Dear Sir, during my few terms as an Interpreter, I have failed three government officers asking me harsh questions. At first, when I had gone with the Platoon Commander to find out the total population of Kanzenze-Commune, the commanding officer who was in charge of Nyamata RPA military camp by that time asked me questions but I took it easy, I thought he wanted to know about me, though I didn't keep quiet I told the UNAMAIR^{Pl} Commander. Although the questions were harsh and they reflected something from his face.

The following are the questions and their respective answers I gave.

What is your name? I am called Simon

Are you a worker in the UNAMAIR? Yes Sir.

What work are you doing there? I am an Interpreter.

Are you a soldier? No Sir.

Where did you come from? I came from Uganda.

When did you come? I came in December.

Where do you stay? In Nyamata town Sir.

Then he failed the ~~Interpretation~~ test on 11-1-95.

• Whether she knows me, she told him that she knows me. then I was left to follow the UNAMIR Commander.

After some few days I was again called by a man claimed to be an intelligent officer and asked me the following questions which were too heavy to me.

• What is your name? I am called Ndutamenye Simon.

Your name sounds Kinyarwanda, are you a Rwandian?

Yes Sir.

Where did you come from? I came from Uganda.

When did you come? I came in December.

I see you always moving with the UNAMIR, are you a worker there? Yes Sir.

• How did you get to know those people? When I had gone to collect food from the Bourgmestress, I met the UNAMIR Patrol Commander in charge of Nyamata Camp by that time, when he heard me speaking English, he asked me my name, from there I became his friend.

What work are you doing there? I am a labourer but at times I interpret for them.

Are you paid? Yes Sir.

Do you get the ration from them? Yes Sir.

• When you go in the villages, what are the problems the people tell you? They tell us, they have not enough food from the UN, stealing of bananas, Cassava and cows by their fellow citizens.

What ~~are~~ about the people who are being killed in the village? I have ^{never} heard about that case except some few who are being arrested and taken to Nyamata prisons, the citizens say that they usually bring food for them.

Who are some of the visitors who usually visit the UNAMIR? The sports master who wanted to play football with the UNAMIR, some white men from the UN, people from the IRL and ~~some~~ from R.P.A. I don't know.

What do the UN officials tell them? They speak English, so it is not my concern to listen to what they say.

What do the IRE people come to do there? They come to ask for transport for the refugees.

How often do the UNAMIR visit the Bourgmestress? we who there twice at the office.

At what time do you usually visit her? during the day.

What did they ask her? At first they wanted to negotiate for accommodation and the second time she wanted the population of Kanzenze Commune.

Apart from the Supref and the Bourgmestress are there any other person who is being visited by the UNAMIR?
No Sir, I don't know.

After a long pause of about three minutes he asked me.

Don't the UNAMIR visit the Bourgmestress at night?

I don't know, at night I am always at my house, I don't do any work at night. While asking me he was writing everything I told him. He said good bye to me and I left for work.

Then recently as I was walking to the town with one UNAMIR Personnel, another tough man called ^{me} that man claimed to be the current Commander of Nyamata R.P.H Military Camp. He was in a company of two arms men. He started asking me the following questions.

How did you come to know those people you are working with? I was going to collect food from the Bourgmestress, when I met the former ~~Palatoon~~ ^{Platoon} Commander of UNAMIR, he heard me speaking English and that made us friends. I was happy to get a foreigner whom we can communicate.

How did you come to work there? I was called by the UNAMIR ~~Commander~~, when I went to him, he asked

me to be helping him as a labourer at his camp.
But I see you interpreting for them, who told you to do that? I interpret when it is necessary but that is not my work.
What do you interpret in the camp? I interpret for those who bring firewood, that is all what I interpret.
How much are you being paid? I told him \$50 per month. He continued telling me that, that work should not be done by me, rather it should be done by a soldier. I told him, well, he can come in but I am not an interpreter, I am a labourer. He then said, he will come and talk to the ~~that~~ Platoon Commander for UNAMIR about it, that it is illegal for the civilian to be with ~~the~~ military men ^{and join} all the time. He left me, I also left the UNAMIR Soldier.
