

Presidential Decree No.52/2012 for the **Appointment of Grade (1) Ambassador into the Diplomatic and Consulate Service in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Republic of South Sudan, 2012 A.D.**

### **1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:**


This Decree shall be cited as "The Presidential Decree No.52/2012 for the **Appointment as Grade (1) Ambassador into the Diplomatic and Consulate Service in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Republic of South Sudan, 2012 A.D**" and shall come into force on the date of its signature by the President of the Republic.

### **2. THE DECREE:**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Article 101 (0) of the Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan, 2011, A.D. read

together with section 25(1) and (4), of the Diplomatic and Consulate Service Act, 2011, I General Salva Kiir Mayardit, President of the Republic of South Sudan, do hereby issue this Presidential Decree for the **Appointment of Dr. Francis Mading Deng as Grade (1) Ambassador with the status of a Deputy Minister into the Diplomatic and Consulate Service in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Republic of South Sudan** with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2012 A.D.
