



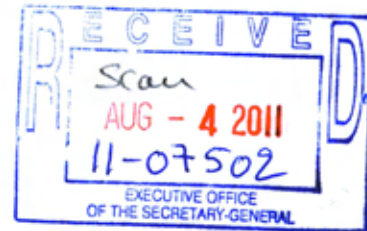

Excellency:

The U.S. Department of Defense currently provides certain types of logistical support and services to the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI) in accordance with the "Agreement between the United States of America and the United Nations Organization Concerning the Provision of Services and Commodities on a Reimbursable Basis in Support of the Operations of the United Nations Assistance Mission in Iraq" (herein "the Agreement"). Pursuant to Article VII.2 of the Agreement, it "may be terminated by either Party upon 90 days written notification to the other Party."

As the U.S. Government draws down its forces in Iraq, the Department of Defense will be unable to continue to provide support to UNAMI pursuant to the Agreement. This letter serves as notice that on October 31 2011, on which date the Agreement shall be terminated, U.S. Forces-Iraq will be unable to perform the tasks described in the Agreement.

I recommend that we continue to discuss the specific timing and details for the conclusion of these services in the bi-weekly telephone conferences held among United Nations Headquarters, UNAMI, U.S. Embassy Baghdad, the U.S. Department of State, and the U.S. Department of Defense.
