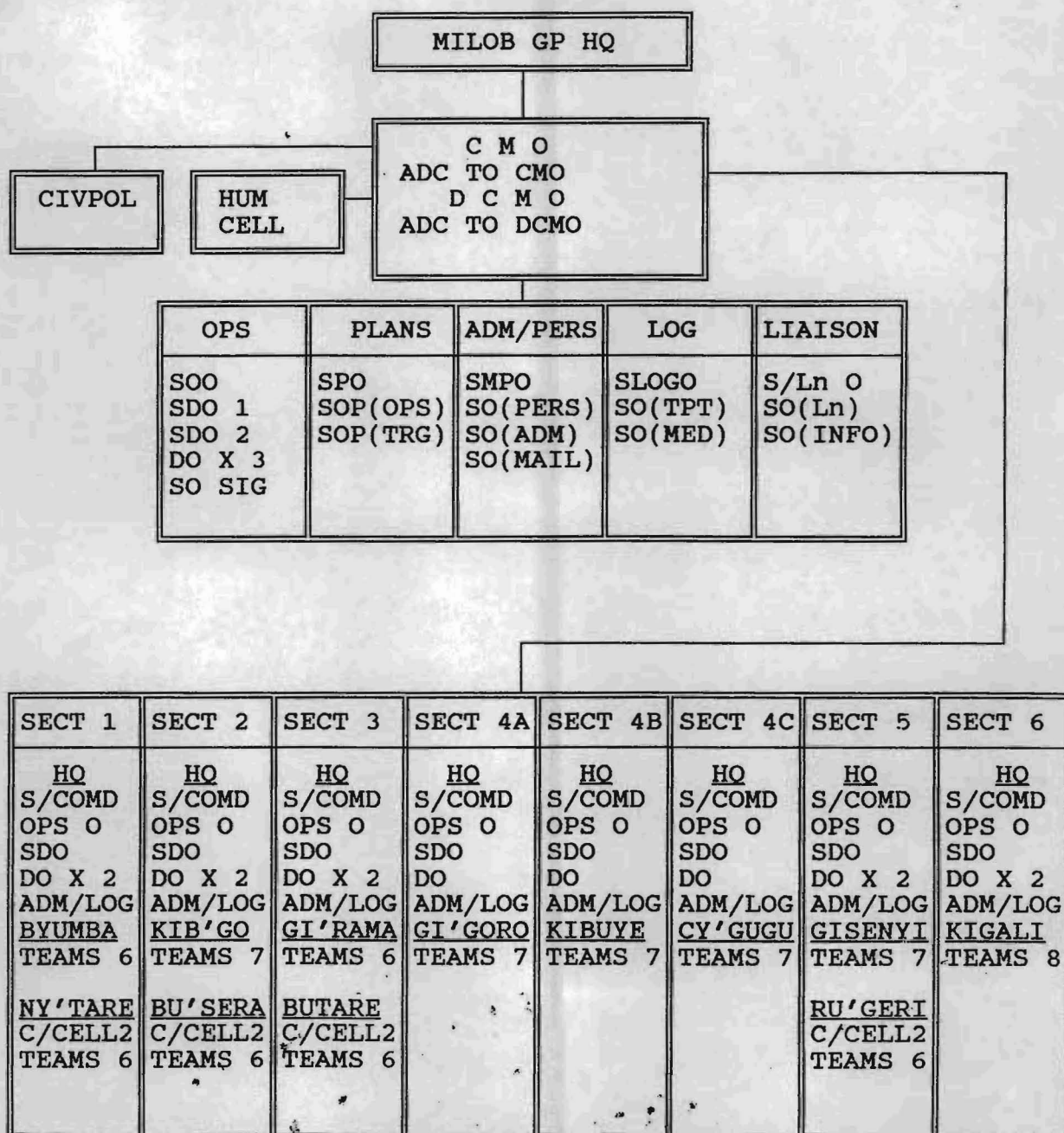

MILOBS DEPLOYMENT POLICY

INTRODUCTION

1. UNMOs are a very important weapon to UNAMIR. As such their morale is a concern of MILOB GP HQ.
2. This policy is designed to safeguard all such elements that might affect the morale of the organization hence reduce or destroy operational efficiency.
3. The policy shall cater for the deployment and employment of MILOBs with a view to:
 - a. Produce an equitable distribution of MILOBs through all Sectors by nationalities.
 - b. Produce an equitable distribution of appointments based on country/nationality strength.
4. The policy shall also look into the rotation system to be adopted.

POWER TO APPOINT STAFF AT MILOB GP HQ

5. The appointment of Branch Heads shall be the CMO's responsibility. For any other junior staff the SMPO, DCMO and branch head of that particular branch with the consent of the CMO shall appoint.

POWER TO APPOINT STAFF AT SECTOR HQs

6. The CMO shall appoint Sector Commanders, Operations Officers

and Administration and Logistics Officers. The appointment of Senior Duty Officers and Duty Officers shall be vested in the Sector Commanders with the consent of the CMO.

POWER TO APPOINT TEAM LEADER

7. Sector Commanders shall recommend to the CMO appointments of Team Leaders. The CMO shall approve or disapprove such recommendations.

NATIONAL SENIORS

8. The appointment of National Seniors shall remain the responsibility of the contributing countries. However, all national seniors shall report to the CMO on arrival in the Mission area. The CMO shall determine his/her appointment.

DEPLOYMENT OF MILOBs

9. MILOBs shall be posted to any MILOB Sector by the SMPO as per CMO and Operations Branch deployment priority.

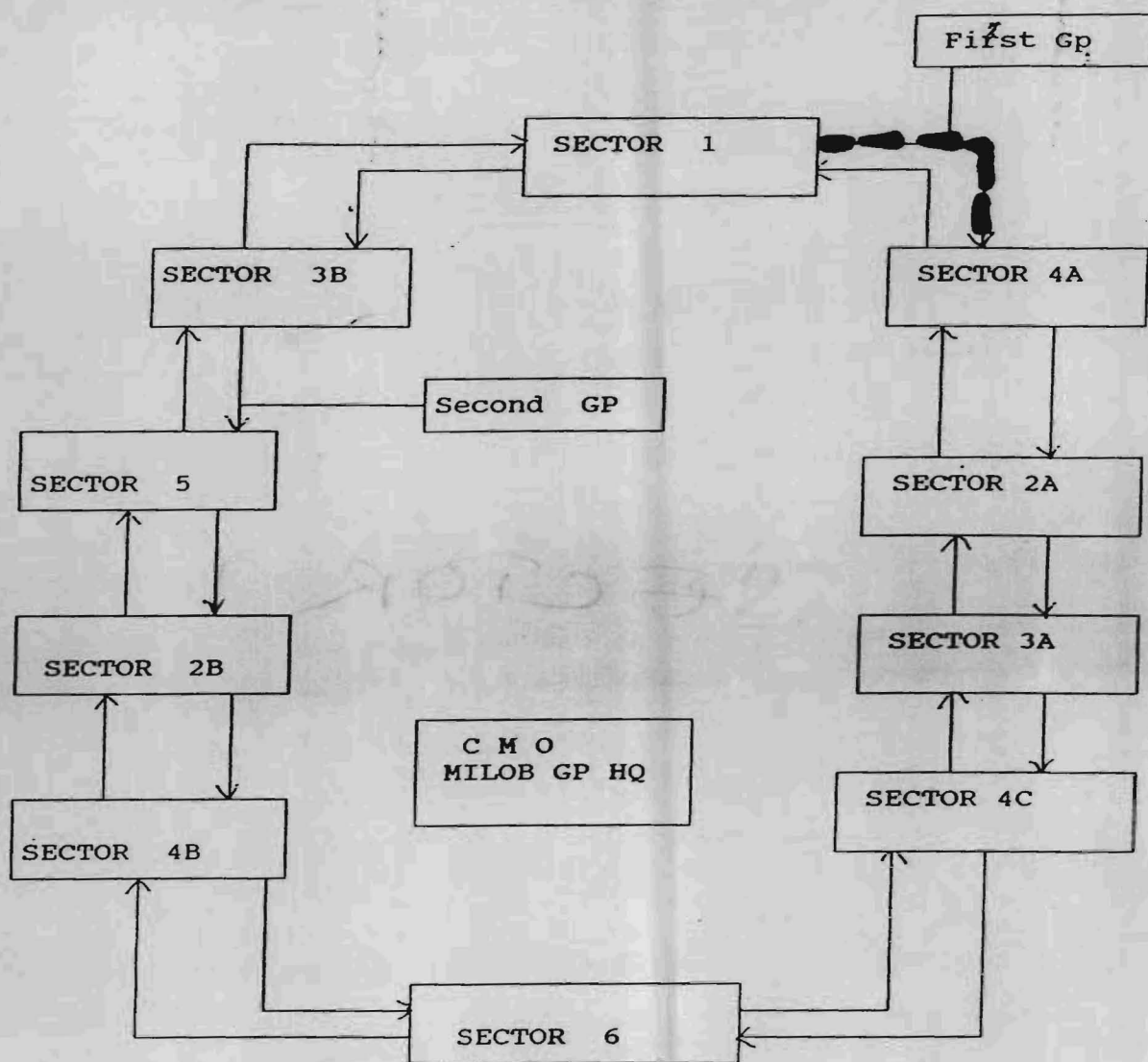
10. Postings shall be by balance of nationalities throughout the Sectors. MILOBs shall deploy with two or more of same nationality.

11. Appointment of individuals shall be balanced within Sectors basing on contingent strength.

ROTATIONS

12. After every four months, MILOBs shall rotate except when sanctioned by the CMO.

13. Within the first four months, half of the Sector MILOBs shall rotate to other Sectors while the other half remains on same station. After two months from first rotation the remaining half shall rotate. The MILOBs affected by first rotation shall then move after completing 4 months in Sector and so the circle continues.

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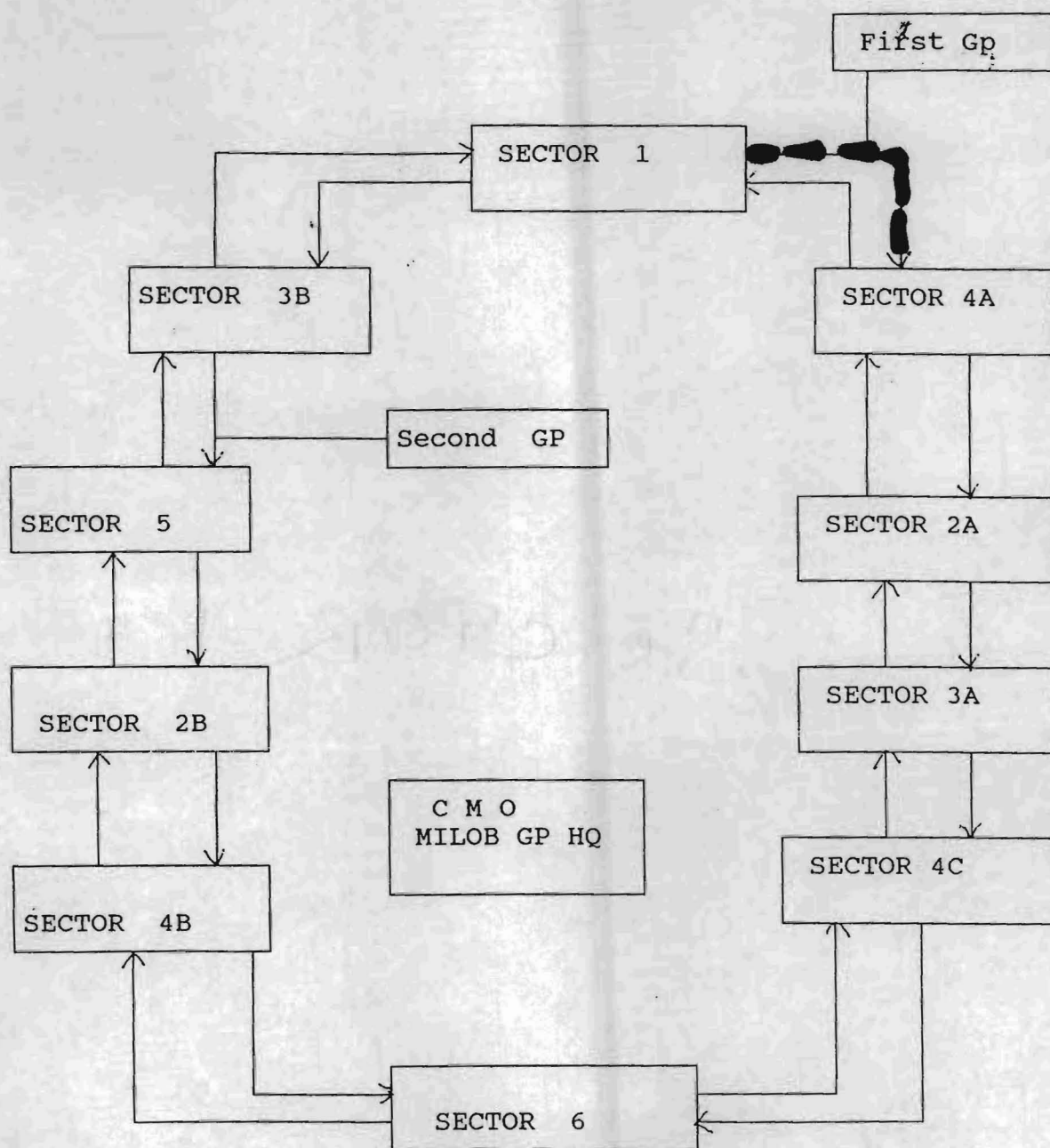
