I have just seen Schaeffer's cable to Thelen and must confess to a feeling of extreme surprise both as to its tone and contents. I am sure you must regret as I do the imputations made personally against Grun who as you know is carrying an extremely heavy burden with conscientiousness and devotion.

2. I understand that during your visit a full discussion took place regarding the operation and the question of relating the need for food and other supplies with the problem of funds both actual and promised. You will recall that at the time the operation was just getting into stride, and there were many imponderable and uncertain factors to be contended with.

3. The position has developed that while adequate supplies of food (except fish) and funds designated specifically for food purchases are available till July, there is an acute lack of funds for operational and transport purposes. Grun had, in consultation with his collaborators, placed before you an estimate of funds required at that time for specific food purchases, and although an allotment was generously made by the League, the money has not been received and has certainly not been drawn upon. If you agree, the funds allotted by the League could be very usefully employed for the purchase of 400 tons of fish and we would request your early reactions to this proposal.

4. Incidentally, I am informed that a personal request was made to you for assistance in finding suitable personnel for operational work among the refugees. We would be grateful if you would examine the possibilities. You may also feel that the expense of maintaining a delegate in Leo, far from the scene of the refugee operations, is perhaps hardly justified.

As you are aware, Procurement and Supply Section have been closely cooperating with the Food Relief Section in connection with materials and equipment urgently required for the refugee programme.

Assistance has been rendered in arranging the movement of supplies and the allocation of vehicles which could be transferred for use on the refugee programme. In addition, local procurement of many items has been effected on an urgent basis.

A quantity of 500 tons of maize flour and 50 tons of dried fish is now reported to be available in Uganda and a request has been made by the Food Relief Coordinator that the Deputy Chief Procurement Officer proceed to Entebbe to arrange contracts for the supply of this foodstuff and the air movement into the Congo.

I feel that it is desirable that this trip should be made and would appreciate your approval. It is considered that the trip will be completed in four days.
