1. With reference to your memorandum C/ADM/520/2/5 of 6 May 1964, I wish to advise you that the above-mentioned generators are needed for emergency purposes for the supply of power to the Collins transmitter/receivers installed in the various field offices in the event of power breakdown.

2. You will realize that an *efficient* communication service between us and the field stations is absolutely necessary, and interruption of the service due to power failure might have adverse effects.
