IT WAS FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE TUTSI RETURNEES (59/60's) ATTACKED THE LOCAL HUTUS ACCUSING THEM OF HARBOURING THE INSURGENTS. ONE HUTU WAS KILLED AND FOUR WOUNDED. ALL INJURED WERE TAKEN TO THE KABATWA CLINIC (3327). ALL HAVE NOW BEEN DISCHARGED. PARC VOLCAN/BUTAKA (3229), LOCALS REPORT A CLASH BETWEEN THE RPA AND THE FRGF ON THE NIGHT 28/29 DEC. DETAILS ARE SKETCHY HOWEVER IT IS THOUGHT THAT THE RPA TOOK SOME CASUALTIES. THE LOCAL RPA DETACHMENT WAS VISITED HOWEVER DECLINED TO AUTHENTICATE THE REPORT.

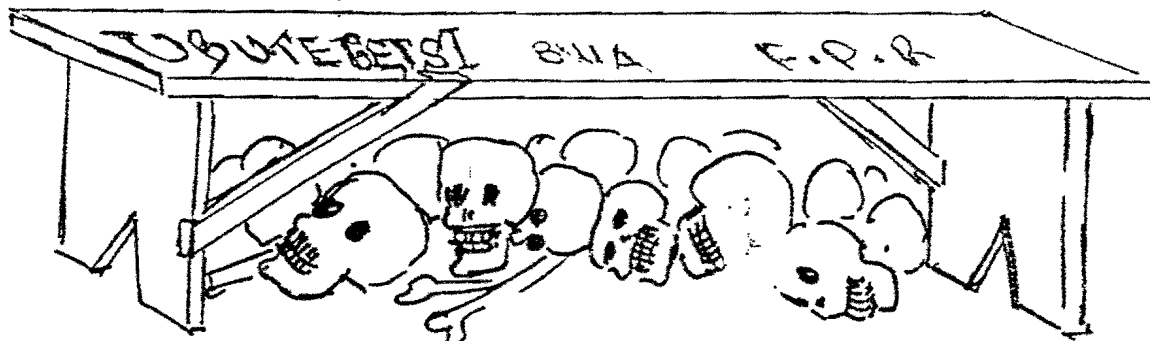
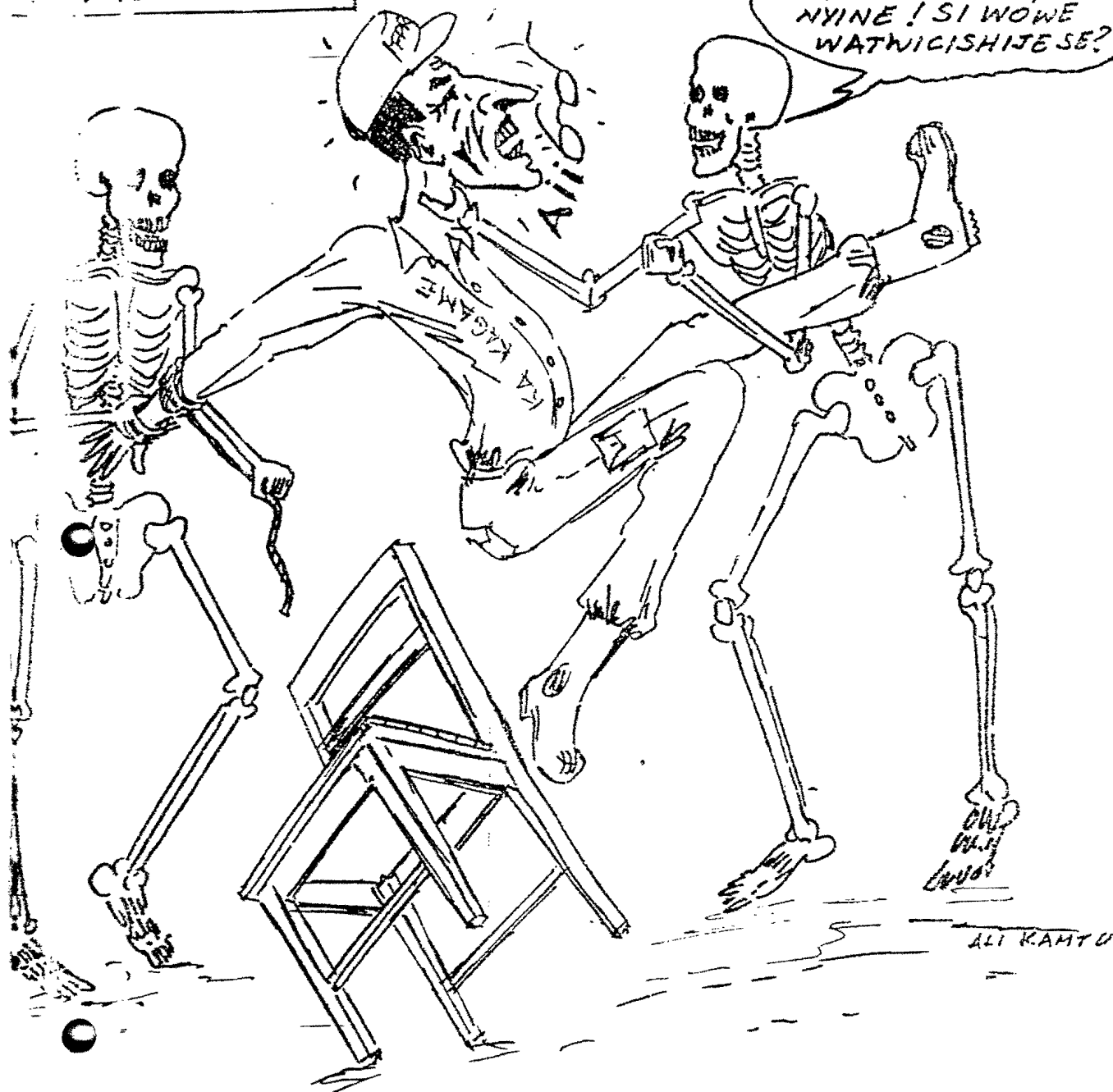

(i) ONE PATROL ON B ROUTE. THE SITUATION IS REPORTED AS CALM. THIS PATROL WAS CONDUCTED TO FOLLOW UP YESTERDAYS REPORT OF UP TO 50 INSURGENTS MOVING INTO THE GISHWATI. THE LOCALS INTERVIEWED HAD HEARD OF THE REPORT HOWEVER THE PATROL COULD NOT FIND ANY CONCLUSIVE EVIDENCE.

(ii) ONE MILOB PATROL ON C ROUTE. THE PATROL VISITED THE MSF CLINIC AT KABAYE WHERE IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE COUNSELLOR OF NUYAMUGEYO SECTOR (4703) WAS MURDERED ON THE NIGHT OF 30 NOV BY PERSONS UNKNOWN. A NOTE WAS LEFT BY THE BODY SAYING THAT THE DEATH IS THE FATE OF ALL COLLABORATORS. MUHUNGWE SECTOR (5015), LOCALS ALSO REPORT THAT ON THE NIGHT OF 28 NOV, TWO PERSONS, A MAN AND HIS WIFE, WERE ROBBED AND THEN KNIFED TO DEATH. FOLLOWING THE KILLING THE PERPETRATORS THREW A GRENADE INTO THE HOUSE INJURING ONE OF THEIR THREE CHILDREN. THE INJURED CHILD IS NOW IN GISENYI HOSPITAL.

10. COMMANDERS ASSESSMENT: OUR C SECTOR SEEMS TO BE HEATING UP (NORTH EAST SIDE OF THE GISHWATI AND DOMAIN MILITAIRE). IT IS DIFFICULT TO DETERMINE WHETHER THIS IS MOVEMENT FROM OR TO THE GISHWATI FOREST. THERE HAVE BEEN SOME MINE INCIDENTS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED HOWEVER NONE IN THE PAST FEW WEEKS. THIS LEADS ME TO BELIEVE THAT THE INCREASE OF ACTIVITY IS MUCH THE SAME AS EXPERIENCED LAST SUMMER WHEN THE INSURGENTS IN THE GISHWATI WERE ROBBING TO FINANCE THEIR ACTIVITIES. EXCEPTING THE MURDER OF THE COUNSELLOR, IT DOES NOT SEEM TO BE POLITICALLY MOTIVATED.

(i) ONE PATROL ON A ROUTE. UPDATE ON THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED ARREST (24 NOV) IN KIVUMU SECTOR (2303), LOCALS REPORT THAT THE SEVEN INDIVIDUALS HAD COME TO RWANDA FROM MUGUNGO CAMP IN ZAIRE. THEY HAD IN THEIR POSSESSION: THREE ATK MINES, SIX HAND GRENADES TWO AK 47'S AND AN ASSORTMENT OF UNIFORMS. THE REMAINING SIX ARE SUSPECTED TO BE HIDING IN THE GISHWATI FOREST. ALSO IN THE SAME SECTOR ON THE NIGHT OF 29/30 NOV, SUSPECTED INTERAHAMWE SURROUNDED THE HOUSE OF THE COUNSELLOR AND DEMANDED ENTRY. THE LOCALS RESPONDED TO THE NOISE AND CHASED THE INSURGENTS AWAY.

(ii) ONE MILOB PATROL ON B1 ROUTE. KANZENZE SECTOR (3019), LOCALS REPORT THAT 50 INTERAHAMWE MOVED THROUGH THAT SECTOR CLOSELY FOLLOWED BY THE RPA. THERE WAS NO CONTACT AND THE INSURGENTS ESCAPED INTO THE GISHWATI. THE LOCALS IN TAMIRA CAMP (3024) REFUSED TO PROVIDE ANY INFORMATION AS THEY HAVE BEEN THREATENED WITH REPRISALS FROM THE RPA SHOULD THEY BE SEEN SPEAKING WITH UNAMIR.

10. COMMANDERS ASSESSMENT: THERE HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF TROOP MOVEMENT IN AND AROUND THE NORTHERN PART OF THE SECTOR. APPROXIMATELY 100 PERSONNEL WERE SEEN MOVING FROM GISENYI ALONG THE GISENYI RUHENGARI ROAD. IN ADDITION, MACHINE GUN VEHICLE(S) (12.7) HAVE BEEN SITED IN AND AROUND THE GISENYI. IF THIS RUNS TRUE TO FORM, IT INDICATES HIGH RANKING PERSONS ARE IN THE AREA. I HAVE NO FIRM INFORMATION HOWEVER THERE IS AN INDICATION THAT SOMETHING IS A FOOT. THIS MAY BE A ROTATION OF THE TROOPS FROM ILE IWAWA TO THE MAINLAND, CONDITIONING ROOT MARCHES ETC HOWEVER THE PRESENCE OF THE MACHINE GUN VEHICLES MAY INDICATE OTHERWISE.
