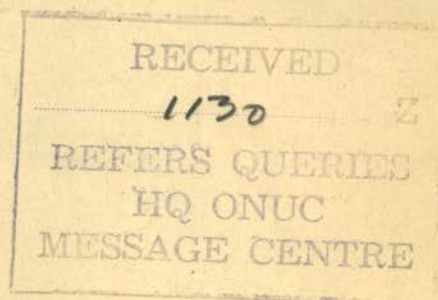

At 1800 we met in camp area at request local European with Oscar Mokobito, claiming to represent Kashamura, and Murri, Italian resident who was on Kivu economic mission to Kampala last month, who mainly listened to our talk. Purpose of meeting was to propose ONUC take over Orientale frontier to prevent Stan forces entering Kivu and overthrowing provincial Govt. Asked us take steps immediately to cover river ^{route} ~~route~~, road Stan to Walikale and road Bunia to Beni. Mokobito stated no fear invasion from Buanda, Katanga or Kasai as those areas friendly, only from Orientale. Admitted partial independence of Kivu was objective. He compares ONUC action requested ~~by~~ ^{by} him to ONUC neutral zones Katanga and Kasai. Mokobito said Kashamura can rely ANC Rumengabo Goma Bagirs and hale Sain i.e. most eastern Kivu, also most Maniema ANC. This may tie in with our BUKA 24. States present provincial government as per my Bule 172 was appointed to quieten Stan by inclusion some MNC representatives but next government will disarm AANNCC and have ONUC train them. We pointed out our missions are defence international frontier and protection minorities currently illtreated. Could only take on new task when these task accomplished satisfactorily. To assist us, we needed Mokobito to help us rent local transport, travel freely in province without ANC halting, guarantee use local airfields. Also he must prevent ANC interfering Europeans and let us assemble them for protection. Mokobito agreed to do these but it remains to be seen if he can or will. instruct us should we continue negotiate Mokobito and what hope can we offer to deploy on threeroutes from Stan. If genuine fear exists of civil conflict Stan/Kivu, our presence could have deterrent effect. If he hopes ONUC cooperation, he may help us on protection mission. While we not hopeful any useful result these talks, they may obtain us larger measure provincial govt cooperation. As earnest his good faith we ~~asked~~ ^{asked} Mokobito arrange to have 10 civil trucks available our call as

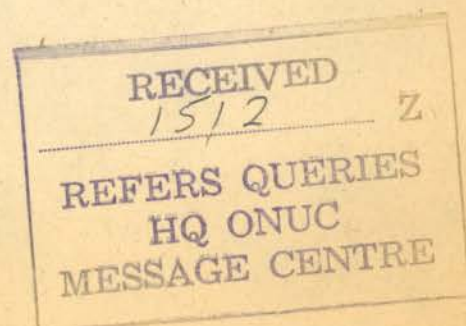

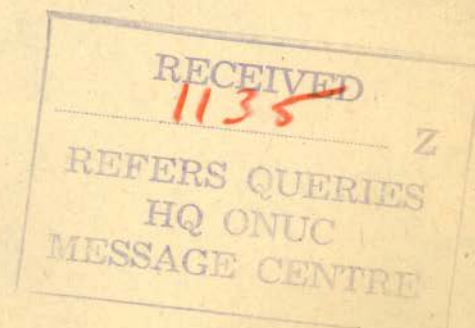

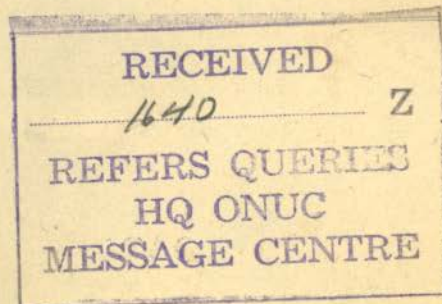
