SUBJ: SITREP NO.120 FROM 301800 TO 311800 DEC 94

1. GENERAL SITUATION. REMAINS UNSTABLE IN COMMUNES ALONG LAKESHORE, PARTICULARLY IN GAFUNZO AND KAGANO COMMUNES. IN LAST 24 HOURS THERE HAS BEEN FOUR ATTACKS OF ROBBERY AGAINST BUSINESSMEN IN KAGANO, ONE RAPE AND BEATING IN KAMEMBE. THE KAGANO ATTACKS RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF THREE PERSONS (CIV) AND INJURY OF 2 INFANTS AND ONE MAN. THERE IS ALSO REPORT OF PROBING/HARRASSING PATROLS BY RGF IN BOATS MOUNTED WITH HVY MG'S IN NORTHERN GAFUNZO PENINSULA. ALSO THE REPORT OF AN ATTACK(S) AGAINST RPA IN NORTHERN GAFUNZO OVER PAST WEEK. THE ENGAGEMENT OF ATTACKERS BY RPA IN GAFUNZO HAS SEEMINGLY GIVEN THE LOCALS CONFIDENCE IN RPA. THE OPPOSITE IS TRUE IN KAGANO COMMUNE.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA.

(1) RPA SEEN MOVING EQPT COVERED IN BACK OF PICKUP TRUCKS IN THE KAMEMBE AREA. EQPT NOT SEEN, BUT POSSIBLY MORTAR OR AA WPN.

(2) RPA ARE ACCUSED BY LOCAL WOMAN WHO WAS RAPED AND BEATEN ON 30 DEC IN NKANKA SECTEUR. THIS INFO RECV LATE TODAY AND HAS NOT YET BEEN ADDRESSED WITH RPA BY MILOBS. RPA ADMIT LACK OF PROPER BOATS FOR PATROLLING. RPA COY COMD ESTIMATES THAT ATTACKS BY RGF/INTERAHAMWE ARE ONLY HARRASSING IN NATURE AND ARE NOT OVERLY CONCERNED. NO INCREASE IN STRENGTH IN RPA IN GAFUNZO COMMUNE IS APPARENT. NO RECRUITING IN THE AREA IS OCCURRING. LOCALS IN GAFUNZO SEEM SATISFIED WITH RPA PRESENCE; CONVERSELY IN KAGANO COMMUNE AREA. LOCALS IN RWESERO SUBPREFECTURE AREA REPEAT THEIR DISATISFACTION WITH RPA AND REITERATE CLAIMS THEY ARE DOING NOTHING TO GIVE GOOD SECURITY. GAFUNZO COMMUNE CENTRE (GR 8935)- RPA COY 2IC NAME IS LT JOSEPH CONFIRMS REGULAR ATKS ON BUGEZA AREA (GR 9244). RPA HAVE RECENTLY INCREASED FOOT PATROLS AND REDISTRIBUTED MANPOWER IN AFFECTED AREAS. PL COMD ARE RANK OF SGT IN THIS AREA AND THROUGHOUT SECTOR 4C. COY-LIKE GROUPS ARE COMD BY LT/CAPT RANK. ONE COY-LIKE GROUP IS CENTERED ON GAFUNZO COMMUNE OFFICE AREA. NO LTR/NUMBER DESIGNATION AVAL. ONE RPA PL IS DEPLNORTH OF GAHABWA (GR 9142). ALL ACTIVITIES SEEM TO OCCUR NORTH OF THIS AREA. PL LDR HERE DOES NOT SPEAK ENGLISH OR FRENCH.

(3) RPA REPORTED THAT THEY WERE FIRED UPON FROM ZAIRE WITH SMALL ARMS FIRE IN AREA OF NYENJI GR 8007

B. RGF. CHEF DE SECTEUR, MR. EVARISTE KANIAMUKENKE, CFM RPA INFO OF REGULAR (ALMOST DAILY) ATTACKS PRIMARILY ON CIV TGTS ALONG WESTERN SHORE OF BUGEZA SECTEUR. ALL ATKS ARE CARRIED OUT BY PERSONS ARRIVING IN BOATS FROM ZAIRE. ATTACKERS WORE COMPLETE RGF UNIFORMS, COMPLETE WITH BERET, AND USE SMALL ARMS FIRE AND HAND

GRENADERS. THERE ARE THREE KNOWN OCCASIONS WHERE THEY WERE SUPPORTED BY HMG MOUNTED ON BOATS EQUIPPED WITH OUTBOARD MOTORS. DATES GATHERED WERE 17, 21 AND 24 DEC. IT IS LIKELY THAT THE BOATS ARE PADDED TO RWANDA, AND MOTORS USED FOR ESCAPE. ATK AGAINST RPA ON NORTHERN GAFUNZO PENINSULA REPORTED 29 DEC IS NOT PRECISELY CFM, HOWEVER ATKS OF CBT NATURE HAVE OCCURRED - DATES ARE LIKELY AS REPORTED ABOVE. NO EVIDENCE OF MORTARS HAS BEEN FOUND. ATTACKERS REPORTED TO HAVE TAKEN COWS AND FOOD SUPPLIES FROM HAMLETS.

C. MILITIA.

1. RGF/MILITIA/BANDITS -WHICH ONE IS UNCFM- CONDUCTED FOUR RAIDS ON LOCAL BUSINESSMEN IN KAGANO COMMUNE IN LAST 24 HRS. ALL OCCURRED IN MUBUMBANO SECTEUR (GR 0039). ALL ATTACKS OCCURED RELATIVELY SIMULTANEOUSLY AT APROX 0130 HRS 31 DEC, AND PROBABLY CONDUCTED BY ONE LARGE GROUP WHICH SPLIT UP FOR SEPARATE TGTS. ONE ATK AT HOME OF HABYRIYMANA, WHERE THEY TOOK ALL GOODS INCL FOOD. SECOND INCIDENT OCCURRED AT HOME OF MADZIMHAKA, WHERE AGAIN ALL WAS ROBBED INCL UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF MONEY, AND HE WAS SHOT IN THE NECK, BUT SURVIVED AND IS NOW IN SERIOUS COND IN NYAMASHEKE HOSP. OTHER INCIDENT OCCURED AT RES OF SHUMBUSHA, ALMOST ALL HOUSEHOLD GOODS, KILLED WIFE WITH RIFLE, WOUNDED ONE INFANT WITH MAHETE. HUSBAND REMAINS IN ZAIRE AS REFUGEE. LAST ATK WAS AT HOME OF HARINDANHWARI, WHERE BOTH HIM AND HIS WIFE WERE KILLED, AND THE BABY INJURED BY MACHETE. SHOTS WERE FIRED AS THEY RAN AWAY.

(2). WOMAN IN RUKIGULI 8514 WAS ATTACKED YESTERDAY BY TWO PERS. VICTIM RECOGNIZED THEM AS NEIGHBORS OF HER VILLAGE. VICTIM IS IN HOSP IN CYANGUGU WITH SERIOUS INJURYIES. TWO LADIES FROM KIZURA 9304 REPORTED THAT THEIR HUSBANDS WERE KIDNAPPED AFTERNOON OF 30 DEC BY FIVE PERS WHO WERE FORMALLY NEIGHBORS BEFOR THE WAR. THESE SAME FIVE PERS WERE LATER SEEN IN BUGARAMA CITE. HUSBANDS WHEREABOUTS ARE UNKNOWN. NAMES ARE AVAL AS REQR.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. PREFET OF CYANGUGU INVITED MILOBS AND NGO TO ATTEND RWANDAN CULTURAL EVENING IN KAMEMBE. INHABITANTS OF BUGEZA IS APPROX 6,000. GAFUNZO COMMUNE IS 42,000. ON MON 02 JAN 95 A MTG BETWEEN PREFET, THE BOUGEMEISTRE OF GAFUNZO AND SECTOR LDERS WILL BE HELD AT GAFUNZO COMMUNE CENTER TO DISCUSS LOC SECURITY SIT IN THE AREA. MILOBS 4C WILL ATTEND. BOUGEMEISTRE OF GAFUNZO IS VIATEUR KUBUISMANA. PREFET AND BOUGEMEISTER OF BUGARAMA VISITED ORPHANS AT RUAYO GR 8212.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. PHYSICALLY INVESTIGATED INCIDENT SITES IN KAGANO AND GAFUNZO COMMUNES. PATROLLED GISUMA AND BUGARAMA AND INFLUENCE AREA.

5. HUMANITARIAN. 80 REFUGEES TPT TODAY TO CYANGUGU FROM BUGARAMA. THERE ARE NO REMAINING REFUGEES AT BUGARAMA AT THIS TIME. AT NYAGATAREA TRANSIT CAMP, 300 PERS PRESENT 30 DEC, 484 ON 31 DEC.

6. LOGISTICS. REQ STATUS OF POLAROID CAMERAS FOR MILOB TMS AND CIVPOL. THESE SHOULD BE READILY AVAL IN UNAMIR SYSTEM.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] AND BY [REDACTED] OF BURUNDI NEAR BUGARAMA WHERE HEAVY FIGHTING BETWEEN BURUNDI GOVT FORCES AND GUERILLA FORCES HAVE OCCURRED ON 24 AND 27 DEC.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. [REDACTED] ES

[REDACTED] IN WHAT MAY BE A SEPARATE INCIDENT, RPA REPORT KILLING 16 PERS ON WATER LAST NIGHT IN ALSO IN NYAMASHEKE AREA.

B. RGF. SAME AS PARA 2C.

C. MILITIA. UNCFM, BUT MAY BE RESPONSIBLE FOR RAID IN NYAMASHEKE. GROUP HAD GRENADES AND SMALL ARM AUTO WPNS.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NTR

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. INVESTIGATION OF ENGAGEMENT AT NYAMASHEKE COMMENCED, BUT RPA MORE UNCOOPERATIVE THAN NORMAL AT PRESENT. CURRENT REPORT WILL BE FWD AND SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT AFTER MORE INFO AVAL. IT IS APPARENT THAT THE INSURGENTS CAME FROM THE ISLE OF IJWI, BUT NOT ALL MAY HAVE BEEN ABLE TO RTN DUE TO THE ENGAGEMENT. SOME MAY BE IN HIDING IN THE NORTHERN GAFUNZO COMMUNE AREA IN AREA OF MUGERA GRID 9438. MILOBS UNABLE TO PATROL THAT AREA TODAY, ACCESS IS ALSO DIFFICULT.

B. REPORTS FROM LOCALS AND RPA/GOVT SOURCES IN BUGARAMA INDICATE THAT BURUNDI GOVT FORCES HAVE BEEN ENGAGED IN HEAVY CLASHES WITH GUERILLA FORCES APPARENTLY SUPPORTED BY FORMER RGF AND INTERAHAMWE. FIGHTING OCCURRED 24 AND 27 DEC, NO CAS FIG AVAL. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS GUERILLA FORCE IS EXPERIENCED AND HAVE BEEN RELATIVELY SUCCESSFUL IN ITS MISSIONS OF LATE. COMMENT: IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THESE GUERILLA FORCES ARE TRYING TO ESTABLISH A FIRM BASE IN NORTHWEST BURUNDI FOR FUTURE OPERATIONS INTO RWANDA, AND UTILIZE (INDIRECTLY) ZAIRE BORDER NEAR BUGARAMA AS DETERRENT AGAINST RPA. IT IS CONSIDERED POSSIBLE THAT RPA LIKELY HAVE CONTINGENCY PLANS FOR RAIDS INTO BOTH ZAIRE AND BURUNDI IF SECUR SIT IN RWANDA IS SEVERELY THREATENED FROM OTHER BORDERS.

C. PICKED UP UNANNOUNCED UNAMIR PRESS TEAM THAT WANTED TO VISIT WITH ETHIOBAT AND MILOBS CYANGUGU. PRESS TM DEP WITH NO PHOTOS AND NO INFO.

D. TPT PREFET OF CYANGUGU FROM HEL AT KAMEMBE AIRPORT TO PREFECTURE. VISITED CYIMBOGO DISPENSARE. ALL PREVIOUS REMAINING

REFUGEE TENTS HAVE BEEN REMOVED.

E. TM LOC IN NYAMASHEKE HAVE MOVED RES AND OFFICE TO DIFFERENT FACILITY STILL IN NYAMASHEKE AREA. POSN OF TM THERE IS PROVING BENEFICIAL.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

A. REHAB OF KAMEMBE HOSP FACILITY BY NORWEIGAN PEOPLES AID (NPA) IS ON SCHEDULE. MORE BUILDING CURRENTLY OCCUPIED BY ETHIOBAT WILL HAVE TO BE VACATED IN MID JAN 95 AS WORK EXPANDS.

B. SECTOR COMD MET YESTERDAY WITH DELAGATION CHIEF OF ICRC AND DISCUSSED ASPECTS OF COORD AND ASSISTANCE IN EFFORTS.

C. 56 PERS TPT TO CYANGUGU TODAY FROM BUGARAMA. 104 PRESENTLY REMAIN. NO REFUGEE CROSSING FIGURES AVAL TODAY.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. NO CHANGE. POPULATION REMAINS TENSE IN NORTHERN COMMUNES.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. DUE TO THE NOTABLE NUMBER OF RPA VEH AND OFFICERS SEEN IN KAMEMBE TODAY, IT IS ASSUMED THAT RPA CONDUCTED A LARGE MEETING AMONGST RPA OFFICIALS. INFO IS STILL BEING SOUGHT.

C. MILITIA.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. PATROLLED BUGARAMA CITE, GISHOMA GR 8211 AND ALONG BURUNDI BORDER; GISAKURA GR 9829 AND THROUGH FOREST; CYANGUGU TOWN AREA. SIT WAS NORMAL, EXCEPT FOR ADDITIONAL OFFICERS AND VEH SEEN OF RPA IN CYANGUGU.

B. NORMAL CROSSING ACTIVITY AT RUZIZI ONE. TWO BATWA TRIBE PERS CROSSED INTO ZAIRE TODAY AFTER ONE AND ONE HALF MONTH JOURNEY FROM GIKONGORO AREA AND THROUGH FOREST. BOTH WERE ADAMANT OF SEEKING REFUGE IN ZAIRE DUE TO FEAR OF BECOMING A VICTIM OF VIOLENCE IN RWANDA.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

A. ATTENDED BI-MONTHLY GEN MEETING CHAIRED BY UNREO. HAC OFFR PRESENTED LOC GEN SECUR SIT AND ANSWERED QUESTIONS. UNHCR DISCUSSED GEN DETAILS OF REHABILITATION PLAN IF THE NUMBERS OF EXPECTED RETURNING AND NEW REFUGEES INTO RWANDA OVER THE NEXT SIX MONTHS ARE ACCURATE. THE HUB OF THE PLAN IS BASED ON OPEN RELIEF CENTRES IN EACH COMMUNE. TPT FOR MURURU CAMP WILL LIKELY CEASE FRIDAY. THE APPROX 70 PERS REMAINING HAVE BEEN OFFERED TPT BEFORE, BUT NEGLECTED TO BOARD. ATTENDEES EXPRESSED INTEREST IN UNDERSTANDING AIM/MISSION OF CIVPOL NOW IN CYANGUGU. CIVPOL APPEAR NOT FULLY OPERATIONAL AND HAD AGAIN DEPARTED TO KIGALI. REQ INFO ON MANDATE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF UNCIVPOL THAT CAN BE ISSUED AS REQ. UNREO RECOMMENDS PLANNING COMMENCE FOR REHAB OF TELECON AND MAIL SERVICE. WATER PLANT IN CYANGUGU STILL NOT FULLY OPERATIONAL DUE TO LACK OF SPARE PARTS, AND WORKERS NOT YET BEING PAID FOR MONTH OF NOV. UNREO TO ADDRESS THIS PROBLEM WITH UNICEF KIGALI.

B. UNHCR AND OTHER AGENCIES HAVE EXPRESSED A NEED FOR LTD AMOUNT OF COMBAT RATIONS FOR CONTINGENCY/EMERGENCY SIT. THE AMOUNT IS MINIMAL CONSIDERING STAFFS ARE NORMALLY APPROX 5 PERS AND APPROX

ONE TO TWO WEEKS SUP WOULD BE REQ. MILOB HQ REQ TO INVESTIGATE POSSIBILITY OF ISSUE FROM UNAMIR HQ CONTINGENT SUP. ADVISE.

C. 300 REFUGEES WERE TPT FROM NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP TO KIGALI. REMAINING STRENGTH IS NOW 623. 50 REFUGEES WERE TPT TO CYANGUGU FROM BUGARAMA. REMAINING STRENGTH IS 45.

D. TOTAL 35 REFUGEES CROSSED INTO RWANDA VIA RUZIZI ONE.

6. LOGISTICS.

A. MILOB AND SOME NGO AGENCIES SHOULD HAVE LTD STOCK OF COMBAT RATIONS AVAL FOR EMERGENCY PURPOSES. ADVISE ON AVAILABILITY AND SUBSEQUENT COORD ASAP. THIS APPLIES TO MAINLY MILOBS LOCATED IN SECTOR 4C, 4B AND SECTOR 5.

B. ADVISE ON AVAILABILITY OF JERRY CANS FOR FUEL STORAGE IN SUBSECTORS OF SECTOR 4C.

C. REQ TOW CABLES FOR ALL VEH IN 4C, REQ FLAGPOLE AND UN FLAG AND FLAG LIGHT FOR NIGHT.

D. VEH 1070 DUE SOON FOR "C" MAINT. WITH VEH 1077 REMAINING IN WORKSHOP FOR SEVERAL MORE WEEKS, AND 1070 AWAY FOR ONE WEEK FORM DUTIES, AT LEAST ONE TEMP REPL VEH IS REQ IN SECTOR 4C. WITH THE NUMBER OF MILOBS NOW POSTED IN 4C TOGETHER WITH MAINT, PERS CTO TPT REQ, OUR LTD TPT ABILITY CAN NOT COPE WITH THE DEMAND. SUBJ: SITREP NO. 116 FROM 261800 TO 271800 DEC 94

1. GENERAL SITUATION. POPULATION REMAINS TENSE, PARTICULARLY IN NORTHERN EDGE OF KAMEMBE AND GISUMA COMMUNES. BANDITRY INCIDENT YESTERDAY AND KILLING OF TWO MEN LAST NIGHT MAINTAIN THE LOCAL INSTABILITY.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. PRESENCE BEING MAINTAINED AT BURUNDI BORDER AREA AND GIKUNDAMVURA AREA (GR 9309). LOC POPULATION APPEARS SATISFIED WITH RPA SECURITY. STRENGTH IS ESTIMATED AT APPROX 50 SOLDIERS IN THIS AREA, AND NO WEAPONS OTHER THAN PERSONAL WEAPONS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED LATELY.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NTR

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. INVESTIGATED AN INCIDENT OF TWO MEN WHO WERE KILLED WITH RIFLE FIRE BY MEN DRESSED IN MILITARY UNIFORM. KILLING OCCURRED AT MURAMBA GR 8132 ON EVENING OF 26 DEC AT APPROX 2200 HRS. APPROX 38000 AMAFRANGA AWAS TAKEN ALONG WITH A RADIO. THE TWO WIVES OF THE TWO VICTIMS WERE WITNESSES AND WERE INTERVIEWED BY MILOB AND UN HUMAN RIGHTS MONITOR. BOTH VICTIMS WERE KILLED BY A SINGLE BULLET; ONE TO THE HEAD, THE OTHER IN THE NECK. ONLY ONE OF THE MEN HAD BEEN TIED WITH HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK. DETAILS OF THIS INCIDENT WILL BE FORWARDED SEPARATELY. RPA OFFICIALS DEPARTED BEFORE MILOB ARRIVAL. TWO RPA SOLDIERS WHO REMAINED WERE CONVINCED TO LEAVE THE SCENE BEFORE MILOB INVESTIGATION COMMENCED IN PRIVATE WITH THE SPOUSES OF THE VICTIMS.

B. PATROLLED CYANGUGU AREA AND SUBURB; BUGARAMA CITE TO BURUNDI BORDER AND UP TO GIKUNDAMVURA (9309); KIRAMBO (0444) TO RUKONO (0847), TO GATARE (1345). SIT FOUND TO BE NORMAL.

C. ATTENDED TO ACCIDENT SITE OF UN WFP LANDCRUISER VEH (UNWFP04) OPERATED BY LOCAL WFP LEADER MR. SYLDIO USENGUMUREMYI. ACCIDENT OCCURED APPROX 1000 METRES DOWNHILL FROM KAMEMBE STADIUM. NO SERIOUS INJURIES, BUT VEH WAS HEAVILY DAMAGED AFTER IT SOMERSAULTED. CIVPOL WERE LATER PRESENT ON THE SCENE AND THEY PREDICT EXCESSIVE SPEED AS A FACTOR IN THE ACCIDENT.

5. HUMANITARIAN.





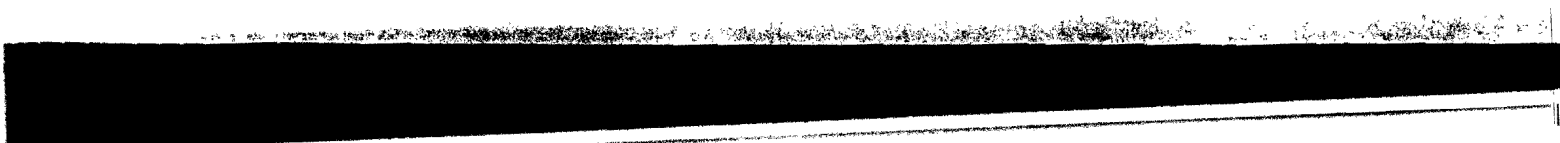
