1. SITUATIONA. GENERAL. CALMB. BORDER.REMERA BP 420899 - NORMAL CROSSING.
AKABUGA BC 499887 - NORMAL CROSSING.2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.A. POLITICAL. NTR.B. MILITARY. NTR.3. OWN ACTIVITY.

A. SECTOR HQ. THE ACTING SECTOR COMD. HAD AN INFORMAL DISCUSSION WITH THE RPA CO, AND OPS OFFICER ABOUT THE SUDDEN RISE OF BANDITRY AT RWAMIKO COMMUNE (49140) AND ITS SURROUNDING AREAS. THE ACTING SECTOR COMD. INFORMED THE CO AND THE OPS OFFICER THAT LOCALS ARE SUSPECTING THE RPA AS THE MAIN CULPRITS, BECAUSE EVEN THOUGH THEY HAVE REPORTED TO THE RPA PL AT KIBEHO (5107) ABOUT THESE BANDITRY ACTIVITIES NOTHING HAVE BEEN DONE. THE OPS OFFICER ASSURED THE ACTING SECTOR COMD THAT THEY WILL TAKE ACTION. TODAY RM-6 REPORTED THAT A PL STR RPA SOLDIERS UNDER THE COMMAND OF A S/SGT. HAVE BEEN STATION AT MATYAZO (4515) IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE TO TAKE CARE OF BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN THE COMMUNE. HQ COORDINATED THE ACTIVITIES OF THE TEAMS AND MONITORED THEIR PROGRESS.

B. TEAM 1. THE TEAM WAS ON STAND BY DUE TO UN AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

C. TEAM 2. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO GO ON FOOT PATROL WITHIN GIKONGORO AREA TO ACCESS THE GENERAL CONDITION IN THE TOWNSHIP AND ALSO TO CHECK ON AVAILABILITY OF FOOD AND THEIR RETAIL

PRICES SINCE TODAY WAS THE MARKET DAY. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL CONDITION WAS QUITE GOOD WITH THE LOCAL GENDARMERIE PATROLLING THE MARKET AREA. PRICES HAVE SLIGHTLY GONE UP, WHEN THE TEAM INTERVIEW SOME OF THE RETAILERS. THEY SAID, THE HIGH COST OF STAPLES FOOD WAS NORMAL IN THIS TIME OF THE YEAR AND IT HAS BEEN COMPOUNDED DUE TO THE POOR HARVEST IN MOST OF THE COMMUNES AND INSUFFICIENT PLANTING DUE TO IN ADEQUACY OF SEEDLINGS AND FERTILIZER. ON MEAT PRICES WHICH HAS GONE UP FROM 300 RWF. TO 500 RWF. THE BUTCHERS CLAIMED THAT MOST OF THE COWS OWNERS HAVE LOST THEIR CATTLE THROUGH BANDITRY THE FEW REMAINING THE PRICES HAVE BEEN DOUBLE.

D. TEAM 3. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUDASOMWA COMMUNE (4222). KITABI (3520), UWINGUGU (4017) SECTORS IN PARTICULAR. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT APART FROM BANDITRY AND STEALING OF FARM PRODUCE IN ISOLATED AREAS THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS VERY CALM. THE SECTOR LEADER AT KITABI REQUESTED THE TEAM TO CONTACT ANY OF THE NGOS TO ASSIST THEM TO MAINTAINED THEIR ROADS AND ALSO EXTEND PORTABLE DRINKING WATER TO THE SECTOR. ON AGRICULTURE HE SAID THEY NEED HELP IN THE FORM OF SEEDLINGS FOR POTATOES, CORN AND BEANS. FERTILIZER IS ALSO NEEDED TO ENABLE THEM HAVE GOOD HARVEST FOR THE NEXT FARMING SEASON.

E. TEAM 4. THE TEAM WAS THE DUTY TEAM FOR THE DAY.

F. TEAM 5. THE TEAM WAS ON STAND BY DUE TO NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

G. TEAM 6. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUBUGA COMMUNE (5220). GISIZI (4802), KABILIZI (4501), GASARA (4942) AND KAMANA (5196) SECTORS IN PARTICULAR. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS VERY CALM. IN ALL THE SECTORS VISITED LOCALS ARE APPREHENSIVE ABOUT ZAMBATT PULLING OUT FROM THEIR COMMUNE MOST OF THEM SAID IMMEDIATELY ZAMBATT LEAVES MOST OF THEM WILL BE ARRESTED AND KILLED. AT MUBUGA COMMUNE CELLS THERE ARE 20 SUSPECTS ACCUSED IN TAKING PART IN THE GENOCIDE. THE SECTOR LEADERS INFORMED THE TEAM THAT, TO STOP BANDITRY ACTIVITIES AND STEALING OF COWS IN THE SECTORS THE LOCALS HAVE DECIDED TO GO ON JOINT NIGHT PATROLS WITH RPA PL LOCATED IN THE COMMUNE.

B. TEAM 1. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUSEBEYA COMMUNE(4033).BUNSHIGISHIGI(3428),GAKANGAKA(3930) SECTORS IN PARTICULAR. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT ALL THE SECTORS THEY VISITED THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS VERY CALM. THE SECTOR LEADERS OF THE MENTION SECTORS TOLD THE TEAM THAT IDPS FROM OTHER PREFECTURES HAVE COME TO SETTLE IN THEIR SECTORS. THEY HAVE REFUSE TO GO BACK TO THEIR ORIGINAL PREFECTURES BECAUSE OF FEAR BEEN ARRESTED BY RPA.THEY PREFER TO STAY IN THOSE SECTORS BECAUSE OF IT PROXIMITY TO THE NATURAL FOREST.DUE TO LARGE NUMBER OF IDPS WHO HAVE SETTLE IN SECTORS, FARM LANDS ARE NOT ADEQUATE AND LOCALS HAVE STARTED ENCROACHING ON THE NATURAL FOREST FOR FARMING AND FUEL WOOD.RPA SOLDIERS HAVE STARTED ARRESTING ENCROACHERS.THE ROAD CONDITION TO THE SECTORS IS ONLY MOTORABLE IN THE DRY SEASON.

C. TEAM 2. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUSANGE COMMUNE(5347).MWUMBA (4651),RUHINGA (4847) AND KIBAGA(5153)SECTORS IN PARTICULAR. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT ALL

THE SECTORS VISITED, THE GENERAL SITUATION IS VERY CALM. APART FROM ISOLATED CASES OF BANDITRY IN SOME PARTS OF THE COMMUNE. IT WAS REPORTED THAT ON THE 20 JUNE 95 A GROUP OF FIVE BANDITS INVADDED CYABUTE(4650) AND STOLE 41,000 RWF. ONE GOAT AND OTHER PERSONAL EFFECTS FROM THE LOCALS ONE OF THEM WAS ARRESTED AND PRESENTLY IN DETENTION CELL AT MUSANGE. IT IS ALLEGED THAT ALL THE BANDITRY IN THE COMMUNE ARE PERPETUATED BY FORMER IDPS WHO COME TO THE COMMUNE. LOCALS WERE SEEN ON THEIR FARMS. IT WAS REPORTED TO THE TEAM THAT THE PREFECT OF GIKONGORO VISITED THE COMMUNE TO TALK TO THE DEMONSTRATORS WHO WERE AGITATING FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUSANGE COMMUNE. ON THE 09 JULY 95 A GROUP 04 RPA WITHOUT ARMS TOOK AWAY ONE COW FROM ONE MR KOMETA BY FORCE AND CARRIED IT TO THEIR CAMP IN MUSANGE. HE HAD BEEN REFERRED TO THE RPA LOCAL COMD. TROCARE HAVE STARTED RE-REGISTRATION OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNE.

D. TEAM 3. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUKO COMMUNE(3841). MUKO (3742), KABAVU(3441) AND JIMBU (3847). THE TEAM REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION IS VERY CALM. THE SECTOR LEADERS TOLD THE TEAM THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA FOR QUITE A LONG TIME. ALSO RPA HAVE NOT ARRESTED ANYBODY FROM THEIR SECTORS. FARMING ACTIVITIES IS VERY PREVALENT MOST OF THE LOCALS WERE SEEN ON THEIR FARMS.

F. TEAM 5. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL NYAMAGABE COMMUNE (5427). GASAKA(4924), KAMEGERI (5122) AND GIKONGORO(5127) THE TEAM REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM. THERE WAS NO RPA CAMPS IN THE TWO SECTORS. BUT THERE IS ROUTING PATROL BY RPA DAILY. THE SECTOR LEADER TOLD THE TEAM THAT,THEY HAVE STARTED COMPILING THE LIST OF LOCALS WHO ARE SUSPECTED TO BE OUTSIDE RWANDA.THEY ALSO MADE A REQUEST TO SOME NGOs TO ASSIST THE SECTORS WITH DEVELOPMENT PROJECT TO IMPROVE THEIR LIVING CONDITION. HE ALSO INFORM THE TEAM THAT THE GENOCIDE SURVIVORS ARE RECLAIMING THEIR COWS AND LAND FROM THE LOCALS.

C. TEAM 2. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL MUSANGE COMMUNE (5347). JENDA (5345). JOMA (5042)AND CYABASANA (5350) SECTORS IN PARTICULAR.WITH REF TO SITREP NUMBER 343,THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO CHECKED ON THE CONDITION OF THE DETAINEE AND ALSO

~~THE GENERAL SITUATION AFTER THE DEMONSTRATION INCIDENT~~
 CELLS, 12 HAVE HAD THEIR CASES INVESTIGATED AND ACCUSED OF COMMITTING THE CRIMES THEY WERE ACCUSED OF. THE COMMUNE IS WAITING FOR A VEHICLE TO CONVEY THEM TO GIKONGORO PRISONS. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THAT AFTER THE DEMONSTRATION THE FORMER BOUGMESTRE OF THE AREA HAVE BEEN REPLACED WITH ONE MR SIBOMAN FELICIEN A SECTOR LEADER BY THE PREFECTURE. THE TEAM ALSO INVESTIGATED ABOUT RPA TAKEN A COW BY FORCE WHICH WAS REFLECTED IN YESTERDAY SITREP. THE LOCAL CMD. DENIED THE INVOLMENT OF HIS TROOPS IN THE SAID INCIDENT THE SECTOR LEADER OF NKORE(5547) ALSO AGREED WITH THE LOCAL CMD. ALL THE SECTORS VISITED BY THE TEAM WAS VERY CALM.

D. TEAM 3. THE TEAM WAS ON STAND BY DUE TO NON AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

E. TEAM 4. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO PATROL KIVU COMMUNE (3996). RUTITI (3707), GITITA(4398) AND RUHERU(4098) SECTORS IN PARTICULAR.
