1. THE ABOVE REFERENCES INDICATED THAT A TOTAL OF 24 LOCALS REPORTED TO MALICOY POSITION AT NTONGWE (9056) TO SEEK UNAMIR PROTECTION FROM RPA ARRESTS AND HARASSMENT. IN RECENT TIMES ALSO THIS HQ IS RECEIVING INCREASING REQUESTS FROM LOCALS IN THE SECTOR TO ASSIST IN SECURING THE RELEASE OF THEIR RELATIVES WHO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED BY THE RPA IN THE VARIOUS LOCALITIES.

2. THE RPA HAS APPROACHED MALICOY IN NTONGWE TO INSIST THAT THE LOCALS BE TURNED INTO THEIR CUSTODY BECAUSE THEY ARE ALL WANTED CRIMINALS. MALICOY'S REFUSAL TO DO SO HAS LED TO A DETERIORATION OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THEM AND THE LOCAL RPA.

3. DIRECTION IS ALSO REQUIRED ON WHAT ACTION TO TAKE ON THE INCREASING NUMBER OF LOCALS WHO ARE REPORTING TO THIS HQ TO MAKE REPORTS ABOUT RPA ARRESTS OF THEIR RELATIVES AND TO SEEK THE PROTECTION OF UNAMIR. AT PRESENT A LOCAL FAMILY OF 12 HAVE REPORTED TO THE SECTOR HQ TO SEEK PROTECTION FROM RPA IN NTONGWE. IT IS OBVIOUS THAT THIS HQ LACKS THE RESOURCES TO PROVIDE THE ACCOMPANYING LOGISTIC SUPPORT FOR THESE PEOPLE.

4. MEANWHILE MALICOY WILL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE PROTECTION FOR LOCALS IN THEIR CAMP.

5. IT WILL BE VERY MUCH APPRECIATED IF THE SITUATION IS TREATED WITH URGENCY. BEST VETS.

CONDITIONS. THE TEAM FOUND THAT AT MUGUSA (6226) THERE IS NEED FOR FOOD, CLOTHING, FOR 39 ORPHANS. ONE TEAM WITH CIVPOL VISITED SHEKE (626044) FOR INVESTIGATION REFER OUR SHEEP OF 28 OCT PARA 4B. NO SUSPECT IDENTIFIED. LOCALS GAVE NEGATIVE COMMENTS THAT UNAMIR IS PROTECTING HUTUS BUT BEFORE THE WAR IT NEVER PROTECTED TUTSIS. (2) LOCALS IN NDGO (GR5201) REPORTED CONSTANT HARASSMENT BY RPA.

THEY ADDED THAT THE RPA HAD KILLED 6 PEOPLE IN THE RUKO AREA (GR 5200). ON INVESTIGATION THE PATROL FOUND 3 PEOPLE FROM ONE FAMILY DEAD AND A 10 YEAR OLD BOY SHOT IN THE ARM. A FIFTH

VICTIM WAS FOUND DEAD ABOUT 500 M FROM THE SCENE. THE SIXTH VICTIM

WAS FOUND BOUND AND HAND AND FOOT AND SEVERLY BEATEN. AT ABOUT 1200 HRS LOCALS ALSO IDENTIFIED 2 RPA SOLDIERS WHO HAD ATTEMPTED TO ABDUCT TWO CHILDREN AND THE WIFE OF ONE OF THEM. CEASED BUT

HAD BEEN CHASED OUT BY AN ANGRY LOCAL MOB. THE INJURED BOY WAS

TAKEN TO THE BRITCON CLINIC FOR TREATMENT. LOCALS HAVE REFUSED TO RETURN TO THEIR VILLAGES AS LONG AS THE RPA IS IN POWER. THEY

HAVE ALSO THREATENED TO DEAL WITH ANY TUTSIS THEY SEE IN THE AREA.

(3) A THIRD PATROL WHICH WAS ESCORTING ELECTROGAZ WORKERS REPAIRING POWER LINES WITHIN BUTARE WAS STOPPED AT GR6913 BY AN RPA OFFICER.
