THREW THE FIRST GRENADE. ZAMBATT'S DECISION NOT TO USE FORCE AT THE DISTRIBUTION CENTER WAS A WISE ONE IN ORDER TO PREVENT MORE BLOODSHED. ZAMBIAN PL REACTED IN A PROFESSIONAL MANNER.

11. LOC: MUSANGE (GS 52 47)

12. ZAMBIAN STATEMENT BY PL LDR : ON 10 NOV 94 1330 HRS ONE RPA PL ARRIVED AT MUSANGE. RPA EXPLAINED TO THE PEOPLE TO LEAVE THEIR HUTS AND TO GO HOME. RPA CONFIRMED THIS EXPLANATION WITH GUNSHOTS AND THE PEOPLE DISAPPEARED. RPA AT THIS TIME BURNED DOWN 10 TO 15 HUTS, KILLED 6 PERS AND WOUNDED 3. ZAMBIANS TRANSPORTED THE INJURED TO KADUHA HOSPITAL. ON 11 NOV 94 THE SAME RPA SOLDIERS ARRIVED AT 2200 HRS, STARTED TO LOOT AND SHOOT AND BURNED DOWN THE WHOLE CAMP. 7 PEOPLE KILLED. AROUND 50 % OF THE CAMP POPULATION HAVE MEANWHILE LEFT FOR KADUHA.

13. RPA STATEMENT BY CAPT ALOYS NTALE: ON 10 NOV 94 RPA AT KADUHA WERE INFORMED ABOUT A RPA RAIDING PARTY AT MUSANGE. RPA KADUHA WAS NOT ABLE TO GO THERE DUE TO LACK OF FUEL. ON 11 NOV 94 THIS RAIDING PARTY SHOWED UP AGAIN AND BURNED DOWN THE WHOLE CAMP. RPA KADUHA IS BLAMING A UNIT FROM GITARAMA PREFECTURE TO HAVE CARRIED OUT THOSE RAIDS. RPA KADUHA CONDEMNS THOSE ACTS OF VIOLENCE WHICH ARE NOT IN COMMON WITH RPA POLICY. RPA KADUHA INFORMED THAT THIS RAIDING PARTY COMES FROM GITWE (GS 64 53) AND REQUESTS UNAMIR TO INVESTIGATE. MILOBS CONTINUED FROM KADUHA TO MUSANGE ACCOMPANIED BY SGT SHARIEF JUMA NTAGANZWA (RPA). AT MUSANGE MILOBS FOUND THE WHOLE CAMP BURNED DOWN WITH FEW PEOPLE AROUND. THE SGT EXPLAINED THE PEOPLE TO LEAVE THE AREA TO KADUHA FOR SECURITY REASONS. PEOPLE AGREED AND ZAMBATT IS WILLING TO PROVIDE TRANSPORT. RPA WILL PROVIDE SOLDIERS TO GUARANTEE FURTHER SECURITY.
