 NYAMYUMBA. A 27 YEARS OLD LOCAL WOMAN, MOTHER OF TWO  
 CHILDREN AND PREGNANT IN THE 7TH MONTH WAS KILLED BY TWO  
 LOCAL MEN (FATHER AND SON, 44 AND 23 YEARS OLD) AND A 25  
 YEARS OLD LOCAL WOMAN, WHICH IS A RELATIVE OF THE TWO  
 MEN.

THE VICTIM RECEIVED TWO BEATS WITH THE BLUNT SIDE OF  
 AN AX. THE CAUSE OF HER DEATH WAS OBVIOUSLY A CRANIAL

## TRAUMA.

THE THREE PERPETRATORS WERE ARRESTED BY THE RPA AND TRANSFERRED TO THE GENDARMERIE BRIGADE OF GISENYI. WHO HAS CARRIED OUT THE DEADLY BEATS MUST BE FIND OUT IN THE FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION. THE REASON FOR THE KILLING WAS OBVIOUSLY JEALOUSY.





2. a. (i) Ref yesterday's sitrep, the meeting discussed security, co-operation among the administration and law enforcement agencies and chain of command in the administrative area.
- (ii) The Prefect of KIBUNGO organized "The Day of the African Child" at MUGERESA 4764. A similar function was held at GAHINI 5696.
- (iii) The Bourgmastre of BIRENGA expressed his appreciation to UNICEF for the provision of school materials; WFP for food aid; LWF and German Agro Action for agric and shelters, Save the Children for re-uniting children to families and MSF for building and providing nutritional needs in the Prefecture.
- (b) The RPA provided security at MUGESERA and GAHINI functions.
3. (a) One team patrolled route RILIMA 2561, GASHORA 2655 and RUTETE 2242. The situation was calm.
- (b) One team patrolled route RILIMA 2561, GASHORA, RUTETE, NGENDA 0644, and BRIDGE 0972. The situation was calm.



(b) One team patrolled route RILIMA 2561, KABUGA 2581, RUGENDA 2784, RUBONA 4474 and RWAMAGANA 4884. The situation was calm.  
(c) One team investigated reported killing of a local in RUKARA area 5601. The RUKARA Bourgmastre denied knowledge of any killing in the area. Counsellors in the commune appear not to have any knowledge of such killing. The general area was calm.

The road condition between ITONERO 6760 and NYARUTUNGA 8361 was very bad. The general situation was calm.



GITARAMA HAS 150 ORPHANS AGED BETWEEN 1 TO 17 YEARS . THE TWO CENTERS DO NOT HAVE A DOCTOR, THEY SOLELY DEPEND ON THE MALI COY DOCTOR WHO HAS A SCHEDULED VISIT TO THE CENTERS. THE STAFF MEMBERS ARE PAID BY CONCERN. THE CENTERS ARE IN DIRE NEED OF SCHOOLING MATERIALS. THEY ALSO NEED CHAIRS AND TABLES. THEY REQUESTED TOILETARY ITEMS INCLUDING BARBING EQUIPMENT . THE TEAM LATER VISITED TARWE SECTOR (7674) UNDER NYAMABUYE COMMUNE AND REPORTED THAT , LOCALS HAVE ENOUGH FOOD BUT, THEY ARE REQUESTING FOR AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS AND SEEDS OF ALL TYPES. GEN SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM AND THERE ARE NO ARRESTS .

ii) ONE TEAM VISITED GIHIRA (8581) , BITARE (8383), BUGARAMA (8589) AND NYAMIREMBE (8087) SECTORS IN KAYENZI COMMUNE AND REPORTED THAT LOCALS ARE DO NOT HAVE POTABLE DRINKING WATER AND MEDICINE IN THE ONLY LOCAL DISPENSARY AND AGRICULTURAL MATERIAL . THE TEAM GATHERED THAT , THERE ARE 636 ORPHANS WHO ARE BEING LOOKED AFTER BY THE SALVATION ARMY . IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT THIS SAME ORGANISATION IS HELPING WIDOWS IN RECONSTRUCTING THEIR DEMOLISHED HOUSES. BANDTRY ACTIVITY IS ON AN INCREASE IN THE FOUR VISITED SECTORS.

iii) ONE TEAM VISITED MUKINGI (7160) AND MUSHUBATI (6970) COMMUNE AND REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IS CALM. LOCALS ARE IN NEED OF FOOD AND BUILDING MATERIALS.

**B. KIBUYE TEAM**

(i) ONE PETROL WENT BY HELICOPTER TO KIGALI PRIMARY SCHOOL 5775 IN THE KIVUMU COMMUNE. THEY SPOKE TO THE SCHOOL DIRECTOR WHO TOLD THEM ABOUT THEIR PROBLEMS SUCH AS NON PAYMENT OF THE TEACHERS. THE NEW DIRECTOR STATED THAT THE NEWS OF THE DEPARTURE OF UNAMIR HAS RAISED FURTHER FEARS IN THE COMMUNITY WHO BELIEVES THAT UNAMIR MANDATE SHOULD BE INCREASED.

ii) ONE PATROL WENT TO RWAMATAMU (1557) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE TO SPEAK WITH THE BOURGMESTRE. THE ASSISTANT BOURGMESTRE SPOKE THAT THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS OR EVENTS GOING ON IN HIS COMMUNE. HE STATED THAT THE BOURGMESTRE WAS STILL AT THE HOSPITAL, AND THAT HIS COMMUNE IS LACKING IN EVERYTHING WHICH HE WANTS UNAMIR TO PROVIDE HIM (SEE HUMANITARIAN PARAGRAPH).

**C. MALICOY. NTR.**

ON THE NIGHT OF 12 JUNE AT ABOUT 2000 HRS, 11 PEOPLE WERE SHOT DEAD BY RPA SOLDIERS, WHEN THEY WERE COMING FROM ZAIRE. ONE WOMAN NAMED BACHINAYE CONFIRMED THAT, AMONG THE KILLED PERSONS MUNGWALERE, UZIVELI AND MUKAMUSONI WERE HER RELATIVES AND SHE IDENTIFIED THEM. BECAUSE OF THE LACK OF COMMUNICATION WE COULD NOT CONFIRM IF THE BODIES HAD BEEN BURIED. THE VICTIMS ARE REPORTED HAVE BEEN SHOT BEFORE THEY LANDED ON THE BEACH.

(i) The hospital treats about 70 out-patients a day and a maximum 31 in-patients at a time due to availability of beds. 30 patients were on admission today. The hospital's maximum in-patients is 80.

(ii) Constructional work on the building was going on steadily.

(iii) The hospital faces acute water shortage. It relied on water tanker service but the recent heavy rain fall washed away a portion of the road on a DAM 655833 and rendered it un-motorable for trucks. The local community had re-filled portions of the damaged road and made it accessible up to 20 ton trucks. The long term solution is providing electricity to pump water from the Dam to the hospital and its environs.

(d) One team investigated an incident at KAYONZA 568900 today at noon in which Miss MUKAMDAHIRO aged 28 years killed one child and injured four others. The injured children were

rushed by GHANBATT PI to RWAMAGANA Hospital 4884 where two were treated and discharged and the other two on admission. Miss MUKAMDAHIRO believed to be a lunatic was later arrested by RPA and handed over to the gendarmerie.

(e) One team patrolled KIBUNGO 6061, SAKA 4354, ZAZA 4861, MEGESERA 4764 and BARE 5448. The general situation was calm. A family of five consisting of 16 persons still at SAKA Transit Camp complained of lack of food and water. The team visited BARE Transit Camp to assess arrangements made to receive over 500 returnees from Burundi and reported as satisfactory.

(b) At MUNYAGA, a Roman Catholic Nun operating the Dispensary reported that the main sickness in the area was malaria. She together with three other local staff leave the Dispensary at about 1600hours because of security. She appealed to any NGO or UNAMIR to assist the Dispensary with solar panel which will be used for water heating.

(c) One team patrolled areas SAKE 4354 and MUGESERA 4764. At MUGESERA the team was again denied access to continue their patrols. Although the check point was clear yesterday, the local militia demanded authority from the Bourgemestre before proceeding. The team could not meet the Bourgemestre.  
(d) The Sector Commander met with the Prefect of KIBUNGO and discussed the problem of the MUGESERA check point and the refusal of the authorities to give access to the teams into the NYAKIRAMBI and RWINKWAVU Transit Camps and the BUKOBA Border check point. The Prefect insisted that the necessary information and returnees figures in the various camps and border points should be collected at the Prefecture weekly. On the MUGESERA Check point issue the Prefect again insisted that the patrol teams should contact the Bourgemestre before proceeding further. These resolutions were observed as being impediment to the free access of UNAMIR in the AOR.

4. GHANBAT handed over two of their local workers employed by BROWN & ROOTS, MDIZEYE JEAN BAPTISTE and BYIRINGIRO PROSPERE, to the KIBUNGO Prosecutor for being reported by three unknown witnesses from BUTARE about two months ago for allegedly involved in the genocide. The handing over was done in the presence of Human Rights and ICRC representatives. According to the Prosecutor the two victims would be kept in the KIBUNGO prison before later being transferred to BUTARE Prefecture for necessary identification and prosecution.

(iii) At INUNGA 3566, a local informed the team that 42 persons were arrested in ZAZA 4759 without reason. This caused him to flee from ZAZA to INUNGA.



The RPA refused the IDPs to disembark from their trucks until authority was received from the Bourgemestre. The IDPs had been in the truck for the past 5 days without food and water. It is feared that casualties might occur as a result of hunger,


thirst and sanitation. IDPs were issued with biscuits but without water and shelter and were exposed to the mercy of heavy downpour of rains today. A woman and a child who arrived yesterday died of hunger. Total number of IDPs in NGENDA is 2400.

(c) Total number of IDPs in GASHORA 2655 was 460. The situation of the IDPs remained unchanged. There were no food and water in the transit camp.

  - (iv) Bourgemestre promised to send the 10 persons who sought protection in GHANBATT Platoon location in GITUKU 703637 to their homes in BWERANKA. However, the ten persons have requested UNAMIR to send them to RUHENGERRI where they originally lived before the war.



  - (v) The events passed off peacefully.
- (c) Sector Cdr and one milob team attended the ceremonies at KIBUNGO and BIRENGA 5959 commune office area. The events were largely attended and passed off peacefully.
- (d) Congregation of people also took place in NGENDA 0644 and GASHORA 2655 communes to commemorate the anniversary of the genocide.
- (e) Sub Sector Cdr RILIMA and three milobs carried out heli recce of the Sub Sector. They reported the situation to be calm.







(i) The victim NTEZILILUABA ALPHONSE was shot dead at close range about 3 km NORTH of RILIMA GR 227630. He had one bullet wound in the neck and two in the head.

(ii) Eye witnesses said that the victim was coming from KABUKUBA 2069 when a person dressed in a long coat requested him for a lift. The victim replied that his motorcycle was not in good order. There was a verbal exchange after which the man took out a weapon and shot him.

(iii) RPA comd and local auths were info. Milobs met Security offr at KANAZI 0963. He initially concluded that the crime was committed by the interhamwe. However, the wife of the victim suspects the RPA because she said that earlier in the day some RPA soldiers had asked the victim for his motorcucle and when he refused they assaulted him. Local auths and RPA said that they will conduct their own investigation.

4. Our team patrolling KABARONDO reported that one orphan NTIZIYARAMEGE, died in the orphanage at GASETSA 5671 after falling into an underground water tank a few days back. There are 19 orphans in the orphanage at the moment. There is a requirement of pump to fill the water tank in the orphanage.







  - (i) In NKUNGU 5071, locals informed that people are still being killed by the RPA, in particular men. Details of killings are not available. Earlier the RPA had been taking people away after meetings on security problems but nowadays they had been taking them away at night. The team also observed that in some villages it is not possible to see any men of the 16 - 35 age group. The team was told by some women that today itself the RPA was looking for one MUNYAKIRUNGO belonging to KASERANGWE sector of KIGERAMA commune.
  - (ii) In the same area, the locals informed that they are expecting some anti HUTU actions in the beginning of Apr. They also said that this fear was one of the main reasons why some people prefer to spend the night in the forest.
  - (iii) Some people appear to have left from these areas to Burundi in the past few weeks.
  - (iv) In MUGESERA, the team was stopped at a militia checkpoint. The team negotiated and passed through. The team questioned the militia man himself and came to know that the checkpoint had been set up by the bourgemestre to prevent people from fleeing the area.
  - (v) The team also confirmed that the bourgemestre had prohibited locals from giving any info to UNAMIR. The locals have been told that they must tell UNAMIR to get the required info from the bourgemestre. The team noticed

some locals running away when their car stopped to talk to them.





The service is twice a week and approx 60 people are arriving in every trip.  
  
(b) One team patrolled the BURUNDI border in the SAKE 4354, MUGESERA 4764 and BIRENGA 5959 communes. They visited the villages of MURAMA 4547 and JARAMA 4248. They met the bourgemestre of SAKE and talked to a number of locals. The bourgemestre confirmed the existence of rumours about planned disturbances on 06 Apr. He also stated that the number of returnees into his commune had dropped due to these rumours. Locals in JARAMA informed that some people had definitely left for BURUNDI due to fear of being arrested. They also said that the bourgemestre is prohibiting people from giving info to anyone regarding the arrests and was also trying to prevent people from crossing over into BURUNDI. The locals also mentioned that there were no interhamwe in the area.  
  
(c) One team patrolled RUKARA 5601 commune. They investigated the alleged existence of a new mass grave as reported by ROMAN CATHOLIC SISTERS at RUKARA. The bourgemestre denied this but did not let the team see the site (CENTRE DE NUTRITION RUKARA). He however took them to the known mass grave in the area at the catholic church. The team however strongly suspects the existence of the new mass grave as it was again confirmed to them by the nuns. Investigations will continue and further details will be intimated.  
  
(d) The team also confirmed the existence of rumours regarding impending disturbances in the RUKARA commune. All milobs and other agencies in this sector have been advised to assist in dispelling such rumours.

  - (iii) The RPA is extensively deployed in the SAKE and GASHORA areas. The original commune office at GASHORA is now used as a training area.
  - (iv) The team encountered two militia checkpoints at JARAMA. The militia asked the team to produce the authority of the bourgemestre of SAKE to move in the area. The team refuted the demand and crossed all the checkpoints. The team confirmed that movement to NGOs in the area is permitted only with the permission of the local authorities.



3. (a) Please refer to your directions regarding movement of civilians to BURUNDI. Three teams patrolled the BURUNDI border today. The areas patrolled are RUKURAZO 6443, SILO 6543, CYANYA 7241, HUMURE 7643, NYAHYAGA 6344, GASHORA 2655, RUTETE 2242 and the southern areas of SAKA 4453 and MUGESERA 4764. Our observations are as follows:-
  - (i) Reports of this movement have also been received by us from UNHCR and UNREO KIBUNGO. As per these reports, approx 1000 people appear to have left the NGENDA commune for BURUNDI during the past few days. The apparent reason is an alleged rumour of impending revenge killings being planned by the RPA between 31 Mar and 06 Feb 95.
  - (ii) Our team patrolling NGENDA met the bourgemestre who expressed surprise at the news of this movement. Locals on questioning also denied any knowledge of this. The immigration officer at the RUTETE border post informed that no movement into RWANDA had taken place since 19 Mar 95.
  - (iii) Our team patrolling SAKA and MUGESERA reported that no movement had been noticed. However, some locals did mention that a lot of people are hiding in the bush and their movement into BURUNDI may have taken place. The team also reported constant monitoring of their activities by the RPA. They also confirmed that the people in the area are scared of divulging any info to UNAMIR.
  - (iv) The team patrolling area RWABITAZI reported extensive patrolling by the RPA in the area. It confirmed no movement into BURUNDI from the area. It met a local who had been beaten by an RPA patrol for allegedly having indulged in stealing. It also reported that the cellule of SILO 6543 is deserted.
- (b) At 1420 h, one local was chased by one person each of the RPA and gendarmerie into the Ghanbatt platoon location at KABILIZI 5066. The man had been arrested by them on the pretext that his brother had allegedly been involved in the genocide. The man was brought to SAKA 5448 by Ghanbatt. Human Rights and milobs went to investigate. The platoon location at KABILIZI was surrounded by two offrs and approx 35 men of the RPA. The milob team is at the moment in the area, negotiating with the

(c) Cdr Sub Sect 2A along with OC B Coy Ghanbatt attended a security meeting with the sous prefect of KANZENZE 0963.


