The United Nations plans to contract a company or non-governmental organization to bring five-to-ten expatriate demining specialists to Rwanda, to make a survey of the most mine-polluted areas, mark them properly and to do emergency (small-scale in high-priority areas) demining. The result of the survey will be deposited in and utilized by the demining office of UNREO. The contractor will be paid by the United Nations and will hire, at the maximum, about twenty local civilians to help with the fencing, marking, etc.

It would be deeply appreciated if you could seek the necessary authorization from the appropriate authority of the Rwanda Government in order to enable us to proceed with these activities as soon as possible.
