Points noted by the Force Commander during his visit to A'ville:

1) The Malayan unit has not got proper cook houses. The present make shift arrangement is very unsatisfactory from cleanliness and hygienic point of view. The Force Commander ordered Mr. Azam to take immediate steps to provide proper cook houses.

2) A large number of Indian Birgade vehicles are still in A'ville. The maintenance and cleanliness of vehicles needs looking into as at present they are very few personnel to look after them. The Force Commander would like the Chief Logistics Officer to apprise him as to when these vehicles will be sent to E'ville.

A 3) The Unimogs have no UN markings on them. No paint is locally available to do the markings. Arrangement should be made to provide paint and stencils to complete the markings.

4) The Ethiopian personnel looking after the Unimogs have not got adequate tentage for living. These personnel were drawn from various Ethiopian units on ad-hoc basis with the result that they were unable to bring cooking utensils and crockery etc. Commander Sector A should look into their difficulties and make adequate arrangement for properly housing the personal and provision of utensils and crockery.

The points discussed by the Force Commander with Col. Maseali, ANC groupment Commander, A'ville are as follows:

a) Provision of POL to the ANC.

b) On 17 October, 5 drums of petrol were flown to Kabalo under instruction from force HQ Leopoldville. No intimation regarding this was given to the local Groupment Commander, who could have sent the above drums by train there by saving an air trip.

c) The ANC Commander complained that the local UN Medical Officer has at times refused to treat serious casualties of ANC personnel. In this connection the Force Commander would like to see Major Mazumdar of ONUC Hospital, Leopoldville, who

was the Medical Officer at A'ville about two months back.

The Chief Medical Officer will ensure that adequate attention is paid to the ANC casualties.

d) The ANC Commander expressed difficulty of discriminating ONUC and Gendarmerie aircraft since Gendarmerie aircraft have been using ONUC markings. The Force Commander emphasised inspite of this difficulty the ANC should not shoot the planes with ONUC markings unless ANC troops are attacked by such planes.

e) The Force Commander stressed the importance of close liaison and co-operation between the ANC and ONUC units in Sector 'A'.




3) TAILORING
