Reycour OPS 1052. Nigeria police units en route Matadi by train was stopped at Kisantu - Nkisi at 1045 hours by ANC soldiers. Reason is that they were not informed of movement of Nigeria police to Matadi. Leopoldville ANC captain liaison officer pleaded in vain. Whole train and luggages of units searched. Units provoked to extreme. All men ordered to dismount train and form up to march to unknown destination. At this juncture 1 ANC officer intervened and ordered units back to train. Units detained for about  $3\frac{1}{2}$  hours. Later allowed proceed Matadi. No man was hurt. Arrived Matadi at about 2330 hours. Well received by ANC and police officers as well as territorial administrator. Relations very warm.




