A) PMT/GISENYI WENT ON PATROLS TO RUBAVU AND NYAMYUMBA
COMMUNES TODAY 28/03/95 AND HAD INTERVIEWS WITH THE
BURGOMASTERS. AT RUBAVU COMMUNE THE BURGOMASTER MISS

MURORUNKWERE SPECIOUS DESCRIBED GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE AS TENSE DUE TO RECENT KILLING OF THREE PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNE SUSPECTED TO HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT BY INTERAMHWES LIVING IN EXILE AT ZAIRE. ACCORDING TO THE BURGOMASTER, THE INTERAMHWES WHO HAVE THEIR WIVES STAYING IN THE COMMUNE OCCASIONALLY SNEAK IN AND ARE A SOURCE OF FEAR TO THE PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNE. THE BURGOMASTER HAS REQUESTED FOR MILITARY AND GENDARMERIE PRESENCE IN RUBAVU COMMUNE.

AT NYAMYUMBA COMMUNE THE BURGOMASTER MR. HABIMANA FESTUS GAVE THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE AS CALM DUE THE RPA PRESENCE IN THE COMMUNE. HE INFORMED THE PMT THAT THERE HAS BEEN CONSTANT MEETING WITH PEOPLE TO DISABUSE THEIR MIND OF CURRENT PROPAGANDA GOING ON IN THE COMMUNE THAT THERE IS GOING TO BE YET ANOTHER GENOCIDE IN THE COUNTRY.

- B) CPMT HAD IN THE MORNING OF THE 28 MARCH 1995 BETWEEN 0830 AND 1000 HOURS A MEETING WITH THE COMMANDER AND AN INVESTIGATOR OF THE GENDARMERIE BRIGADE OF GISENYI. IT WAS TALKED ABOUT POLICE INVESTIGATIONS AND TASKS ON A SCENE OF A CRIME. THE NEXT MEETING WILL TAKEN PLACE ON THE 01 APRIL 1995 AT 1400 HOURS. THIS MEETINGS ARE PART OF THE CIVPOL/GENDARMERIE-TRAINING-PROGRAM.
- C) IN THE AFTERNOON OF THE 28 MARCH 1995 BETWEEN 1400 AND 1700 HOURS MILOBS, HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVPOL GISENYI RECEIVED A DELEGATION OF THE MINISTERS OF INTERIOR AND AGRICULTURE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA. THE DELEGATION WAS BRIEFED ABOUT MURDER CASES IN THE GISENYI AREA. THE DELEGATION LEFT GISENYI AT 1708 HOURS BY HELICOPTER.

ON 17 JULY 1994 MY SON ABDOULKARIM HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY THE RPA.
THAT HAPPENED AT THE CHECK POINT OF THE GISENYI/GOMA BORDER. HE WAS
ON THE WAY TO GOMA. NEITHER I NOR ANOTHER MEMBER OF OUR FAMILY HAVE
SEEN THE ARREST, BUT IT WAS TOLD US BY A PERSON WHICH IS IN ZAIRE.
WE DO NOT KNOW IN WHICH PRISON HE WAS ARRESTED. WE HAVE GOT AN
INFORMATION, THAT HE IS IN THE MOMENT SOLDIER IN A RPA BATTALION OF
BUTARE.

ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT TASKS OF A POLICE IS TO KEEP UNDER SURVEILLANCE THE ATTENTION OF THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS. THE AIM OF THAT SURVEILLANCE MUST BE TO MAKE PLAIN THE ROAD USERS THE NECESSITY OF THIS ATTENTION. THE POLICE MUST BE ABLE TO IMPART, THAT TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ARE MADE TO PREVENT ACCIDENTS AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE LIVE AND THE HEALTH OF ALL OF US, THAT THIS REGULATIONS WILL BE RESPECTED.
THE MOST DANGEROUS CONTRAVENTION AGAINST TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ARE

- * OVER-SPEED
- * OVERTAKING MANOEUVRE IN SPITE OF ONCOMING TRAFFIC,
PROHIBITION OF OVERTAKING OR BLIND STRETCH
- * DRIVING ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE ROAD
- * DRIVING A VEHICLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL
- * NON-OBSERVANCE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY

THE POLICE HAS TO CONCENTRATE THEIR MEN-POWER AND THEIR MATERIAL FACILITIES IN THE SURVEILLANCE OF THIS CONTRAVENTION. TO PUNISH A ROAD-USER, THE CONTRAVENTION MUST BE CLEAR AND PROVED. I DO NOT KNOW IF IN RWANDA EXIST A LIST OF FINES. IF NOT, IT WILL BE AT FIRST NECESSARY TO CREATE THIS LIST OF FINES FOR THE WHOLE COUNTRY. IT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE, THAT THE PUNISHMENTS FOR THE SAME CONTRAVENTION ARE DIFFERENT.
THE PUNISHMENTS SHOULD ALSO BE SUITABLE. TO TAKE FOR EXAMPLE 10000 R.F. FOR A WRONG PARKING IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AND WILL CREATE MORE PROBLEMS AS IT WILL HELP TO MAKE PLAIN THE NECESSITY OF THE ATTENTION OF THE PARKING REGULATIONS.
THE REGULATIONS AND THE TRAFFIC SIGN MUST BE CLEAR AND IN ORDER. THE POLICEMEN MUST HAVE A GOOD COMMENT OF THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AND THEY MUST BE ABLE TO EXPLAIN THE SENSE TO THE ROAD USER. THE POLICE PREVENT, THAT THERE WILL DEVELOP THE IMPRESSION, THAT THE AIM OF THE POLICE SURVEILLANCE IS ONLY TO TAKE IN MONEY. FOR THAT IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO MAKE A PUBLICATION ABOUT THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AND THE INTENDED SURVEILLANCE OF THE POLICE. IN THE FIRST WEEK OF THE SURVEILLANCE THE POLICE SHOULD ONLY PUNISH THE GRAVELY CONTRAVENTION. THE FIRST CONTROLS THE POLICE SHOULD USE TO INFORM THE ROAD-USERS.

BUT AFTER TWO INCIDENTS IN THE LAST DAYS I HAVE REASON TO BELIEVE, THAT THE MANNER, HOW IT IS CARRIED OUT IN THE MOMENT BY THE GENDARMERIE BRIGADE OF GISENYI, IS NOT VERY EFFECTIVE.

IN BOTH CASES A GENDARME OBJECTED A WRONG PARKING AT THE MARKET PLACE. IN THE FIRST CASE HE REQUIRED 5000 AND IN THE SECOND CASE 10000 RF. BOTH CASES HAPPENED AT THE SAME PLACE. I COULD ME CONVINCED OF, THAT IN BOTH CASES IT WERE NEVER A WRONG PARKING. IN BOTH CASES IT WAS ONLY A STOPPING AND IT HAPPENED NOT IN A 'NO STOPPING AREA'. BESIDES HE WAS NOT ABLE TO EXPLAIN THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN 'NO STOPPING' AND A 'NO PARKING AREA'. BOTH CASES INDICATE A LACK OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE AND I THINK IT IS NOT VERY GOOD FOR THE REPUTATION OF THE GENDARMERIE.

WE HAVE DISCUSSED THE TWO CASES ALSO UNAMIR INTERN. WE HAVE DECIDED, THAT NONE UNAMIR DRIVER SHOULD PAY A PUNISHMENT, BEFORE NOT A CIVPOL TEAM HAS CHECKED THE SITUATION.
