(1) TEAM: PATROLLED KIGOMBE AND NYAKINAMA COMMUNES. SITUATION IS CALM IN BOTH COMMUNES.

KIGOMBE: TEAM VISITED SALEM RWANDA ORPHANAGE. THE TEAM WAS TOLD THAT SALEM RWANDA KEEPS CHILDREN WHOSE PARENT'S LOCATION IS NOT KNOWN. SAVE THE CHILDREN AND ICRC AFTER LOCATING THE PARENTS ADVISE SALEM RWANDA WHO WILL THEN HAND OVER THE CHILDREN TO THE PARENTS. CURRENTLY THEY HAVE 35 CHILDREN. SINCE AUG 95, 37 CHILDREN REUNITED WITH THEIR FAMILIES. THEY INTEND TO CONDUCT VOCATIONAL TRAINING FOR THE CHILDREN IN THE NEAR FUTURE. APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE HAVE BEEN FORWARDED TO UNDP. THE CENTRE ENCOUNTERS PROBLEMS OF CHAIRS/BENCHES FOR CLASSROOMS, BEDS AND CLOTHING FOR CHILDREN. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED THE ORPHANAGE OF HEART OF MARY. THE CENTRE WAS UNDER REHABILITATION FOR SOME TIME. IT WAS COMPLETED AND INAUGURATED TODAY. THERE ARE 199 CHILDREN AND 43 WORKERS. THEY HAVE THE PROBLEMS OF TRANSPORT AND SALARY FOR THE WORKERS. BOTH CENTRES ARE IN MUHOZA SECTOR GR 6034. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED KARWAZA VILLAGE GR 643 565 WHERE 58 HECTARES HAVE BEEN CLEARED FOR RESETTLEMENT FOR 59/60 RETURNEES. ARP IS ASSISTING THE RETURNEES. CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSES HAS ALREADY STARTED.

NYAKINAMA: THE TEAM VISITED A PRIMARY SCHOOL IN MUKO SECTOR GR 5828. THE SCHOOL HAS 1164 PUPILS AND 19 TEACHERS. THEY RECEIVE SALARY REGULARLY. THEY HAVE PROBLEMS OF DESKS, BROKEN CLASSROOM

DOORS AND TOILETS.

(2) TEAM: PATROLLED NKUMBA AND KINIGI COMMUNES. SITUATION IS CALM.

Info { NKUMBA: THE BOURGEMESTRE HELD A SECURITY MEETING WITH COUNCILLORS AND RPA LOCAL COMD. DETAILS OF MEETING NOT KNOWN. THE COMMUNE HAS WATER PROBLEMS. THE NEAREST PLACE TO COLLECT WATER FROM THE COMMUNE OFFICES IS 10 KMS. SOME PEOPLE SELL WATER AT 50 FRANCS PER JERRICANE. THE COMMUNE PROPOSES TO RESETTLE PEOPLE AS FOLLOWS: GATETE SECTOR GR 6240-59 HECTARES, RUTAMBA SECTOR GR 6742-2 HECTARES, NYANGA SECTOR GR 3870-150 HECTARES AND GITINDA SECTOR GR 6337 -130 HECTARES. EACH FAMILY WILL BE ALLOCATED 1 HECTARE. IN GATETE SECTOR, A PRIMARY SCHOOL WAS COMPLETELY DESTROYED DURING THE WAR. FORMER DRINKING PLACES ARE NOW USED AS CLASSROOMS. THE PUPILS FEEL ABANDONED. THE HEADMASTER IS REQUESTING FOR ASSISTANCE TO REHABILITATE THE SCHOOL.

KINIGI: THE COMMUNE HAS PROBLEMS OF WATER. THE BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED THE TEAM THAT ON 11 OCT THERE WILL BE A MEETING WHICH HE HAS INVITED MILOBS, ICRC, MSF AND UNHCR.

COMMENT: THE REHABILITATION OF THE WATER SYSTEM COVERING NKULI, MUKINGO, KINIGI, NKUMBA AND KIDAHU COMMUNES REQUIRES MORE URGENT ATTENTION IN ORDER TO DELIVER WATER TO THE PEOPLE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

NOT MALARIA. 4 PEOPLE HAVEE BEEN ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH
POISONING.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

a. SECTOR HQ: CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE TEAMS.

b. TEAMS:

(1) TEAM: PATROLLED CYERU AND BUTARO COMMUNES. SITUATION WAS CALM IN BOTH COMMUNES.

CYERU: TEAM VISITED MUSASA SECTOR GR 7435. WFP IS BUILDING 2 PRIMARY SCHOOLS AT NDAGO GR 7938 AND MUSASA GR 7435. IT ALSO CONDUCTS FOOD FOR WORK PROGRAMMES. IN RUGENDEBARE SECTOR GR 7630, LOCALS MARKED AN AREA SUSPECTED TO BE A MINE FIELD. THE COMMUNE STAFF WERE ADVISED OF THIS LOCATION BY THE LOCALS. IT WAS REPORTED THAT IN AUGUST A CIVILIAN SUSTAINED INJURIES AFTER DETONATING A MINE, HE WAS TREATED IN RUHENGERI AND IS NOW BACK AT HIS HOME. WORLD VISION DISTRIBUTED 1000 HOES TO THE COMMUNE TODAY. IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE COMMUNE HAS 238 WATER POINTS 102 OF WHICH ARE NOT FUNCTIONING. THE IPJ HAS RECEIVED A MOTORCYCLE, TYPEWRITER AND FURNITURE FROM RUHENGERI PREFECTURE. SEBAZUNGU WAS ARRESTED ON 15 SEP FOR SMUGGLING WOLFRANG ACROSS THE BORDER.

BUTARO: IT IS REPORTED THAT 159 FAMILIES RETURNED IN AUG AND SEP. THEIR HOUSES WERE DESTROYED DURING THE WAR. THEY REQUIRE ASSISTANCE IN BUILDING MATERIAL. THE IPJ RECEIVED A MOTORCYCLE FROM THE PREFECTURE. THERE WAS A VACCINATION PROGRAMME AT BUTARO

MSF HOSPITAL.

LIVING WITH FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNE. THESE NEED ASSISTANCE. SALEM
RWANDA WILL BE ADVISED.

MUKINGO: IN GARAGA SECTOR GR 5030 THE CONCILLOR REPORTED THAT 20
RETURNEES WHO CAME BACK ON 23 AUG FROM ZAIRE REQUIRE ASSISTANCE
IN FOOD AND BUILDING MATERIAL SINCE THEY FOUND THEIR PROPERTY
DESTROYED.

g. team 6. the team was tasked to patrol musebeya commune [4038]. the team was asked to investigate a mine accident at gr [3937], a location which is approximately 4 kms from the musebeya commune office. the accident took place at approximately 1000hrs on 26 sept 95 when an icrc team has been severely injured the veh has been thrown approximately 10 mtrs from the site of the accident and front portion of the vehicle has been severely damaged . the site was also visited by the capt gasana from the rpa . the milobs also assisted to locate and inform a human rights team which was operating in the area of the accident . the vehicle is still at the accident site . the rpa have placed a guard over the vehicle to protect the property. icrc has confirmed that they have recovery resources at butare which would recover the vehicle.

10. sector commanders assessment: the mine incident in the sector is without precedence. musebeya commune is characterized by movement of persons into and out of the commune. about 17 returnees have come into the commune from zaire since aug 95. this commune also has a large number of idps who have not yet returned to their home commune since the closure of the 4 idp camps in the prefecture. the process of return of the idps to their home commune has commenced recently, under the aegis of unhcr. the musebeya- muko road on which the

device was planted is frequently used by un agencies and ngos. there is an rpa camp at approxmiately 10 kms from the site of the accident . the nature of the damage to the vehicle indicates that the mine was an antitank mine or an improvised explosive device having a lethality akin to that of an anti -tank mine. it is quite unlikely that the device could have been brought into the countary by the returnees since they have all come into the commune via the nyagatare transit camp. the possiblities are that there are cachets existing in the are where from the device could have been recovered and used. it is also possible that there are some returnees who have notcome through the unhcr channel and are not known to the authorities. the device could have been planted by the returnees orthe idps who are sympATHETIC TO THE CAUSE OF THE FORMER GOVERNMENT . DIALOGUE WITH THE RPA HAS ALSO INDICATED THAT THIS COMMUNE WAS DOMINATE BY THE RGF.

b. TEAMS:

(1) TEAM: PATROLLED KIDAHO COMMUNE. SITUATION CALM. THE BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED THE TEAM THAT OUT OF ALL THE SECTORS, ONLY BUTETE SECTOR GR 7145 HAS DRINKING WATER. BY 28 AUG 95 ONLY 8 RETURNEES WERE REPORTED. 3 CAME THROUGH CYANIKA AND 5 THROUGH GISENYI. THE COMMUNE STAFF HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE JANUARY 95. THE WORKERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE DECEMBER 94. IN BUTETE SECTOR, AT A PROTESTANT CHURCH ARE 7 CHILDREN BEING CARED FOR BY THE CHURCH. IN KAGOGO SECTOR GR7447 ARE A PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS COLOCATED. THEY BOTH FUNCTION.

IN KINYABABA GR7948 IT IS REPORTED THAT A NUMBER OF MINE INCIDENTS OCCURRED. ABOUT THREE MONTHS AGO A MAN WAS KILLED BY A MINE. ONE RPA SOLDIER WAS KILLED BY A MINE IN JULY AND ANOTHER IN AUGUST. ON 23 SEP 95 A CIVILIAN LOST 3 FINGERS AFTER DETONATING A MINE. HE IS BEING TREATED IN RUHengeri HOSPITAL. ON SUNDAY, 24 SEP A RPA SOLDIER DETONATED A MINE DURING AN EXERCISE. HE WAS INJURED IN THE STOMACH BY SPLINTERS.

IN KINYABABA GR 7948, THE ROAD IS MOTORABLE TO RUTOVU THROUGH MUSOGA GR 8050. THE OTHER SIDE OF THE LOOP IS NOT MOTORABLE BECAUSE 8 BRIDGES HAVE BEEN DESTROYED. ASSISTANCE TO REPAIR THE BRIDGES IS BEING SOUGHT BY THE COMMUNE.

COMMENT: WE BELIEVE THE INCIDENT WHERE ONE LOST THREE FINGERS WAS DUE TO A DETONATOR NOT A GRENADE. THE MINE SITUATION IN KINYABABA REQUIRES TO BE GIVEN PRIORITY WHEN THE

DEMINE EXERCISE COMMENCES. SOME OF THE PEOPLE DETONATE THE MINES WHEN THEY ARE WORKING IN THE FIELDS.

(2) TEAM: PATROLLED NYAMUTERA GR 5719, NDUSU GR 6212 AND KIGOMBE GR 6033 COMMUNES. SITUATION WAS CALM IN ALL THE COMMUNES. IT WAS MARKET DAY IN NYAMUTERA COMMUNE.

NYAMUTERA: THE TEAM WENT TO CONFIRM AN ASSAULT INCIDENT WHICH WAS REPORTED TO THE SECTOR THIS MORNING BY MSF. A WOMAN FROM MARANGARA SECTOR GR 5421 WAS ASSAULTED ON 21 SEP. THE CAUSE OF THE ASSAULT WAS LAND DISPUTE. 10 PEOPLE HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR THE ASSAULT, 2 OF THEM ARE WOMEN. THE IPJ INFORMED THE TEAM THAT THE MATTER WAS UNDER INVESTIGATIONS. HE HOWEVER ALLOWED THE TEAM TO SEE THE PEOPLE IN THE CELLS. THE IPJ PROMISED TO FURNISH THE TEAM WITH ALL DETAILS AFTER THE INVESTIGATIONS.

NDUSU: AUSTRIAN RELIEF PROGRAMME DELIVERED A CORN MILL TO THE COMMUNE ON 22 SEP 95. THE TEAM VISITED JANJA ORPHANAGE GR 638143. THE ORPHANAGE HAS 56 CHILDREN. THEY ALSO ASSIST 200 OTHER CHILDREN WITH FOOD AND CLOTHING. 3 SISTERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ORPHANAGE. THEY GET FOOD ASSISTANCE FROM WFP. THEIR MAIN PROBLEM IS PAYING SALARY TO THE WORKERS, SOAP AND CLOTHING FOR THE CHILDREN. TWO WATER POINTS REQUIRE REHABILITATION IN JANJA SECTOR AT NYAKAGEZI GR 6313 AND MUZO SECTOR GR 6712. IN KABINGO SECTOR, THE TEAM VISITED MUTEKO SCHOOL GR 6110. 720 PUPILS ATTEND SCHOOL. THE HEADMASTER MENTIONED THE PROBLEM OF TEXT BOOKS AND FURNITURE. THE MINISTRY IS AWARE OF THIS

PROBLEM.

KIGOMBE:THE RESETTLEMENT PROJECT IN KIMONYI SECTOR GR 5533 HAS
250 HECTARES CLEARED FOR RESETTLEMENT.

(3) TEAM: LIAISED WITH IMMIGRATION OFFICIAL AT CYANIKA.REACTED
TO A REPORT OF AN EXPLOSIVE WHICH WAS SEEN AT MUSANZE GR
5535.THE HEADMASTER OF MUSANZE SCHOOL CAME TO OUR OFFICES TO
REPORT THAT ONE OF HIS PUPILS HAD SEEN AN EXPLOSIVE.THE TEAM
WENT THERE WITH RPA ENGINEERS WHO DESTROYED THE RIFLE GRENADE
IN SITU.

AND A REP OF MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION WHO WORKS IN NDUSU WITH
TRANSPORT TO RUHENGARI.WHEN THEY ARRIVED AT A CHECK POINT AT
NYAKINAMA UNIVERSITY GR 5928,THE SOLDIERS ORDERED THEM TO DEBUS.THE
WOMAN WAS RELEASED WITHIN A SHORT PERIOD. THE MAN WAS BEATEN ACCUSED
OF BOARDING A UN VEHICLE AND OF GIVING UN INFORMATION.HE WAS ALSO
ACCUSED OF ASSISTING THE LADY TO RUN AWAY.HE WAS LATER RELEASED.


