Milob an Cirpol team visited Murama-commune. Talking to the Bourgmestre he declared, that the situation is generally calm. Only a stealing of a cow had been last week and in Riunguma there was an incident on Sunday 29th of Oct., that a man has shot his own house without hurting anybody. He was arrested in Murama-cachot. He thinks, he's insane.

Retourneés: Between 04.11.95 and 08.11.95: 2 retourneés NAO promised, to distribute seed in the 5 sectors.

On the 24.10.95, in Sectors Nkomero, Bueramume, Joma, Ruamangundo and Rubona seed of cassava, mais, sorghum & sweetpot. are distributed to poor families. Each family got 2 kg.

Murama-cachot:

The platoon-sergeant Alois Butare refused to see the cachot, because we haven't had the allowance papers with us.

Joma-section: The residents talked of no problems with bandits and the situation is still calm.
The last returnee had come in Sept.

Because they are suffering on hunger, they aren't able to cultivate their beans and sorghum fields. They also ordered batatas and casava, but it is not available.



Milob and Cirpol visited the sectors of Rayenzi commune. We talked to the people of nearly all sectors. It is remarkable, that after conversation with the people of the different sectors it seems to be very calm in the commune.

A few things were disclosed:

- Bitore: One person, named Fenziman had been arrested on Sunday, 29.th Oct. 95


- Mugerwa: Last week, unknown persons tried to steal some cows. The residents chased them successfully away.
- Bunyanga: Only 10 arrested in past 3 months
- Buguruma: 5 persons were coming back, after released from Kayenzi-cachot, accused of genocide.
- - Murango, Cubi and Nyambirembe: NTR
It's nothing heard in the sectors about refugees and returnees
- - Kayenzi: The Commune-administration was very busy, because on this day, there was a distribution of lenses, mais, beans and sorghum for the whole commune, so that there has been a lot of people.
Each member of a family, more than ten years old, gets 5kg of above mentioned food. The distribution was the whole day in progress.
We also dropped there 16 ~~thick~~ boxes with exercise-books.
The IPJ was also very busy and we had to go there three times for getting a date.

A visiting of the cachot was not possible.
A RPA-sergeant refused although we have
the permissions of the old and new brigade-commander.
After a few speeches, he went to ask for the
platoon commander. Backing he said, that he had
gone to Gitorama. But he was seen before at
the spot so we couldn't get into the cachot.
This problem is especially in Kayenzi.



 - Killings: 1 killing of a girl 20 years old, killed by the husband of his sister on 16 October 1995 in RUGENDABALI sector, than committed suicide, his body were found later on 31 October 1995. The investigation made by the bourgmestre and I.P.J lead to find that the killer is a mad since a long time.
 - Returnees: 22 since August 1995
 - Main problems: lack of sheaths to protect building materials given by "PAM" from rain
 - Remarks: The number of population belongs to BULINGA Commune is 35 469 < 18 806 women < 16 663 men
- 2- Gitarama PMT visited MUSHUBATI Commune, speaking with the bourgmestre, according him the general security situation remains calm unless few stealings of banana, potatoes and cows in some sectors. The population is about 64 000.
- 3- Gitarama PMT visited RUTOBWE commune, the general situation is good. The population is around 35 000.

* Robberies: few robberies of cows recently



OWN ACTIVITIES

MILIBS/CIVPOL TEAM PATROLLED TO MAKANGO COMMUNE TODAY AND HAD CONTACT WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE WHO REPORTED THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE AS CALM. THE TEAM VISITED THE COMMUNE PRISONS BUT MET THE IPJ ABSENT. THE RPA PLATOON COMMANDER KUNIZERA JUSTUS WAS CONTACTED AND HE ASSISTED THE TEAM TO INSPECT THE PRISONS. THERE IS A TOTAL NUMBER OF 224 DETAINEES ON GENOCIDE CASES INCLUDING 9 WOMEN AND A CHILD OF 2 YRS. THE BUILDING HOUSING THE PRISONERS IS TOO SMALL AND THE INMATES ARE OVERCROWDED. THE TEAM ALSO INSPECTED

THE TEAM ALSO INSPECTED A CATCHOT ATTACHED TO THE COMMUNE HQ. WHICH ALSO HAS 25 DETAINEES FOR COMMON CRIMES. THE COMMUNE HAS A CLINIC WHICH CATERS FOR THE PRISONERS.




1- Civpol team visited Butinga Commune, speaking with the bourgmestre and the following informations were collected:

- * Returnees: about 30
- * Robberies: few stealings of cows.
- * WFP: the commune received quantities of food last week and the distribution taken place during all the week.
- * Main problems: - Lack of community clinics (there are only two)
- lack of primary schools
- * Security: generally calm.

2- Civpol team visited the I.P.J, collecting the following informations:

- * Prisoners: - 67 for genocide (two of them are ladies).
- 4 assassins
- 3 for other crimes (one of them is a lady).
- 49 religious prisoners (temperas) were released on 30.9.95.

3- Civpol team received from R.P.A 5000 Amafanga, the price of diesel stolen on 9.10.95 and sold to small shops in Gikarama.
