SUBJ: PATROL REPORT.

REF: STREP. 9/8/95.
INSURGENTS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTOR

1. On 7/8/95 at about 2300hrs, at Muchebela cellule of Echanga sector - RUTSIRU commune, an electro-gas pylon was blown by explosives which were tappered to it by unknown person.
2. On 8/8/95 also at about 1130hrs, at Rutkaragata sect- RUTSIRU commune along Kibuye - Gisenyi road a landmine exploded after a truck + loaded with beds, and mattresses and blankets passed through it. There were no casualties. The two right rear wheels were blown off including the ~~fuel~~ fuel tank.
The truck Reg. IT. 6806 belongs to CARITAS - RWANDA based in Kigali.
According to the C.O. driver SANGWA CHARLES, found at the scene, ~~himself~~ and GATUNGE JOHN the driver, were proceeding to Cyangugu via ~~Kibuye~~ Gisenyi, and Kibuye from Kigali. They were to deliver ~~himself~~ *himself*.

3. Findings: The two explosions are
strongly suspected to be the work
of Militia men who have greatly
infiltrated the sector to pursue
their Insurgents activities.

A Widely Known Interahamwe, Rukara
was arrested by R.P.A. on the night
of 8/8/95 from his home in
Rutiro Commune few Kilometers
away from the scene of the explosions.
According to information gathered from
Locals, Rukara is among those who
fled to Zaire last year after the
genocide leaving his two wives behind.
Early this year, he secretly crossed
Lake Kivu into Kibuye (Rwanda) and
collocated his two wives into Zaire.

On this fateful trip, he came to
fetch food. ~~After~~ His presence
was notified to R.P.A. who arrested
him at night.

SUBJ: SHOOTING INCIDENT AT RUSIRO COMMUNE

Reference: STREP OF 3/8/95.

1. Below is the Preliminary report on the above mentioned report subject.

On 3rd August 1995 a joint team of CIVPOL and MILOB patrolled Rusiro Commune on routine observation task.

2. Whilst on patrol, the team learnt from locals that on Tuesday 1st August 1995 at about 0500 hrs, R.P.A. soldiers shot dead thirteen people at a place known as Rwamasizi, a mineral mining area situated in MUKURA Natural forests, under the pretext, the deceased were Interahamwe.

3. An interview with two locals who escaped ^{death} namely, UKUZE BARAZA EVARISTO and MUTARO PIERRE, revealed that on the fateful day, R.P.A. soldiers picked the ^{nine (9)} ~~thirteen (13)~~ deceased from their huts near the mining area tied their hands at the back and shot them dead. The other four (4) deceased, were burnt to death after setting their hut ablaze.

3. Mr Tubanamazi, a councilor of the area when asked to confirm the shooting incident said the information was genuine because the deceased were Interahamwe and that the rural mukara forest was infested with Interahamwe, as such the shooting was in good faith security wise.
4. The mineral mined at this place is Tin. Before the war in 1994, the mine was owned by COPIMAR NATIONAL SOCIETY. After the war, a white man whose name is known by ^{his} initials only as "SSZM" living in Iceland took over the operation of the mine. He has a labour force of about 100 men. He does not visit the mining area regularly, may be once in a fortnight.
5. After interviewing several locals, we as a team visited the scene ~~together~~ in company of councilor, and the two survivors. At the scene, we physically counted nine (9) bodies with gunshot wounds, with hands tied by their backs. We also saw four fresh graves where the four burnt in ~~the~~ hut were buried. The scene is about 6 kms off the main road. The path is not motorable for it is hilly with thick forest.

6. Locals managed to identify eleven (11) out of (13) and named them as follows:

- BAZIMITIMA
- SENYENZI
- NURKALA
- NDUSHA BANDI
- BAZEZI QITE
- HABINYAKANG
- MUGARAGU
- MIDERE
- BRALONKITE
- TWAGIRA
- SEMIRYANGO

C The other two could not be identified by names for they came from Kivumu Commune and are not known to them.

7. Investigations will continue, otherwise Rusebaga Comm sector ^{is} densely populated by Hutu tribe. All ~~the~~ deceased are Hutu.


