Following a recent exchange of views with one of the members of the United Nations Council for Namibia, I had suggested to my Government that an invitation to visit Portugal be addressed to the members of the Council who are presently visiting some Western European countries.

Under instructions from my Government, I am now pleased to inform you that the Council for Namibia will be most welcome in Portugal and all possible facilities will be accorded to its members during their stay in Portugal, so as to enable them to carry out their mission with success. In this connection I would like to recall that the Government of Portugal is deeply committed to the cause of the Namibian people in their struggle for independence and self-determination, hence our continued interest in all activities of the Council aimed at achieving that goal within the shortest possible time.

I look forward to hearing from you on the program of the visit; in the meantime I dare suggest that the stay be scheduled from May 16th to 19th, during which ample

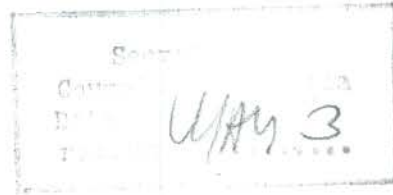
