We know you will enjoy the event, and we look forward to having you as our guest, which will make the occasion particularly special for us.

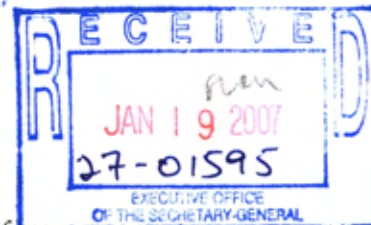
