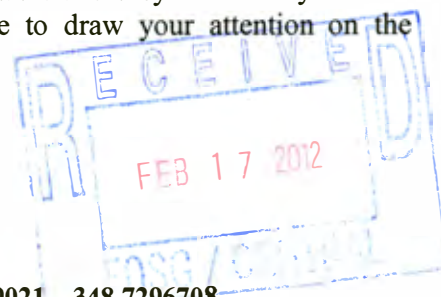

Your Excellency,

The Italian Committee of Parliamentarians and Citizens for a Free Iran has been informed that the first 400 Iranian refugees currently in Ashraf are ready to move to the temporary location in Camp Liberty. They agreed to take this decision with their leadership in order to show their good will for a peaceful and mutually accepted solution of issue; however, they are aware – as is the whole international community – that the portion of Camp Liberty Iraqi authorities have reserved for them does not fit any acceptable human rights standard.

Recalling that the United Nations bears Responsibility to Protect all the unarmed Ashraf refugees, until the UNHCR will have completed its process of recognizing their individual status and they will finally be able to reach third countries, we would like to draw your attention on the following points:

- Camp Liberty should not be like a prison. The residents should have the possibility to leave the camp and return, in particular to visit the hospital outside;

- Iraqi police should not be stationed inside the camp, as this would inevitably increase the tension;

- Lawyers, doctors and other persons requested by the residents should be able to access the camp;

- UNAMI and UNHCR should strictly monitor the situation of the camp and ensure the full respect of the lives, rights and dignity of each and all of the residents.

We are looking forward to receiving positive news about the issue.
