A HAND GRENADE WAS THROWN AND ROUNDS OF SHOTS WERE FIRED ~~THE~~ AGAINST THE LOCATION OF OUR TROOPS DEPLOYED AT ZCRC WAREHOUSE IN KAMEMBE GR (7826). OUR GUARD RESPONDED BY OPENING AN AUTOMATIC FIRE EARLY THIS MORNING AT 0100 HRS.

OUR TROOPS SEARCHED THE SURROUNDING AREA AND FOUND THE TOTAL OF 3 HAND GRENADES.

AN MDM TOYOTA VEHICLE CARRYING 8 PEOPLE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT WHILE PROCEEDING TO MBIKIZI (8116) WHEN AN ANTI-VEH. MINE WHICH WAS BURIED BY UNKNOWN PEOPLE EXPLODED.

A WOMAN WITH HER CHILD DIED AND THE REST 7 INJURED SERIOUSLY. 3 OF THE INJURED ONES ARE TRANSPORTED TO MBIKIZI BY RPA. THE REST FOUR TRANSPORTED TO GIKUNDWE HOSP. BY MIKOB. THE VEH. IS NO LONGER SERVICEABLE.

ANOTHER LOCAL WOMAN ALSO GOT HER LEG CUT WHILE WALKING ON AN ANTI-PERSONNEL MINE WHEN EXPLODED AT THIS LOCATION. SHE IS TRANSPORTED TO GIKUNDWE HOSPITAL BY OUR PATROL TEAM.

IT IS SUSPECTED THAT ANOTHER ANTI-VEH. MINES ARE BURIED. WE WILL CLEAR THE ROAD TOMORROW AND PASS YOU A REPORT.

1. Ref. FC directive on the legal jurisdiction applicable to UNAMIR and Rwandan authorities, Annex D para 3.

1. On 28 Mar 95 at 2000 Hrs a Rwandan national named NDEZE XAVIER, presently working as magistrate at the Council of States in Kigali, sought UNAMIR protection together with his wife and 5 children and one bicycle pickup.

2. He says he came from Kigali on Mar 18/95 and was arrested by local gendarmes. He was released on Monday 26 March 95 (19-26) without giving him any reason for his arrestation. He says he and his family are constantly persecuted, so he decided to seek UNAMIR protection.

3. After explaining to him (in French) the content of FC's directive he agreed to be handed over to the local prosecutors office, we provided him temporary protection, in the presence of the head of UNHRFO, Jane Rasmussen and UNHCR head, Mr Gunter Hartman.

4. We request the HQ to take necessary action according to the FC's directive Annex D para 3, ASAP.

ACTIVITIES ALONG ZAIRE BORDER

1. IT SEEMS MOVEMENT TOWARDS RWANDA FROM ZAIRE HAS SUBSTANTIALLY DECREASED IN RECENT DAYS, AND ILLEGAL MOVEMENT DURING THE NIGHT HAS INCREASED FROM RWANDA TO ZAIRE.

2. MUCH OF THE PROBLEM IS DIRECTLY AND INDIRECTLY RELATED TO THE ELEMENT OF FEAR IN THE LOCAL POPULATION ON THIS SIDE OF THE BORDER AND OF THE REFUGEES ON THE OTHER SIDE IN THE BUKAVU CAMPS. MUCH OF THE FEAR AT THE MOMENT IS MORE BECAUSE OF THE POTENTIAL OF ACTIVITIES THAT COULD TAKE PLACE ON AND AFTER 6 APRIL 95, RATHER THAN FEAR OF PERSECUTION BY RPA. IT IS KNOWN FOR CERTAIN THAT REFUGEES IN THE CAMPS HAVE A FEAR OF THEIR FUTURE IF RETURNING TO RWANDA, BUT THAT THE FEAR IS DIRECTLY RELATED TO THOSE WHO RULE THE CAMPS. IT CANNOT YET BE CONFIRMED FROM WHERE AND WHEN THE ILLEGAL MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE FROM RWANDA TO ZAIRE OCCURRED, BUT UNHCR BUKAVU HAVE CONFIRMED AN INCREASE IN THE CAMPS IN THE PAST WEEK. THE PREFET OF CYANGUGU HIMSELF ADMITTED KNOWLEDGE OF THIS SITUATION AND BLAMES IT ON THE SECURITY SIT. UNFORTUNATELY THE TWO BORDERS, THE TERRAIN, THE PROXIMITY OF THE CAMPS, THE EASY PASSAGE FROM IJWI ISLAND, AND THE LACK OF RPA TROOPS AND OBSERVATION EQUIPMENT ARE ALL FACTORS THAT WILL ENSURE THE SECURITY SIT DOES NOT IMPROVE IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

3. THERE IS A SHORTAGE OF FOOD IN THE REFUGEE CAMPS AND THERE

IS GROWING CONCERN FOR THE LEVEL OF MALNUTRITION THAT WAS EVIDENT FROM LAST SPRING IN '94. IT IS APPARENT THAT ALTHOUGH UNHCR HAVE CUT BACK SOME OF THE FOOD, THERE IS ENOUGH DELIVERED. THIS DELIVERY TO EACH REFUGEE, HOWEVER, MAY BE DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY FRGF TROOPS WHO TAKE SOME OF THE FOOD. THE SIT IS GETTING WORSE AND AS WAS EVIDENT LAST WEEK IN BUNYAKIRI, ZAIRE, FEARFUL AND HUNGRY PEOPLE WILL REACT. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT IT IS KNOWN THAT ZAIREAN TROOPS RECENTLY SEARCHED A VEHICLE THAT WAS CARRYING FOOD AND FOUND ARMAMENTS UNDERNEATH THE FOOD DESTINED FOR A CAMP. IT WAS A LOCAL TYPE TRUCK AND NOT AN NGO VEH. QUANTITY AND TYPE OF ARMAMENT IS NOT KNOWN AT THIS TIME.

4. UNREST BETWEEN HUTU AND TUTSI IN NORTHWEST BURUNDI ALSO AFFECTS THE SIT HERE IN SECTOR 4C. NGO OF MDM WERE AT THE BURUNDI BORDER DURING ONE SMALL SKIRMISH LAST FRIDAY WHICH SEEMS TO HAVE OCCURRED BETWEEN PERS IN BURUNDI ONLY, RPA WERE NOT APPARENTLY INVOLVED. HOWEVER, THE MOVEMENT OF LOCALS IN BURUNDI TO ZAIRE FEEDS THE NOTION FOR LOCALS IN RWANDA TO SEEK AT LEAST TEMPORARY SAFETY (PERCEIVED) SOMEWHERE ELSE. THERE MAY ALSO BE A GROWING OPPORTUNITY FOR FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT OF CRIMINAL AND ALSO FRGF ACTIVITY TO OPERATE IN THE AREA. IT WAS REPORTED EARLIER THAT FRGF FUNDING AND TROOPS ARE ASSISTING IN THE UNREST, AND THERE HAS BEEN NO INFO SINCE THEN TO DISCOURAGE THE EARLIER REPORT. IT MUST BE CONSIDERED THAT THE APRIL 6 ANNIVERSARY DATE MAY BE UTILIZED BY EXTREMISTS NOT SO MUCH HERE IN RWANDA, BUT IN BURUNDI INSTEAD.

5. THE BORDER BETWEEN ZAIRE IS MORE SENSITIVE NOW THAN DURING INITIAL UNAMIR DEPLOYMENT. RPA AND ZAIRE EXCHANGE OF FIRE SHOWS MORE A SIGN OF INCREASE THAN DECREASE. RPA ADMIT A SORT OF IMPATIENCE FOR THE SITUATION AND AN OBVIOUS FRUSTRATION OVER THE FRGF'S NATURAL AND SOMEWHAT SYMBIOTIC DEFENCE WITH ZAIRE BORDER TROOPS. ALSO, ZAIRE MILITARY MOVT IN THE CAMPS IS REMAINS EXTREMELY LIMITED TO NON EXISTENT, EVEN AFTER UNHCR ARRANGED PAYMENT FOR ZAIRE TROOPS TO ASSIST IN THE RESTORATION OF CONTROL IN THE CAMPS.

6. ALTHOUGH RUMOURS CLOUD SOME OF THE FACTS, ALL RUMOURS PRESENT IN SECTOR 4C ARE BEING TAKEN SERIOUSLY, MOSTLY BECAUSE OF THEIR POSSIBILITY, AND PERHAPS, PROBABILITY. THE POPULATION REMAINS INSECURE AND THE GEN SIT IS UNSTABLE. IT WOULD TAKE VERY LITTLE TO CREATE A BIG IMPACT.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY

Mr. Pierre Claver Rwangabo, the Prefect of Butare, was assassinated on Saturday evening at 9:00 p.m. at Mwurire, in Mbazi Commune, in Butare Prefecture, by five unidentified gunmen. Mr. Rwangabo, who was one of the senior leaders of the Social Democratic Party (PSD), was on his way home from a working mission in Kigali. His eldest son, Kwihangana, and his driver were also killed, while an RPF escort soldier was wounded and is currently in Butare Hospital.

Vice-President and Minister of Defence, Major-General Paul Kagame, along with several ministers, visited the scene of the killing and made a statement condemning the assassination.

The President of Rwanda, Mr. Pasteur Bizimungu, sent a message of condolence to Madam Agnes Rwangabo, the wife of the late Mr. Pierre Claver Rwangabo and to Mr. Charles Ntakirutimana, the Chairman of the Social Democratic Party.

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General, Ambassador Khan, accompanied by several other UN officials, attended Mr. Rwangabo's funeral service in Butare today at 11:00 a.m.

The Republic of Ghana celebrated its national holiday with a military parade in Kibungo. The SRSG, Ambassador Khan, was in attendance, and General Tousignant, the UNAMIR Force Commander, officiated at the medals ceremony.

A cabinet meeting was held in Kigali under the chairmanship of President Pasteur Bizimungu during which a decision was made to institute a floating exchange rate which will be determined by the Rwandan National Bank and the relevant, independent foreign currency exchange offices. The institution of a floating rate, or, as a second option, the devaluation of the Rwandan currency, was a condition imposed by the European Union as part of its programme of assistance. The floating rate will go into effect on 14 March, 1995.

A presidential decree has been issued banning the exchange of foreign currency on the black market.
