
Dear Mr. Ambassador,

I would also like to express to you once again my gratitude for the valuable support that the Government of Uruguay continues to provide to this important peacekeeping operation.

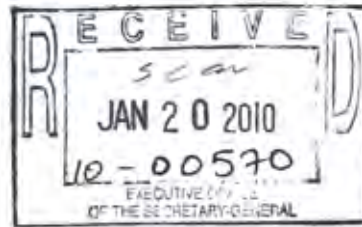


