are very grateful for your positive response on our request for a bulldozer to help expand Nkamira transit centre. The bulldozer arrived at the end of last week and I understand from my colleagues that the ground was being cleared over the week end.

For your information, please find enclosed a note for the file on our conversation of 30 August.

Thank you very much for your continued assistance to UNHCR operations.

UNHCR SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES AND PRIORITY REQUIREMENTS

1. ENTRY POINTS

A) Existing:
Rusizi 1 and 2 (Cyangugu)

Basic emergency facilities -water and sanitation and emergency distribution of food- were set up at border entry points for arriving returnees awaiting transport to transit centres.

2. TRANSIT CENTRES

Two transit centres were already functional before the current emergency in Gisenyi (Nkamira, opened in November 1994, with a capacity of 1,500 people), and Cyangugu (Nyagatare, opened in October 1994 with a capacity of 3,000).

With the onset of the emergency and mindful of the possibilities of further influxes, UNHCR has already begun to expand border point and transit centre capacities in both Gisenyi and Cyangugu. In order to facilitate spontaneous returns, UNHCR is also rehabilitating the dirt road near Gisenyi entry point.

In Gisenyi, Nkamira (capacity: 1,500) is being expanded to double its capacity. UNHCR has also prepared the College (capacity: 10,000) and the Methodist University facilities; they will be opened after local authorities give permission.

In Cyangugu, the expansion of Nyagatare transit centre cannot be considered an option; a new transit centre is being set up at Bugarama. At Nyarushishi basic health and sanitation services have been set up and tents prepositioned in preparation for an influx.

Implementing partners for transit centres:

- Nkamira: Coopi (administration, water and sanitation, distribution of relief items); MSF-B and Merlin (health)
- College: Coopi (building, administration, water and sanitation, distribution of relief items); MSF-B and Merlin (health)
- Methodist University: Inter-SOS
- Nyagatare: IRC (water and sanitation); MDM (health)
- Nyarushishi: Concern (administration and distribution); IRC (water and sanitation); MSF-Spain (health), MSF-France (shelter)
- Bugarama: LWF (building, administration), MDM (health and building health structures)

3. TRANSPORT

NOTE FOR THE FILE

Re: Planning for emergency - Conversation with Lt. Col. Tomas Fox, Chief of Humanitarian Assistance Office, UNAMIR, 30 August 1995

1. Trucks:

UNAMIR has a fleet of 50 trucks. Most are 5 ton trucks. Thirty of these were used in the emergency in Cyangugu and Giseny, while the other 20 are being used throughout the country in humanitarian assistance operations, such as assistance to WFP, etc. UNHCR can count on the thirty trucks now. Should the repatriation start again we could also request the 20 remaining trucks (though of course all other uses of the truck will suffer). Lt. Col. Fox will liaise with his logistics officer on this. One issue raised by Lt. Col. Fox was fuel - current stocks at the rate transport was done last week would suffice only for three days.

Could we use these trucks, which are at our disposal, to preposition NFIs or transport any other items needed in Cyangugu and Gisenyi now?

2. Other assets (tents, generators, etc.)

I discussed with Lt. Col. Fox other items, such as tents, generators, vehicles, water bladders and tankers, combat rations and medical supplies, based on the letter that was drafted by MacKay Wolff dated 15 August (never sent as it needs rewording).

UNAMIR has shipped much of its materiel for other operations already, and Lt. Col. Fox said it is very little what they can give. We agreed however that I would send him a letter enquiring about those items, but indicating quantities and if possible locations of where these materiel would be positioned.

Tents: there are very few; he said that as a big concession three or four could be given.

Generators, water bladders and tankers can be a possibility.

Vehicles: they have no light vehicles that they could provide.

With regard to medical supplies, he referred to other NGOs, WHO, etc., which have also medicines, indicating that UNAMIR has very little.

3. Bulldozers

Lt. Col. Fox will send a bulldozer to Nkamira to assist in the expansion. This point will be referred to in the letter.

4. Commune rehabilitation

Lt. Col. Fox is very concerned at the absorption capacity of the communes, in particular the issue of land tenure and property. He will send his MILOBs teams to the communes (sector commanders will speak to the Prefets, while milobs teams will go to the communes) to gather information about free land available and other immediate needs in the communes. He will pass on their assessment to us.

1. Reference A is a letter sent to UNAMIR HQ by the WFP organization requesting that 200 cartons of combat rations be provided for distribution at refugee entry points near Gisenyi. As already discussed at reference B, the provision of combat rations to non UNAMIR agencies is problematic. There are presently insufficient stocks within theatre to provide rations for all of the refugees which could re-enter Rwanda. We have nevertheless recently again provided combat rations to assist in the recent influx of refugees from Zaire and Burundi. This situation was already discussed during the last UHAAG and the committee was unanimous in our resolve to stem similar requests since the provision of food to refugees fell within the purview of other UN and NGO agencies, not UNAMIR's.
2. Action addressees are therefore requested to inform the WFP of our inability to assist them in this request and to pass on the UHAAG's decision to them. With the potential for future mass repatriations of refugees to Rwanda, it would be appropriate for both them and similar organisations to initiate appropriate measures to obtain alternate sources of rations if required. Should you require additional information, do not hesitate to contact me.


