Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to your note verbale of 23 August 2010, requesting a meeting between the Secretary-General and the Prime Minister of Denmark, His Excellency Mr. Lars Løkke Rasmussen, during the forthcoming General Debate period of the General Assembly.

We have been making careful reviews of the programme of the Secretary-General on a continuing basis to accommodate a maximum number of bilateral meetings with world leaders. Despite this, I regret to inform you that conflicting commitments will not permit a scheduled meeting during the period requested. I know you will understand that the time available for bilateral meetings during the High-level Plenary Meeting on the Millennium Development Goals and the General Debate of the sixty-fifth session of the General Assembly is severely limited by the number of key multi-lateral meetings and other events on the margins of the General Assembly that, inevitably, require the direct and continuous participation of the Secretary-General.

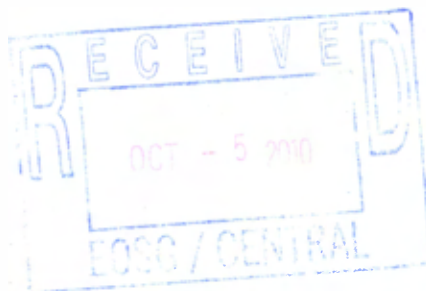
I would therefore be most grateful if you could convey to His Excellency Mr. Lars Løkke Rasmussen the above mentioned circumstances which would preclude a bilateral meeting with the Secretary-General. Needless to say, we look forward to arranging a suitable meeting on a later occasion.

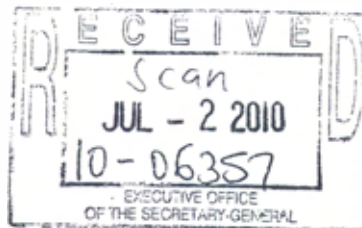

The Permanent Mission of Denmark to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Executive Office of the Secretary General and has the honor to refer to its Note Verbale of 2 August 2010, acknowledging receipt of a request for a meeting between His Excellency Ban Ki-moon, Secretary General of the United Nations, and H.E. Mr. Lars Løkke Rasmussen, Prime Minister of Denmark, on 23 or 24 September 2010 and requesting the Permanent Mission to inform Mr. Yeocheol Yoon, Chief of the Scheduling Office, of any changes in the plans of the Prime Minister and any details regarding the topics to be discussed in the meeting.

The Permanent Mission of Denmark can update the scheduled presence of H.E. Mr. Lars Løkke Rasmussen, Prime Minister of Denmark, in New York as follows: the Prime Minister will arrive during the afternoon of Tuesday 21 September and stay until Thursday 23 September 2010 in the evening. During this time the Prime Minister will be available for meeting the Secretary General early in the morning or late afternoon of 22 September or early morning or afternoon of 23 September. The Prime Minister will leave New York late evening 23 September.

During the requested meeting the topics to be discussed could include climate change and the situation in Afghanistan.

The Permanent Mission of Denmark to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Executive Office of the Secretary General the assurances of its highest consideration.
