women and men from Kibizi sector were repairing the road again  
to the commune office.

B. 1x NIOB team escorted Force Engvs. team to rescue the bus  
(62-601979) in NYAKIBU commune in response to our request  
made last 15 JUN 95.

C. 1x NIOB team patrolled KUNASHYA (62-6926), sit. was reported  
calm with locals carrying out community work, including

agriculture and roadwork. Area around KAPUGUMYA (GR 7031) largely abandoned with one abandoned school, 10% of houses occupied and less than 10% of fields being worked.

D. 1x MILIB team patrolled MUYIRA (GR 8639), sit. was reported calm with various agricultural activities going on.

##### 5. HUMANITARIAN:

A. Bourguemestre of NYARUHENGIRI (GR 7607) reported that CONCERN has stopped it's assistance in the commune since the incident which took place on 12 May 95. He also reported that there are 300 orphans in the commune, and between May and June about 1000 returnees came back home.

B. In KIBANGU sector, NYAKIZU commune (GR 9694) the judgment of cattle robbery was undertaken by the Sector Leader with the presence of the locals of his sector.

C. At RUHASHYA (GR 6926) AICF/USA clinic was carrying pre + post natal exams. Bourguemestre Mr. Silas and his assistant accompanied MILIB patrol in order to point out bridges. Of 10 bridges seen only 2 require work (GR 678243) and (GR 7131).

D. At MUYIRA (GR 8639) since OXFAM and WFP have stopped assisting with the water supply this is now the main problem.

A. The Local authorities in Butare are requesting the use of UNAMIR low loader to uplift their bulldozer from GIKONGORO to Butare any day this week; requested by MILIBS sector 3B, yesterday 24 July 95 by fax, no answer received yet.

PATIENTS PER DAY. CLINIC ALSO HAS GOT NO  
WATER SUPPLY AND FOOD FOR PATIENTS. AT  
SIMBI SECTEUR, MEDICAL CENTRE IS BEING  
RUN BY AICF-USA (NGO) SUPPORTED BY  
CARITAS (NGO).

6. CIVIL AFFAIR, IN MARABA ~~SECTION~~ COMMUNE  
LOCAL HAVE ORGANISED SELF-HELP ROAD  
REHABILITATION PROJECT AND ARE ALREADY WORKING  
ON THE MANY ROAD USING LOCAL MATERIALS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITY: MILOB TEAMS

RUSATIRA GR 7431, RUHASHYA GR 7026,

RETURNEES TRANSIT CAMP. SITUATION  
REPORTED CALM IN ALL THE AREAS  
WITH BANDITRY WHICH WAS RIFE IN  
RUNYINHA REPORTEDLY DRASTICALLY REDUCED.  
SINCE THE CLOSURE OF KIBEHO IDP  
CAMP.

5. HUMANITARIAN:

A. ASST BOURGMESTRE AT RUNYINHA REPORTED  
THAT WFP HAS SINCE JUNE 1995 CEASED  
FOOD DISTRIBUTION THEREBY CAUSING HUNGER  
AMONG LOCALS WHO HAD POOR HARVEST  
LAST SEASON. ICRC FOUND VISITING  
COMMUNE PRISON TO CHECK ON CONDITION  
OF PREMISES AND INMATES. MSF CEASED  
OPERATION AT KARAMA CLINIC AND THE  
CATHOLIC SISTERS NOW IN CHARGE HAVE  
INADQUATE DRUGS AND NO BEDS FOR THE  
MATERNITY WING.

B. AT KABILIZI RETURNEES TRANSIT CAMP  
450 PEOPLE INCLUDING CHILDREN ARE STILL  
MAROONED THERE WITHOUT FOOD OR  
WATER. THESE RETURNEES ARE ALL  
FROM GIKONGORO PREFECTURE AND  
ARE READY TO MOVE AS SOON AS



TRANSPORT IS MADE AVAILABLE. IT WAS OBSERVED THAT UNLESS FOOD AND WATER IS MADE AVAILABLE WHILST THEIR TRANSPORT IS BEING ARRANGED THE CAMP WILL START EXPERIENCING DEATHS ESPECIALLY AMONG CHILDREN FROM STARVATION. MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION SHOULD BE INFORMED TO QUICKLY SOLVE THE PLIGHT OF THESE RETURNEES AS A MATTER OF URGENCY. KABILIZI HOSPITAL RUN BY AICF-USA (NGO) LACKS HAS INADQUATE BEDS TO CATER FOR ADMISSIONS AND ALSO GOT NO WATER SINCE UNICEF CEASED SUPPLY TO THE PLACE.

C. WATER SUPPLY AT RUSATIRA IS JUST AWAITING FOR WATER PUMP TAKEN TO KIGALI FOR REPAIRS BY CARITAS (NGO). INSPECTOR OF SCHOOLS IN THE AREA REVEALED THAT FEED THE CHILDREN (NGO) WHO HELPED REHABILITATE THE EIGHT (08) PRIMARY SCHOOLS CONTINUE DOING SO. SCHOOLS HAVE TOTAL ENROLLMENT OF 3,177 PUPILS WITH 54 TEACHERS 32 WHO ARE UNQUALIFIED. TEACHERS ARE IRREGULARLY PAID AT TIMES GOING WITHOUT SALARY. ALL THE SCHOOLS LACK TEACHING AIDS.

D. TO REHABILITATE EX-IDPS AND RETURNEES IN RUHASHYA COMMUNE, THERE 128 HOUSES TO BE RENOVATED AND 536 NEW HOUSES TO BE BUILT WHICH REQUIRES CEMENT, ROOFING SHEETS AND WINDOWS. THE COMMUNE PRISON WAS FOUND TO BE OVER CROWDED WITH INMATES LIVING IN UNHUMAN CONDITIONS HENCE BOURGMESTRE REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT TO TRANSFER TO NYAZA PRISON IN NYABISINDU COMMUNE. DOCKETS FOR PRISONERS ARE READY AND COORDINATION WITH NYAZA PRISON DIRECTOR ALREADY DONE.

6. CIVIL AFFAIR, ALL OKAY WITH NORMAL SOCIAL AND COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES TAKING PLACE THROUGH-OUT THE PREFECTURE. HOWEVER AT KABILIZI RETURNEES TRANSIT CAMP 450 RETURNEES FOUND STARVING AND WITHOUT WATER FOR THE PAST THREE - WEEKS AND ANY DELAY IN THE SUPPLY OF THE TWO ITEMS WILL RESULT IN DEATHS.

A. **RPA:** CONTINUE WITH THEIR ROUTINE PATROLS IN BUTARE TOWN, HOME COMMUNES, UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, MANNING OF CHECK POINTS AND PRISONS. ALSO CONTINUE WITH PHYSICAL PRESENCE AT BORDER POSTS.

B. **RGE:** NIL REPORTED IN THE SECTOR.

C. **MILITIA:** NIL REPORTED IN THE SECTOR.

4. **OWN MILITARY ACTIVITY:** PATROLS SENT TO NYABISINDU GR 7138, MUGUSA GR 8426, MUYAGA GR 9026, GISHAMVU GR 6505, BUTARE WAY STATION AND REMABILITATION CENTRE. SITUATION IN ALL THE AREAS REPORTED CALM. IN GISHAMVU'S SHEKE SECTOR CONSELLOR TOOK EM-5 MILOB TEAM ON A CONDUCTED TOUR OF HIS AREA AND MET LOCAL RPA COMMANDER WHO REPORTED SITUATION TO BE CALM WITH GREAT REDUCTION OF BANDITRY ACTIVITIES.

5. **HUMANITARIAN:**

A. **BOURGMESTRE KIGEMBE COMMUNE GR 7093** REPORTS RECEIVING BETWEEN 100 AND 150 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI PER DAY AND THAT FROM 13 JUNE 1995 TOTAL 3242 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI MOST OF THEM ON FOOT REPORTED TO THE COMMUNE. SIXTY (60) FAMILIES MOST OF THEM GENOCIDE SUSPECTS FROM BURUNDI ONLY STAY AT THEIR HOUSES DURING THE DAY AND SPEND NIGHT'S AT REFUGEES CENTRE ESTABLISHED TO CATER FOR PEOPLE NOT SURE OF THEIR SECURITY.

B. **AT BUTARE WAY STATION** 164 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AND ZAIRE WERE FOUND, HOWEVER IOM TRANSPORTED 45 TO MUYAGA COMMUNE AND 14 TO MUGUSA COMMUNE TODAY WHILST REMAINDER AWAIT DOCUMENTATION BEFORE BEING TRANSPORTED TO VARIOUS HOME COMMUNES.

C. 2480 CHILDREN INCLUDING TEN GIRLS ARE AT THE REHABILITATION CENTRE AND MANY MORE ARE EXPECTED FROM OTHER RPA UNITS. SCHOOL IS EXPERIENCING PROBLEM DUE TO LACK OF BOOKS, DESKS AND WATER SUPPLY.

D. AT MUYAGA 45 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI WERE BROUGHT BY IOM. CARITAS HAVE SINCE 19 JULY 1995 BEEN DISTRIBUTING FOOD STAFFS TO 1300 PEOPLE FROM TWO SECTEURS. HOSPITAL AT GAKOMA SECTEUR REHABILITATED BY MSF OPENED ITS OPERATION ON 17 JULY 1995 BUT LACKS BEDS, TABLES AND ELECTRICITY, OXFAM (NGO) MEANWHILE IS WORKING ON THE WATER SYSTEM.

E. AT NYABISINDU CRS (NGO) DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO 83 IDENTIFIED POOR FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNE. SCHOOLS IN THE AREA LACK QUALIFIED TEACHERS AND TEACHING MATERIALS.

6. CIVIL AFFAIRS: ALL OKAY WITH NORMAL SOCIAL AND COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES GOING ON THROUGHOUT THE PREFECTURE.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITY: PATROLS WERE SENT TO MBAZI GR 7117, SHYANDA GR 7718, NYAKIZU GR 5796 AND KANYARU-HAUTE BORDER POST GR 6291 AND REPORTED SITUATION AS CALM IN ALL THE AREAS. MANY LOCALS OBSERVED ENGAGED IN AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES WHICH REPORTEDLY IS ON THE INCREASE IN ALL THE HOME COMMUNES PATROLLED.



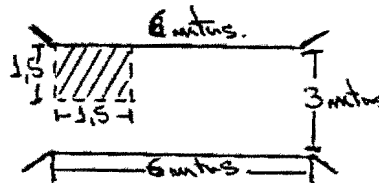

IOM IS PROVIDING TRANSPORT TO VARIOUS PREFECTURES AND COMMUNES BUT DELAY IN FINISHING THE EXERCISE IS DUE TO ABSENCE OF AN OFFICIAL FROM MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION WHO IS GOVT AGENT SUPPOSED TO GIVE GO AHEAD OF RETURNEES AND IDPs LEAVING THE STATION.

D. RUNYINYA (GR 6012): SITUATION REPORTED CALM. AT RUKARA SECTOR COUNSELLOR BRIEFED TEAM OF AN ACUTE SHORTAGE OF FARMING IMPLEMENTS AND INPUTS AND THAT POPULATION OF SECTOR HAS INCREASED TO 2,900 SINCE CLOSURE OF IDP CAMPS IN APRIL 1995. RUNYINYA-KIBEHO ROAD IS IN VERY POOR CONDITION AND REQUIRED REPAIRS. 470 PRISONERS MOSTLY 1994 GENOCIDE ACCUSED ARE HELD AT COMMUNE PRISON AND THERE HAVE BEEN NO RELEASED. PRISON IS CONGESTED AND CONDITION POOR FOR HUMAN HABITATION VERY POOR, BUT BOURGMESTRE TOLD TEAM THAT AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN TOLD BUT NOTHING HAS BEEN DONE.
