

THE HEADQUARTERS, WAS ASSISTED BY A DETACHMENT FROM THE FORCE ENGINEER COY TO INVESTIGATE THE EXPLOSION WHICH SERIOUSLY INJURED A SEVEN YEAR OLD BOY YESTERDAY AT THE INVESTIGATION SITE OF THE INTERNATIONAL. (REF PARA 9 OF SITREP 359). IT WAS ESTABLISHED THAT THE BOY WAS PLAYING AROUND WITH SOME SORT OF HAND GRENADE OR PART OF A LAND MINE HE FOUND IN THE VICINITY, WHEN THE EXPLOSION OCCURRED. IT WAS NOT POSSIBLE TO GO FIRM ON THE TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE BUT IT WAS EVIDENT THAT THE BOY WAS HANDLING IT ABOVE THE GROUND WHEN IT EXPLODED. IT WAS NOT POSSIBLE TO INTERVIEW THE BOY SINCE HE IS STILL IN A BAD SHAPE. THE ENGINEER DET SEARCHED 3 (THREE) SELECTED MASS GRAVE SITES FOR SIMILAR EXPLOSIVES AND FOUND THEM SAFE. THEY PLANNED COMING TO PROD OTHER SELECTED AREAS WHEN THE TRIBUNAL PERSONNEL RETURN FROM BREAK.

THE BOY WAS OUT IN THE FIELD AROUND HOME S JEAN (QT 270717), KIBUYE, AT AROUND 0800HRS WITH HIS MOTHER, PICKING FUEL WOOD WHEN THE EXPLOSION OCCURRED. 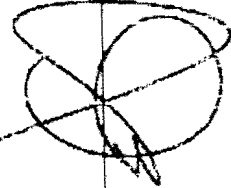





LE PRÉFET, HOWEVER ABSENT COULD NOT BE SOLICITED FOR A SAUF-CONDUIT TO ASSURE THE MOVEMENT OF MSF PERSONNEL FROM KIBUYE TO THEIR OTHER AREAS OF INTEREST IN THE PREFECTURE WHERE THEY WOULD LIKE TO GO AND INFORM AND PAY-OFF THEIR LOCAL WORKERS. THE SOUS-PRÉFET WAS THERE, HOWEVER THE MSF ADMINISTRATOR WAS NOT SATISFIED WITH HIS METHOD OF SECURITY WHICH WAS, SHE CLAIMS, TANTAMOUNT TO HAVING A GUARD POSTED ON THEM TO WATCH AND CONTROL THEIR EVERY MOVEMENT WITH A







A LETTER, WITH ACCIDENT REPORT AND STATEMENTS, HAS BEEN TRANSMITTED BY FAX TO SOO FOR HIS CONSIDERATION AND PROMPT ACTION.

10. SECTOR COMMANDERS ASSESSMENT THE THEFT OF OUR WHIP ANTENNA AND INCREASED TRAINING LEVEL OF THE LOCAL RPA, AND THE REQUESTS FROM M. LE PRÉFET ARE FURTHER INDICATORS OF THE PRESSURE FELT BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND RPA ABOUT A PROBABLE UNAMIR WITHDRAWAL.

GEN SECUR CONDITION IN THE AREA. ON THE WAY, THE TEAM STOPPED AT THE BIRAMBO SOUS-PREFECTURE (QT 4764) AND THE BWAKIRA COMMUNE OFFICE (QT 4961). THE BOURGMEISTRE OF BWAKIRA COMMUNE WAS NOT THERE, BUT THEY SPOKE TO THE SOUS-PRÉFET WITH A VIEW TO CONFIRM SOME ISSUES REPORTED BY THE TEAM ON 24 NOV 95 (OUR SITREP 323 REFERS). HE CONFIRMED THAT THE NUMBER OF PRISONERS TRANSFERRED TO THE KIBUYE PRISON TO BE TWENTY-ONE (21). HOWEVER, HE WAS RELUCTANT IN CONFIRMING WHETHER OR NOT, MALE VISITORS ARE ALLOWED AT THE SOUS-PREFECTURE CACHOT. ON THE ISSUE OF TOLLS AT THE MARKET, THE SOUS-PRÉFET SAID THOSE OWNING SHOPS AT THE MARKET HAVE TO PAY THEIR TOLL ONLY TO THE COMMUNAL POLICE. THE TEAM ADVISED THAT HE MAKES SOME EFFORT TO CHECK THE EXCESSES OF THE LOCAL RPA IN THAT REGARD. THE TEAM THEN PROCEEDED TO MUHORORO (QT 5062), WHERE THE LOCALS CLAIMED THAT FIVE (5) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED ON THURSDAY, 24 NOV 95 BY THE BWAKIRA COMMUNAL POLICE FOR ALLEGEDLY COMMITTING GENOCIDE AND ARE SAID TO PRESENTLY BE IN THE BWAKIRA COMMUNE CACHOT. TWO (2) OF THEM, MESSRS. NZAGAHIMANA KUHONDE AND MUYANGO, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FORMERS WIFE, ARE SAID TO BE IN THERE. SHE ALSO CLAIMS THAT WOMEN ARE NOT EVEN ALLOWED TO SEE THE MEN: THE WOMEN BRING FOOD IN A PLATE THAT IS TAKEN BY A GUARD WHO THEN BRINGS BACK THE PLATE EMPTY. AT THE OBJECTIVE, CYANYANZA SECTEUR, THE LOCALS THERE IN THE MUJOJOYO CELLULE (QT 5466) CLAIMED THAT THE SITUATION THERE IS CALM AND THAT THERE HAVE BEEN NO ARRESTS IN SOME TIME.

(2) ONE TEAM (D) WENT BY RD TO MUBUGA HEALTH CENTRE (QT 2463) IN THE GITESI COMMUNE. THE AIM OF THE PTL WAS TO TALK TO THE LOCAL POPULATION AND ASSESS THE GEN SECUR CONDITION AND DELIV HUMANITARIAN SUPPLIES WITH THE A/HUM O (SEE HUMANITARIAN PTS BELOW). WHILE THE TEAM WAITED AT THE BOURGMEISTRE'S OFFICE, ONE RPA SOLDIER TOLD THE TEAM, ON HIS OWN INITIATIVE, THAT ON THE NIGHT 27-28 NOV 95 THAT FOUR (4) UNIFORMED ARMED MEN CONDUCTED BREAK-INS AND ROBBERIES IN MUBUGA WHICH AMOUNTED TO 150,000 RWF STOLEN FROM THE LOCAL POPULATION. HE SAID THAT THE RPA IS INVESTIGATING THIS INCIDENT.

ON THE WAY, THEY TALKED WITH A NUMBER OF LOCALS AT BUDELIDELI (QT 3871), KIBANDE (QT 3870) AND KAREHE III (QT 4368), ALL CELLULES ALONG THE RD. THE LOCALS IN THESE CELLULES CLAIM THAT THE GEN SECUR SIT WAS PRESENTLY CALM,

AND THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO ARRESTS SO FAR IN THE PAST WEEK. HOWEVER, KAREHE III LOCALS LAMENTED OVER THEIR INABILITY TO VISIT THEIR ARRESTED RELATIONS IN THE BIRAMBO (QT 4763) SOUS-PREFECTURE CACHOT AND THE KIBUYE (QT 2871) PREFECTURE PRISON. THE REASON, THEY CLAIM, WAS THAT MALES WHO WENT TO THOSE PLACES WERE ALSO ARRESTED. THIS DEVELOPMENT HAS PROMPTED AN INCREASED SUSPICION AMONG THE LOCALS THAT THEIR RELATIONS MIGHT HAVE BEEN KILLED. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED IN KAREHE III THAT SOME LOCALS WERE BEATEN IN THE MARKET BY RPA SOLDIERS ON FRIDAY 24 NOV 95, FOR NOT PAYING FOR THE SPACE IN WHICH THEY WERE SELLING THEIR WARES. HOWEVER, IT WAS NOT CONFIRMED WHY THE RPA SOLDIERS WERE TAKING UP THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COLLECTING TOLLS IN THE MARKET. AT THE OBJECTIVE, MUGANDA, A GP OF LOCAL WOMEN SPOKE WITH THE TEAM. THE WOMEN CLAIMED THAT THEIR SECURITY THERE WAS NOT VERY ENCOURAGING. THEY SAID THAT THEIR HUSBANDS AND MALE CHILDREN ARE ARRESTED AT RANDOM. ONE OF THE WOMEN CONCLUDED BY SAYING THAT WHEN UNAMIR LEAVES, THEY BELIEVE THAT QUOTE "WE SHALL ALL BE KILLED, SO, WE ARE WAITING FOR THAT TIME" UNQUOTE. THIS GIVES THE OBVIOUS IMPRESSION THAT THE LOCALS IN THIS AREA ARE LIVING IN ABSOLUTE FEAR.

THE LOCALS CLAIM THAT THOSE ARRESTED DO NOT COME BACK AND THAT THEY FEAR THAT THEY HAVE BEEN KILLED. THE TEAM THEN PROCEEDED TO THEIR OBJECTIVE KAGANDA. THEY SPOKE WITH THE CONSEILLER WHO STATED THAT THERE ARE GROUPS OF MEN, NUMBERING AROUND TEN (10), WHO COME TO TAKE AWAY THEIR LIVESTOCK. HE BELIEVES THAT THEY COME FROM GISHYITA. HE CLAIMS THAT THEY LAST CAME ON 23 NOV 95 AND BEAT UP A MAN FOR HIS CATTLE. THE LATTER COMPLAINED TO THE BOURGMEISTRE WHO HAD THREE (3) OF THESE MEN ARRESTED THREE (3) DAYS LATER. THEY ARE SAID TO HAVE BEEN RELEASED, BUT WERE ORDERED TO PAY THE MEDICAL BILL FOR THE VICTIM. THE CONSEILLER CLAIMS THAT THE SECTEUR HAS LOST AROUND FIFTY (50) COWS, INCLUDING TWO (2) OF HIS OWN, FROM SURVIVORS WHOM HE CLAIMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS TERROR. ALSO AT KIVURUGA, THE LOCALS SAID THAT OVER SEVEN (7) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED LAST NIGHT, 24 NOV 95, IN RUBAZO SECTEUR (QT 2863). THE TEAM CONFIRMED THIS AT THE NICOY POST AT KARONGI, FROM ONE OF THE MEN ARRESTED AND SUBSEQUENTLY RELEASED. THE MAN TOLD THE TEAM THAT ACTUALLY TEN (10) OF THEM WERE ARRESTED FOR REFUSING TO TURN UP FOR NIGHT PATROLS IN THE SECTEUR. THE MAN CLAIMS THAT THE CONSEILLER EFFECTED THEIR ARREST AND THAT SO FAR ONLY THREE (3) OF THEM HAD BEEN RELEASED. THE TEAM THEN PROCEEDED TO MUKUNGU (QT 3353) WHERE THEY SPOKE WITH ONE OF THE SISTERS OF THE MUTUNTU (QT 3353) HOSPITAL. SHE CLAIMED THAT THERE THE SITUATION IS CALM, OTHER THAN FOR ONE OR TWO ARRESTS OCCASIONALLY WHICH SHE CONSIDERS AS NORMAL. THE TEAM THEN LEFT FOR GISAYURA (QT 3751) WHERE LOCALS TOLD THEM THAT EIGHT (8) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED IN THE BIRAMBO CELLULE (QT 3950) ON 23 NOV 95. THERE WAS NO KNOWN REASON FOR THEIR ARREST. FURTHERMORE, THEY ALSO CLAIM THAT FOUR (4) PERSONS WERE ALSO ARRESTED IN THE GITUNU CELLULE (QT 3750) BY THE RPA AND SOME SURVIVORS, ON 23 NOV 95. MESSRS. NIRAGIRE, NAGANIRA, ALPHONSE NIBISLIGWA, AND RUHAMYANKA. THERE IS NO KNOWN REASON FOR THEIR ARREST, AND THEY ARE SAID TO BE PRESENTLY IN THE MWENDO (QT 4557) COMMUNE CACHOT. THE LOCALS ALSO CLAIM THAT, ALTHOUGH THEY CONSIDER THEIR PRESENT CONDITION TO BE SURVIVING IN AN UNSAFE ENVIRONMENT WHERE THEY CONSTANTLY HAVE THEIR LIVESTOCK GRABBED AWAY FORCEFULLY BY SURVIVORS AND ARRESTED BY THE RPA, THE SITUATION LOCALLY IS FAIRLY CALM.


