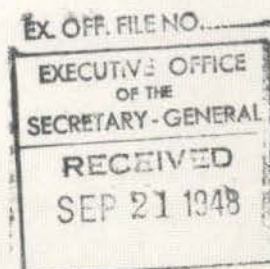

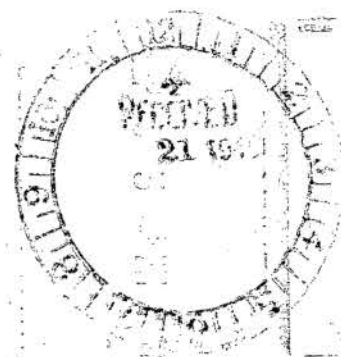

ORGANIZA UN CONCURSO MUNDIAL DE AFICHES
EL DEPARTAMENTO DE INFORMACION DE LA UN

El Departamento de Información de las Naciones Unidas organiza actualmente el segundo concurso de la serie "Afiche del Año", destinado a estimular a los artistas de oficio. Se ha resuelto en esta oportunidad que el tema del citado concurso sea el texto tomado del Preámbulo de su Acta Constitucional, en el que se expone la voluntad de los pueblos de "favorecer el progreso social e instaurar las mejores condiciones de vida en medio de la mayor libertad".

Las condiciones

Podrá participar del concurso todo artista profesional, mediante la presentación de un sólo boceto. Las maquetas no podrán presentar más que seis colores y deberán medir, incluida la leyenda, 45 cm. 7 x 60,9 cm. El afiche deberá ostentar un lema breve que no será parte integrante de su propósito, ya que posteriormente será traducido en varios idiomas, lo que ha de exigir un número mayor de palabras.

Los artistas participantes deberán utilizar para sus lemas aquellos símbolos que sean comprendidos universalmente y que no pertenezcan ostensiblemente a una nación o a un grupo de naciones. Las "maquetas" o bocetos no deberán traducir ideas ya expresadas en concursos precedentes.

Los interesados deberán enviar anotados sus nombres y apellido, nacionalidad y dirección a la que puede ser devuelto el afiche si el mismo no es reservado por el jurado. Estas señas deberán ser anotadas al dorso de su "maquette" respectiva y recubrirlos con un papel blanco a fin de mantener el secreto de su identidad. En el anverso del boceto no deberá aparecer ninguna firma.

Valiosos premios

Al autor del mejor trabajo presentado se le otorgará un premio de 1.500 dólares, recibiendo premios de 1.000 y 500 dólares, respectivamente, a los trabajos que ocupen el segundo y tercer puesto. Además serán otorgadas 10 menciones honoríficas por valor de 100 dólares cada una.

Los afiches que hayan merecido un premio o una mención de honor, quedarán de propiedad de la Organización de las Naciones Unidas que se reserva todos los derechos de reproducción. Los bocetos no reservados serán devueltos.

Fecha de clausura

La entidad organizadora hace saber a los artistas interesados que entre los afiches enviados serán elegidos los tres mejores presentados y luego enviados a M. Benoit-Lévy, Centro de Información de las Naciones Unidas, Avenida Kléber, 19, París, Francia. Igualmente hace saber que los trabajos deberán llegar a destino antes del 15 de Octubre próximo, donde un jurado internacional procederá a discernir los premios establecidos.
