IN KIBANGO SECTOR OF NYAKIZU COMMUNE THE TEAM WITNESSED DIGGING OUT OF REMAINS OF THE GENOCIDE VICTIMS AS A PRELUDE TO A PREPARATION FOR REBURIAL TO BE HELD ON 16 SEP 95. TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT ON 07 SEP 95 A TOTAL OF 208 RETURNEES CAME TO THE COMMUNE. ALL ARE BEING SETTLED IN THE COMMUNES.

(3) CIVPOL ON A REQUEST BY THE SECTOR COMMANDER OF SECTOR 1B, GITARAMA, THE TEAM CARRIED OUT A INVESTIGATION OF THE CASE OF KIDNAPPING/ ARBITRARY ARREST OF THE HEAD NURSE OF KABGAYI HOSPITAL IN GITARAMA ON 30 AUG 95. TEAM FOUND THAT THE NURSE HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY THE GENDARMERIE OF BUTARE ON CHARGES OF HER INVOLVEMENT IN 1994 GENOCIDE. SHE WAS TRANSFERRED TO NYANZA PRISON IN NYABISINDU ON 12 SEP 95. SECTOR 1B HAS BEEN INFORMED ACCORDINGLY. A DETAILED REPORT ON THE SUBJECT FORWARDED BY THE CIVPOL IS ENCLOSED FOR YOUR INFORMATION.



THAT IN AUG 95 A TOTAL OF 221 RETURNEES HAD COME TO THE COMMUNE OF WHICH 100 WERE FROM BURUNDI AND 121 FROM ZAIRE. BOURGEMASTER INFORMED THAT THE COMMUNE WAS IN URGENT NEED OF SEEDS, FARMING IMPLIMENTS AND THAT THE SPRING WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM WAS STILL OUT OF ORDER. THE MOST IMPORTANT REQUIREMENT OF THE COMMUNE HOWEVER WAS BUILDING MATERIAL TO BUILD HOUSES FOR THE RETURNEES.

(2) EM-3 TEAM VISITED MUGANZA (GR 8407) COMMUNE AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. TEAM SAW A LARGE PIT BEING DUG FOR THE REBURIAL CEREMONY TO BE HELD ON 16 SEP 95 WHERE REMAINS OF 4000 VICTIMS OF GENOCIDE ARE GOING TO BE REBURIED. TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT IN PAST TWO MONTHS THE COMMUNE HAD RECIEVED 2500 RETURNEES. ON 11 SEP 95, A TOTAL OF 17 RETURNEES ARRIVED FROM BURUNDI.

(2) EM-4 TEAM VISITED KIGEMBE (GR7093 ) COMMUNE AND KANYARU- BAS BORDER POST AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. TEAM WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE FORCE ENGR COY PERSONEL WHO CARRIED OUT RECCE OF THE BROKEN BRIDGE ON BUTARE - KANYARU-BAS ROAD. THE ENGR ARE PUTTING UP DEMAND FOR REPAIR MATERIAL SEPARATELY. TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT ON 09 SEP , 14 RETURNEES AND ON 12 SEP 68 RETURNEES , ALL FRO BURUNDI , CAME TO THE COMMUNE AND THAT ALL WERE BEING SETTLED IN THE SECTORS. BOURGMASTER OF THE COMMUNE REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT TO TRANSFER 50 PRISONERS TO NYANZA PRISON FROM HIS COMMUNE.
