(i) ONE COMBINED MILOB/MSF HELI PATROL TO RAMBA ON 10 JAN. THERE WERE A NUMBER OF NGO/UN RELATED POINTS THAT WERE PASSED TO THE RELEVANT AGENCIES DURING THIS MORNINGS BRIEFING.

(ii) ONE PATROL ON B ROUTE. THE SITUATION IS REPORTED AS CALM.

(iii) ONE PATROL ON C ROUTE. THE SITUATION IS REPORT AS GENERALLY CALM. KARAGO COMMUNE (4516), LOCALS REPORT THAT ONE PERSON, MR RIVEMAOKA, WAS ARRESTED AS HE REFUSED TO GIVE HIS LIVESTOCK UP TO THE AUTHORITIES. SAME COMMUNE, LOCALS REPORT THAT 10 PERSONS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR ROBBERY AND NINE FOR BREAKING THE LAW BY ASSEMBLING AND PRAYING AFTER CURFEW. SITINSYI (5800), LOCALS REPORT THAT THE RPA ARE BEATING THOSE WHO REFUSE TO SURRENDER THEIR COWS ON DEMAND.

(iv) RUHENGIERI - ONE TEAM PATROLLED NKUMBA (6639) AND NYAKINAMA (5827) COMMUNES. A MEETING WAS HELD WHICH WAS ATTENDED BY APPROXIMATELY 1500 PERSONS. IN ATTENDANCE WERE THE SUB-PREFECT OF RUHENGIERI, ALL COUNSELLERS AND THE 59 BN COMD. THE FOLLOWING TOPICS WERE DISCUSSED - MILITARY AND CIVILIAN RELATIONSHIPS, NKUMBA ARMS CACHE INCIDENT AND GENERAL

SECURITY. ON 10 JAN, THREE PERSONS WERE ARRESTED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RUHONDO (6937) AND NYANGA (7138) ARMS CACHE INCIDENT. THESE PERSONS ARE NOW BEING HELD IN THE RPA DETENTION CENTRE AT RUHENGARI.

HE ADDED THAT ONE OF THEM, A MR GATERA JOHN, WAS ARRESTED AND FOUND WITH A HAND GRENADE. HOWEVER, THE REMAINING THREE BEGAN TO FLEE AND WERE KILLED IN THE ATTEMPT. DURING FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS, MR GATERA REVEALED AN ARMS CACHE CONSISTING OF 16 SMALL ARMS CONSISTING OF AR 47'S AND M16'S. ALL WERE WITHOUT MAGAZINES. HE FURTHER INDICATED THAT THERE WERE SEVEN WEAPONS INCLUDING ANTI/PERS MINES HIDDEN IN A SEPARATE LOCATION. THE WEAPONS WERE BROUGHT INTO RWANDA IN ANTICIPATION OF AN OPERATION.
