ENTRETIEN AVEC LE MAJOR-GENERAL GUY TOUSSIGNANT  
COMMANDANT LA FORCE DES NATIONS-UNIES AU RWANDA

Le 04 Avril 1995, le commandant de la force des nations-unies au rwanda s'est rendu a BUTARE à l'occasion de la célébration de la fête de l'indépendance du SENEGAL par le bataillon sénégalais de la MINUAR. A l'issue de la cérémonie le Major - Général Guy TOUSSIGNANT a accordé une interview a notre correspondant au Rwanda .

QUESTION : Mon Général, pouvez-vous nous faire un bilan partiel de la Mission des Nations-Unies pour l'Assistance au Rwanda ?

REPONSE : Au moment de la mise en place de ces troupes onusiennes au mois d'août 1994 , le Rwanda était un pays déchiré , meurtri . Kigali, la capitale, était sans vie . Regardez autour de vous aujourd'hui , ça bouge, ça vit, après seulement huit mois . Je pense que le résultat pour le moment est globalement positif .

QUESTION : Le bataillon sénégalais vit une situation assez particulière par rapport aux autres éléments de la MINUAR. Pensez-vous qu'à l'avenir cette situation puisse évoluer de manière à lui permettre de mieux remplir sa mission ?

REPONSE : Au lendemain de la Turquoise, le bataillon sénégalais a intégré la MINUAR et s'est vu confier le secteur de KIBUYE ou il avait évolué à côté des autres formations ayant pris part a cette mission dirigée par les français.

Cette zone présentait donc des difficultés d'ordre géopolitique mais aussi géographique. C'était très compliqué . Les rapports avec les autorités n'étaient pas des meilleurs malgré la reconnaissance de l'APR (Armée Populaire Rwandaise) comme force légale du pays .

Je demeure cependant convaincu qu'après le redéploiement du bataillon sénégalais dans la préfecture de BUTARE , et lorsque les populations décrouvront réellement toutes les qualités du militaire sénégalais tout rentrera dans l'ordre . Ils seront alors appréciés a leur juste valeur .

QUESTION : La présence des troupes de la MINUAR est très souvent contestée par certains qui avancent même qu'elles sont inefficaces voir inutiles - Qu'en pensez-vous ?

REPONSE : Le moins que l'on puisse dire c'est que les troupes onusiennes ont effectué un excellent travail au rwanda. Par conséquent notre objectif en ce moment doit être de valider notre deuxième mandat . Ensuite, il faudra dresser avec le gouvernement une nouvelle feuille de route , de nouveaux axes d'effort . Il s'agira de préciser le type de mission et le genre de troupes : techniciens, observateurs etc... par exemple . Après quoi nous nous attellerons a mener a bien cette nouvelle mission

QUESTION : Il est question de porter l'effectif du contingent à 500 hommes . Est ce exact ?

REPONSE : Pour effectuer cette mission d'assistance au rwanda , j'avais évalué les besoins en hommes à 5500 .Actuellement l'effectif est passé à 5794 . Ce qui fait un excédent de 294 . Dans ces conditions il n'est pas envisageable d'augmenter ce nombre .Toutefois , si un pays demandait à retirer son contingent ou diminuer son personnel , il serait alors possible de faire appel au Sénégal pour un supplément en hommes .
