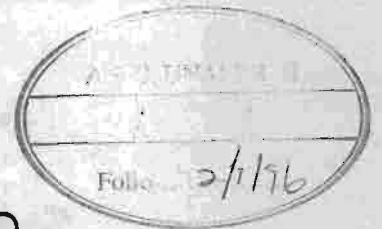

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOCUSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.
2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.
3. RPA.
 - A. SECTOR 2B (KIBUNGO) - RPA HAS ROTATED ITS TROOPS IN THE GENERAL AREA OF RUKUMBO GS 9466. THE STRENGTH SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN INCREASED FROM A PLATOON TO A COMPANY WITH ITS HQ HAVING MOVED FROM RUKUMBO TO PIMIERA GR 9360.
 - B. IN SECTOR 5A (RUHENGIERI), IT WAS CONFIRMED BY AN NGO THAT THE RPA HAVE STOPPED LOCALS INCLUDING TOURISTS FROM ENTERING THE FOREST TO SEE THE GORILLAS.
4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.
 - A. IN SECTOR 5C (KIBUYE), THERE WAS AN EXPLOSION AT "HOME SAINT JEAN" CHURCH (SITE OF ITR INVESTIGATION) ON 290800 DEC 95 IN WHICH A SMALL BOY HAD HIS LEFT HAND AMPUTATED AND HAD FACIAL INJURIES. THE BOY CURRENTLY ON ADMISSION. MILOBS INVESTIGATING.
 - B. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU), ON 29 DEC 95 AT ABOUT 0030HRS, THE NYAMASHEKE MEDICAL CENTRE WAS ATTACKED BY GUNMEN SUSPECTED TO BE FRGF MEMBERS. THREE GRENADES WERE LAUNCHED AT THE MEDICAL CENTRE. GRENADE SPLINTERS AND 15 EMPTY CASES OF 7.62MM ROUNDS WERE PICKED FROM THE SCENE OF INCIDENT. THE ROUNDS USED WERE NOT THE TYPE AK 47 COMMONLY USED BY RPA. FROM THE SPLINTERS, IT WAS EVIDENT THAT TWO TYPES OF GRENADES WERE USED THOUGH THEIR MAKE COULD NOT BE ASCERTAINED. NO CASUALTIES WERE RECORDED. THE WALLS AND WINDOWS OF THE CENTRE WERE HOWEVER DAMAGED.
 - C. IN SECTOR 5B (GISENYI), AT RUSIZA GS 3027, LOCALS REPORTED THAT ON 27 DEC 95 ONE RPA SOLDIER ON LEAVE FROM KIGALI WAS KILLED AND HIS BROTHER WOUNDED AT APPROXIMATELY 2100HRS BY SUSPECTED INTERAHAMWE. IT WAS FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE TUTSI RETURNEES OF 59/60 ATTACKED THE LOCAL HUTUS ACCUSING THEM OF HARBOURING INSURGENTS. ONE HUTU WAS KILLED AND FOUR WOUNDED. THE WOUNDED WERE TAKEN TO KATABWA CLINIC GS 3327. THEY HAVE SINCE BEEN DISCHARGED. AT PARC VOLCANO BUTAKA GS 3229, LOCALS REPORTED A CLASH BETWEEN RPA AND FRGF ON THE NIGHT OF 28/29 DEC 95. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES. GHANCOY 2 CONTINUES DEPLOYING A PLATOON IN KIBUYE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL EXPERTS WORKING IN THE AREA. ITR TEAM ON RETURN FROM KIGALI ON 31 JAN 96 WILL BE ADVISED TO MOVE TO "GOLF EDEN ROCK" HOTEL WHERE OWN TROOPS ARE ACCOMMODATED TO FACILITATE SECURITY.

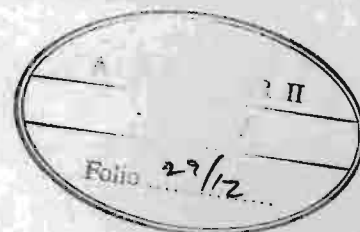

 - A. RPA CONDUCTED CORDON AND SEARCH IN GITARAMA ON NIGHT 27-28 DEC AND ARRESTED SIX THIEVES SUSPECTED TO BE INVOLVED IN THE BREAK IN AT THE SECTOR HQ GITARAMA REPORTED EARLIER. APPROXIMATELY HALF THE STOLEN CURRENCY NOTES WERE RECOVERED FROM THEM.
 - B. IN SECT 5A, RUHENGIRI, THE IPJ OF NDUSU COMMUNE REPORTED THE ARREST OF MR. MUNYANEZA OF MOZO SECTOR BY RPA ON 25 DEC 95 FOR HIS ALLEGED ROLE IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE. ALSO ONE MR. KAGANO OF MUNARIRA SECTOR (GR 6025) WAS ARRESTED ON 26 DEC 95 ON CHARGES OF HARBOURING AN FRGF INFILTRATOR.
4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. LOCALS OF BUYEYE (GR 1111) REPORTED SMALL ARMS FIRING IN FOREST TO MILOBS SECTOR 5A. THE REPORT BEING INVESTIGATED.

6. POLITICAL.
 - A. THE SRSG ATTENDED THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY OF THE BRIDGE ,CONSTRUCTED BY THE FORCE ENGR COY, AT GASHORA BY MINISTER OF PUBLIC WORKS. THE MAIN THEME OF THE PUBLIC SPEECHES MADE ON THE OCCASION, CALLED FOR MEANINGFUL COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND UNAMIR IN THE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS CONCERNING RWANDA.THE ROLE OF THE FORCE ENGR COMPONENT OF UNAMIR WAS PARTICULARLY APPRECIATED IN THIS REGARD.
 - B. ACCORDING TO RADIO RWANDA, THE SEMINAR ON DETENTION AND ARREST PROCEDURES THAT CONCLUDED ON 27 DEC 95 IN SAINT PAUL CENTRE, EMPHASIZED UPON THE NEED FOR COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE ARMY AND CIVIL JUDICIAL INSTITUTIONS. IT ALSO CALLED FOR SETTING UP OF THE COMMISSION FOR ASCERTAINING PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED BY SUCH PROCEDURES AS WELL AS DETERMINING THE GUILTY.

HOTEL AUTHORITIES OF THE GUEST HOUSE IN KIBUYE WHERE THE MEMBERS OF INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL ARE STAYING TRIED TO PREVENT THE GHANCOY PLATOON FROM GUARDING THE EQUIPMENT OF THE TRIBUNAL. THE PREFECT WAS CONTACTED WHO ASKED THE HOTEL AUTHORITIES TO FURNISH A WRITTEN GUARANTEE FOR ENSURING THE SAFETY OF TRIBUNAL MEMBERS AND THEIR EQUIPMENT. UNABLE TO DO THIS THEY ALLOWED THE GUARD TO CONTINUE BUT THREATENED TO REPORT THE MATTER TO RPA BN COMMANDER. ISSUE BEING RESOLVED WITH GOV'T AUTHORITIES

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA. SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) - ON 26 DEC 95, AT 2330 HRS, A HAND GRENADE WENT OFF ACCIDENTLY IN A VEHICLE CONVEYING 03 RPA SOLDIERS TO THEIR NEW LOCATION. ONE RPA SOLDIER AND THE CIVILIAN DRIVER, WERE BADLY INJURED. THE OTHER TWO PASSENGERS SUSTAINED MINOR INJURIES.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU), ON 26 DEC 95 AT ABOUT 1930 HRS, 03 DEAD BODIES POSSIBLY OF FRGF, WERE FOUND NEAR A BRIDGE AT RUSANBU (GR-914306).

B. IN SECTOR 5A RUHENGIRI, IT WAS CONFIRMED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE AND ALSO BY IPJ OF MOKINGO COMMUNE THAT SEVERAL FRGF HAVE INFILTRATED INTO THE AREA BORDERING THAT COMMUNE. THE RPA CARRIED OUT A SPECIAL OPERATION IN THE FOREST AREA TO ARREST OR FLUSH THEM OUT. ACCORDING TO RPA, NO ONE WAS ARRESTED. THE RPA BELIEVES THAT SOME OF THE INFILTRATORS ARE STILL WITHIN THE COMMUNE AREA.

A. SECTOR 5A- RUHENGARI. MILOB PATROL TO NYAMUTERA COMMUNE (5719), WAS INFORMED THAT MOST OF THE EX-FRGF WHO WERE RECRUITED INTO THE RPA, HAVE DESERTED AFTER SEEING THE CONDITIONS THERE. THE RPA THEN LAUNCHED A SEARCH OP AND ARRESTED MOST OF THEM. HOWEVER THE WHEREABOUTS OF THE DESERTERS IS PRESENTLY NOT KNOWN.

B. IN SECTOR 3B (BUTARE), IN MUGUSA COMMUNE GR 8425, IT WAS LEARNT THAT A LOCAL WHO WAS ARRESTED BY THE RPA FOR BEING IN POSSESSION OF UNIFORMS, WAS SHOT DEAD ON 20 DEC 95. THE RPA CLAIM THAT THE DECEASED WAS KILLED WHILE TRYING TO ESCAPE. HR INFORMED AND INVESTIGATIONS IN PROGRESS.

C. IN SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA), IN MUGINA COMMUNE, RPA SOLDIERS SHOT DEAD A LOCAL ON 19 DEC 95 FOR ALLEGEDLY SUPPLYING WEAPONS TO THE INTERHAMWE DURING THE GENOCIDE. INVESTIGATIONS BY THE IPJ AND THE BOURGEMESTRE ARE IN PROGRESS. HR INFORMED.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 5A (RUHENGARI), THERE WAS A CIRCULATION OF LEAFLETS ABOUT THE RETURN OF FRGF ABOUT THREE WEEKS AGO. SENIOR RPA OFFICERS AND THE PREFECT OF RUHENGARI WENT AROUND AND TOOK SOME OF THE LEAFLETS AWAY. IN THE SAME SECTOR, ARMED BANDITS WHO CALL THEMSELVES "ABAZIMBABWE" HAVE INCREASED THEIR ACTIVITIES IN NYAMUTERA COMMUNE. SO FAR ONLY TWO OF THEM HAVE BEEN ARRESTED. IT WAS LEARNT THAT SOME RPA SOLDIERS HAVE BEEN COLLABORATING WITH THE BANDITS BY SUPPLYING THEM WEAPONS.

B. IN SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA), A MILOBS TEAM TO KIBUNGO SECTOR GR 8968 REPORTED THAT ONE LOCAL WAS KILLED IN KAMWILLI CELLULE ON 12 DEC 95 BY TWO CIVILIANS AND ONE MAN IN UNIFORM. THE MOTIVE FOR THE KILLING IS NOT KNOWN BUT BANDITS ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE CARRIED OUT THE KILLING. HR INFORMED.

C. IN SECTOR 5B (GISENYI), SABOTEURS BLASTED TWO ELECTRIC PYLONS ON THE ROAD TO THE BREWERY. THE MISCREANTS ALSO ATTEMPTED TO BLOW UP THREE PYLONS IN BUSHEKE GR 1911 AND BUGASHA GR 1909 CELLULES IN NYAMYUMBA COMMUNE. INVESTIGATIONS IN PROGRESS.

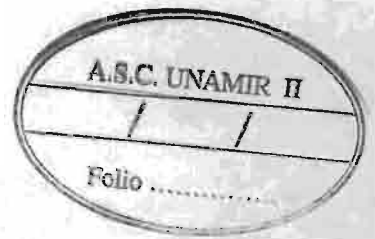



1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

1. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA.

A. MILOBS SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) REPORTED THE ARREST OF MR. MALACHIE NYAMULEMYE, IPS OF KAGAME COMMUNE, IN KIGALI WHILE ON A TRAINING COURSE. THE ALLEGED REASON FOR HIS ARREST IS THE RELEASE OF INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED FOR GENOCIDE WHO HAVE NOW FLED TO ZAIRE.

B. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) WERE INFORMED BY THE LOCALS OF THE ARREST OF AN INFILTRATOR BY RPA ON 13 DEC 95. THE ARRESTED PERSON CAME FROM ZAIRE AND WAS IN POSSESSION OF A GRENADE.

C. MILOBS SECTOR 5C (KIBUYE) WERE INFORMED BY LOCALS OF RUSTIRO COMMUNE (GR 4185) THAT SOME LOCALS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED BY RPA FOR UNKNOWN REASONS AND WERE TAKEN TO MILITARY CACHOT IN MUHIRA (GR 4185).

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) THE ICRC OFFICE IN CYANGUGU WAS ROBBED OF US \$4,500, RWF 700,000 AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS ON 14 DEC 95. THE ROBBERY WAS CARRIED OUT BY THREE ARMED MEN. NO ONE WAS INJURED DURING THE ROBBERY. THE RPA HAS ARRESTED SOME INDIVIDUALS IN THIS CONNECTION BUT NO RECOVERIES HAVE BEEN MADE SO FAR.

B. IN SECTOR 5A (RUHengeri), A HUTU COUPLE WAS KILLED BY SUSPECTED FRGF BANDITS ON 14 DEC 95 AT ABOUT 2030 HRS IN KABAYE SECTOR (GR 5833). THE MAN WAS A TEACHER AT THE SECONDARY SCHOOL IN RUHengeri AND HIS WIFE WAS A STUDENT OF THE SAME SCHOOL.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG MET WITH THE DUTCH CHARGÉ D'AFFAIRES, MR. VAN DE VEN, ALONG WITH MR. IAN MARTIN, CHIEF OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS FIELD OPERATIONS IN RWANDA, AND DISCUSSED THE KIBEHO INCIDENT AND HUMAN RIGHTS VOTING ISSUE IN THE 3RD COMMITTEE OF THE UN.

B. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT THE TANZANIAN DELEGATION LED BY PRESIDENT BENJAMIN MKAPA MET WITH RWANDAN PRESIDENT PASTEUR BIZIMUNGU IN MWANZA TOWN ON 14 DEC 95 AND AGREED TO RESUME REGULAR VISITS TO RWANDAN REFUGEES CAMPS IN TANZANIA BY RWANDAN LEADERS, TO COUNTERACT RUMOURS IN THOSE CAMPS. THEY ALSO EXPRESSED THEIR WISH THAT THE FACILITATORS OF THE CAIRO SUMMIT MEET IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO ANALYZE HOW FAR THE RESOLUTIONS HAVE BEEN IMPLEMENTED, AND TO PREPARE ANOTHER MEETING OF HEADS OF STATES OF THE GREAT LAKES REGION.

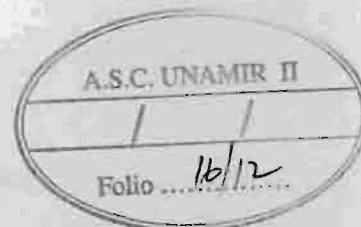

3. RPA. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED FREQUENT HARASSMENT OF LOCALS OF INNGANZO (GR 2202) AND GAHUMBA (GR 2292) BY RPA.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED INCREASED INFILTRATION OF INSURGENTS FROM THE PARC DES VOLCANS INTO THE AREA OF KABATWA (GR 3228). 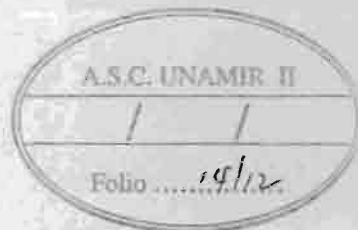

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.

2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA.

A. IN SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA) RPA LO AGREED TO INFO THE SECT CDR JUST BEFORE THE SEARCH OF GITARAMA PRISON BEGINS SO THAT THE LATTER COULD BE PRESENT. THE PURPOSE OF THE SEARCH IS NOT KNOWN.

B. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) ONE RPA SOLDIER STEPPED ON A MINE ON 12 DEC 95 IN RANGIRO SECTOR (GR 0733), KAMATSIRA CELL. THE SOLDIER LOST HIS RIGHT LEG.

C. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED FEW CASES OF CATTLE THEFTS IN RAMBA COMMUNE (GR 4893). THEY ALSO REPORTED ARREST OF 32 PERSONS OUT OF WHICH 12 HAD REFUSED TO ASSIST RPA IN NIGHT PATROLLING. THE REST ARE SUSPECTED OF HAVING PARTICIPATED IN THE GENOCIDE.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) ON 12 DEC 95 ONE MR. CLAUDE HARELIMANA OF RUGANO SECTOR (GR 1344) WAS SEVERELY BEATEN UP BY FOUR BANDITS. THE VICTIM REMAINS UNCONSCIOUS IN KIBOGORA HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS HOSPITALISED. AN UNSPECIFIED AMOUNT OF MONEY WAS ROBBED FROM HIM.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG ATTENDED THE HEADS OF AGENCIES MEETING AT THE UNDP PREMISES AND DISCUSSED MATTERS RELATING TO WHITE HELMETS INITIATIVES, THE JUSTICE SYSTEM AND UNAMIR'S MANDATE. LATER, HE HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE AND SPOKE ABOUT THE SECURITY COUNCIL'S DECISION TO RENEW THE MANDATE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE MONTHS DURING WHICH UNAMIR'S ACTIVITIES WOULD BE RELATED TO ENCOURAGING THE VOLUNTARY RETURN OF REFUGEES. AMBASSADOR KHAN NOTED THAT H.E. PRESIDENT BIZIMUNGU HAD PAID TRIBUTE TO UNAMIR II'S ROLE.

B. THE SRSG REFERRED TO THE INDICTMENTS ISSUED ON 12TH DECEMBER BY THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL IN ARUSHA AND EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT ALL MEMBER STATES INCLUDING KENYA WOULD COOPERATE WITH THE TRIBUNAL.

C. THE SRSG EXPRESSED CONCERN OVER THE SUSPENSION OF ACTIVITIES OF 38 NGOS AND ADDED THAT, WHILE IT WAS RWANDA'S SOVEREIGN RIGHT TO DECIDE SO, DO HOPE THAT THE APPEALS BY THE AFFECTED NGOS WOULD BE GIVEN DUE CONSIDERATION BY THE GOVERNMENT. THE SRSG FIRMLY DENIED THE STATEMENT ATTRIBUTED TO HIM REGARDING THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF ZAIRE AND TANZANIA WHILE REFERRING TO THE RADIO RWANDA REPORT OF 10 DECEMBER. HE HAD STATED THAT BOTH COUNTRIES ACKNOWLEDGED THE PRESENCE OF INTIMIDATORS WHO NEED TO BE SEPARATED FROM THE REST OF REFUGEES AND ALSO ACCEPTED TO PREVENT MILITARY TRAINING ON THEIR TERRITORY.

D. THE SRSG ALSO EXPRESSED CONCERN AT THE ARREST OF MR. JEAN-BAPTISTE BARAMBIRWA, PRESIDENT OF CLADHO, AFTER HE HAD MADE A SPEECH ON SUNDAY AND HOPED THAT HE WOULD BE TREATED WITH TRANSPARENT JUSTICE.

E. THE VICE PRESIDENT OF RWANDA AND VARIOUS MINISTERS VISITED BUTARE PREFECTURE AND ADDRESSED THE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS AND STAFF. THE CONTENTS OF ADDRESS NOT KNOWN.

A. RPA CONDUCTED A CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION OF GISENYI TOWN ON 05 DEC 95. RESULTS OF THE OPERATION UNKNOWN.

B. IN NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR, IN SECT 4 CYANGUGU, AT 051519 DEC, THERE WAS A SHOOTING INCIDENT INVOLVING RPA. RPA FIRED IN THE AIR TO ATTRACT THE ATTENTION OF THE OCCUPANTS OF A BOAT MOVING NORTH EAST DIRECTION ON LAKE KIVU (GR 133436). THE BOAT WAS TURNED TOWARDS THE SHORE. THERE WAS NO RESISTANCE FROM THE OCCUPANTS WHO WERE INTERROGATED BY RPA. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.

C. CIVPOL PTL TO MWENDO COMMUNE IN KIBUYE PREFECTURE, WAS INFORMED BY THE COMMUNAL POLICE THAT THE COUNCILLOR OF GASAYURA SECTOR WITHIN THE COMMUNE, WAS ARRESTED BY RPA FOR ORGANISING INSURGENT ACTIVITIES. HR INFORMED.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECT 3A, GIKONGORO, MILOB PATROL TO MUSEBEYA COMMUNE (GR 4033) REVEALED THE PRESENCE OF FORMER GOVT SOLDIERS IN THE COMMUNE. A CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN LAUNCHED TO CONVINCE THEM TO SURRENDER THEMSELVES, THEIR EQUIPMENTS AND WEAPONS.

5. REFUGEES. NSTR.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG ATTENDED THE HEADS OF AGENCIES MEETING AT THE UNDP COMPOUND. THEREAFTER, MR. DEGNI SEGNI, SPECIAL RAPPORTEUR UNHFOR CALLED ON THE SRSG AND DISCUSSED THE GENERAL SITUATION AND CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS CONCERNING RWANDA. LATER, THE SRSG HELD A MEETING WITH THE FORCE COMMANDER AND EXCHANGED VIEWS REGARDING THE FORCE LEVEL AND UNAMIR'S MANDATE.

B. ACCORDING TO RADIO RWANDA NEWS OF 5 DECEMBER, THE SRSG, IN HIS ADDRESS AT THE CONFERENCE OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF RWANDA, STRESSED THE NEED FOR STRENGTHENING THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM, SO AS TO BRING ABOUT STABILITY AND GIVE REFUGEES MORE CONFIDENCE. HE SAID THAT HE WAS PLEASED TO SEE HOW SOON THINGS STARTED IMPROVING AFTER WHAT HAPPENED IN RWANDA.

C. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED ON THE SAME DAY, THAT A MEETING WAS HELD IN GIKONGORO BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UN HIGH COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN RWANDA, UNAMIR FORCES AND RPA SENIOR OFFICERS ON THE QUESTION OF BANDITS IN NYUNGWE NATURAL FOREST. IT FURTHER REPORTED THAT, ON 27 NOVEMBER, PATROL SOLDIERS IN SHABA SECTOR, KIVU COMMUNE, HAD AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE WITH AN UNKNOWN PEOPLE BASED IN THE CAMP AT ABOUT 20KM IN THE FOREST. THE ENCOUNTER RESULTED IN THE KILLING OF TEN PEOPLE WHEREAS HUNDRED OF THEM FLED IN ALL DIRECTIONS.





2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA.

A. SECTOR 2A - REF THE REPORTED INCIDENT OF 30 NOV IN WHICH A TRUCK GOT STUCK IN THE MUD AT GAKUMA (GR 225539) WHILE DELIVERING SCHOOL MATERIAL TO MUVUMBA COMMUNE. THE MILOB TEAM LEADER OFF LOADED THE MATERIAL IN THE TRUCK INTO THEIR PICK-UPS AS THE RECOVERY COULD NOT BE ORGANISED THE SAME DAY AND LEFT AN ARMED ESCORT TO GUARD THE TRUCK. WHEN THE TEAM ARRIVED AT THE COMMUNE OFFICES AFTER 2100 HRS, THE ARMED ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE NAMED BOSCO MANZIA AND ANOTHER PERSON NAMED STANCLLAS MUBASHAKIWAYA BOTH DRESSED IN MILITARY UNIFORMS, IMMEDIATELY ARRESTED THE SCHOOL INSPECTOR AND ORDERED THE MILOBS TO LEAVE. WHEN THE TEAM LEADER EXPLAINED THAT THE INSPECTOR HAD THE KEYS TO THE STORE ROOM WHERE THEY HAD TO DEPOSIT THE ITEMS, THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE FIRED TWO SHOTS INTO THE LEGS OF THE ARMED ESCORT FROM GHANCOY BUT FORTUNATELY MISSED. THE TEAM LEADER CONTACTED THE HQ AND WAS TOLD NOT TO FIRE BACK BUT TO WITHDRAW TO A NEARBY CLINIC AND PROCEED BACK TO BYUMBA WITH THE REST OF THE PARTY AND MATERIAL LEAVING ONLY THE ROOFING SHEETS AND THE INSPECTOR IN THE HANDS OF THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE. ON 01 DEC 95, THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE AND HIS ACCOMPLICE WERE ARRESTED AND ARE BEING HELD AT BYUMBA GENDARMERIE. THE INSPECTOR WAS RELEASED AND THE SCHOOL ITEMS WILL BE DELIVERED TO MUVUMBA COMMUNE TODAY.

B. RPA CONDUCTED CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN THE NYAKINAMA COMMUNE (GR 5827) ON 30 NOV 95 FROM 0600 HRS TO 1800 HRS. ONE WEAPON WAS FOUND IN THE HOUSE OF ONE OF THE TWO COUNCILLORS WHO WERE ARRESTED FOR NOT MAINTAINING SECURITY IN THEIR AREAS. TWO CIVILIANS WERE ALSO ARRESTED DURING THE OPERATION FOR ALLEGEDLY HARBOURING FRGF SOLDIERS IN THEIR HOUSES.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 3A - MILOBS RECEIVED REPORTS THAT PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KILLED IN THE FOREST NEAR SHABA SECTOR (GR 397155) OF KIVU COMMUNE. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT ON 17 AUG 95, CONSEQUENT TO THE ARREST OF THE LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE (4914), LOCALS HAD FLED TO THE FOREST AND ESTABLISHED A CAMP WEST OF SHABA OF WHICH PEOPLE ON THE COMMUNE WERE NOT AWARE. LOCALS REPORTED HAVING HEARD FIRING ON 25 NOV 95 BETWEEN 0900 HRS TO 1600 HRS FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE CAMP. LOCALS ALSO REPORTED THAT THEY HAD SEEN ABOUT 08 PEOPLE IN UNIFORM IN SHABA AREA AND THESE HAD LEFT ON 26 NOV 95. ON RECEIPT OF ABOVE INFO, A TEAM OF MILOBS, HR AND ABOUT 40 TO 50 LOCALS WENT TO THE CAMP SITE WHICH HAD BEEN DESTROYED AND COUNTED UP TO 20 DEAD BODIES. ONE OF THE SURVIVORS SAID THAT PRIOR TO THE INCIDENT, ABOUT 135 PEOPLE WERE LIVING IN THE CAMP AND DURING THE SHOOTING,

THE PEOPLE HAD FLED INTO THE FOREST. THE EXACT NUMBER OF CASUALTIES COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED AS A NUMBER OF BODIES ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE BEEN DISPOSED OFF BY THE ATTACKERS. THE RPA SECOND IN COMMAND WHEN CONTACTED, DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE INCIDENT. HR INVESTIGATING.

B. SECTOR 5B - MILOB PATROL TO KIVUMU SECTOR (2303) REPORTED THAT SEVEN INDIVIDUALS HAD COME TO RWANDA FROM MUGUNGO CAMP IN ZAIRE CARRYING THREE ATK MINES, SIX HAND GRENADES AND TWO AK 47 RIFLES AND ASSORTED UNIFORMS. THE INFILTRATORS WERE SUSPECTED TO BE HIDING IN THE FOREST. ALSO IN THE SAME SECTOR ON THE NIGHT 29/30 NOV 95, SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE SURROUNDED THE HOUSE OF THE COUNCILLOR AND DEMANDED ENTRY. THE LOCALS RESPONDED TO THE SITUATION AND CHASED THE INSURGENTS AWAY.

C. MILOBS PATROL TO KANZENZE SECTOR GR 3019 WERE INFORMED BY LOCALS THAT 50 INTERHAMWE HAD INFILTRATED INTO THE COMMUNE CLOSELY FOLLOWED BY THE RPA. THE INSURGENTS HOWEVER ESCAPED INTO THE NEARBY FOREST.

A. FC HELD A MEETING WITH UNAMIR SENIOR STAFF TO DISCUSS THE FUTURE UNAMIR MANDATE.

B. MR. DUSAIDI, DIRECTOR OF CABINET FROM THE OFFICE OF RWANDAN VP AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE CALLED ON THE FC TO DISCUSS MATTERS OF MUTUAL CONCERN.

C. MR. E ASSEID, DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF UNHRFOR PAID A COURTESY CALL ON THE FC.

A. SECTOR 1

(1) 53 RETURNEES ARRIVED AT NDERA CAMP FROM BUTARE AND NYAGATARE. 56 RETURNEES WERE DESPATCHED BY UNHCR TO KIGALI, GITARAMA, NYAGATARE, BUTARE, KIBUNGO AND BYUMBA. A TOTAL OF 115 ARE STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM THE CAMP.

(2) INDBATT PROVIDED ESCORTS TO BROWN AND ROOT WATER TANKERS FOR NIGHT SHIFT DUTIES.

(3) INDBATT MEDICAL STAFF TREATED 95 MEDICAL AND 06 DENTAL PATIENTS AT OWN CLINIC.

B. SECTOR 2.

- (1) NORMAL DUTIES WERE CONDUCTED IN AOR.
- (2) GHANBATT PROVIDED TWO TRUCKS TO RPA FOR TRANSPORTATION OF FOOD FROM KIGALI TO BUTARE AND COMPLETED FENCING WORK ON WFP WAREHOUSE IN BIRENGA.
- (3) GHANBATT PROVIDED TWO TCVs TO KIBUNGO HOSPITAL FOR ACTIVITIES MARKING THE WORLD AIDS DAY, TWO TRUCKS TO MINISTRY OF JUSTICE TO TRANSPORT PRISONERS AND SIX TOYOTA PICK-UPS TO UNHCR FOR ESCORTING RETURNING REFUGEES.
- (4) 55 MEDICAL AND 08 DENTAL PATIENTS WERE TREATED AND DISCHARGED BY GHANBATT MEDICAL STAFF AT OWN CLINICS.

- (3) NICOY MEDICAL TEAM TREATED 40 LOCAL PATIENTS IN MADAM ROSE CARR'S ORPHANAGE CENTRE.

F. FORCE SIGNAL COY.

- (1) FORCE SIGNAL COY CONTINUED ASSISTING RWANDATEL IN ACTIVATION OF LOCAL LINES IN KIGALI.
- (2) SIG COY PROVIDED ON TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION OF WOOD FROM RUGALIKA TO NYAMAHURU ON REQUEST OF A LOCAL ORGANISATION ARDEC.

G. FORCE ENGR COY.

- (1) PROVIDED ONE VEHICLE TO ARDEC FOR CONVEYANCE OF WOOD.

(2) FORCE ENGR COY PROVIDED TWO DUMPERS FOR DESTRUCTION OF EXPIRED RATIONS AND DEPLOYED A DOZER FOR A REHABILITATION PROJECT IN KIGALI.

H. NORMED. TREATED 36 MEDICAL AND 11 DENTAL PATIENTS.

I. AIR OPS. A TOTAL OF 18 FLIGHTS OPERATED FOR THE DAY.

J. UN MP COY. FOUR TRAFFIC ACCIDENT WERE REPORTED AND ONE PRIVATE PROPERTY THEFT WERE RECORDED. NO INJURY WAS REPORTED IN ANY OF THE ABOVE INCIDENTS.
