Dear Ms. Malcorra:

The MIT Sloan Fellows Program, now in its 85<sup>th</sup> year, is an elite 12-month program which prepares exceptional mid-career managers for increased roles of responsibility and leadership in organizations worldwide. The MIT Sloan Fellows will be traveling to New York this December to meet with senior executives as part of our leadership curriculum and we would be honored to have you as a featured speaker during our brief stay in New York. It is with thanks to Mohamed Elkaraksy, Diplomat, Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and member of the class of 2015; and Charles Callanan, Director Global Partnerships Office and member of the class of 2014, that we have this unique opportunity to request a meeting with you.

To put our request in context, let me take this opportunity to explain our program in more detail. To complement our academic program on campus at MIT, we arrange for the Fellows to meet with senior leaders in a wide range of organizations during business trips within the United States. The purpose of our New York trip is to familiarize the Fellows with major issues facing leading organizations in key New York for-profit and non-profit sectors, from the perspective of the **organizations'** top officials. In recent years, we have met with Jeffrey Immelt of GE, Glenn Lowry of MoMA, Duncan Niederauer of NYSE Euronext, and Kenneth Chenault of American Express. We also met with Kofi Annan, a 1972 Sloan Fellows alumnus, until his retirement in 2006. It is the perspectives and first-hand experiences that leaders have shared with classes over the years that has sustained our trip to New York as one of the most successful and longest-standing features of the leadership component of our program.

Participating in our **December 15-18** visit to New York City this year will be 118 mid-career professionals from 35 countries and nearly as many industries.
