The Scheduling Office would like to confirm that the Secretary-General has seen the note and the luncheon is already scheduled in his calendar.

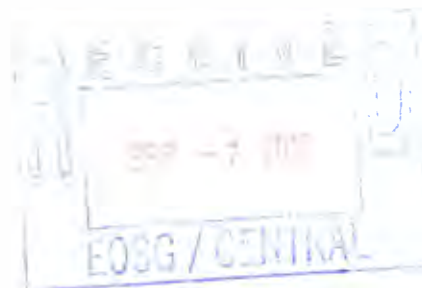

**Luncheon for Messengers of Peace and Goodwill Ambassadors  
on International Day of Peace**

As you know, the International Day of Peace (IDP) will be observed on Friday, 21 September 2012, and its theme will be "Sustainable Peace for a Sustainable Future."

Messenger of Peace (MOP) Ms. Jane Goodall has confirmed her attendance, as has UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador (GWA) Mr. Forest Whitacker and UN Foundation "Girl Up" Champion Ms. Monique Coleman. They will take part in the Peace Bell Ceremony and the annual Student Observance of the International Day of Peace, in which the Secretary-General will also participate.

We also anticipate receiving positive responses from UNAIDS GWA the Crown Princess of Norway Mette-Marit and the Indian actress Aishwariya Rai Bachchan.

The Secretary-General has kindly indicated his readiness to hosting the luncheon in their honour again this year. We would propose it be held at 1:00 p.m. in Private Dining Room 1-3. A proposed guest list is attached, which includes the three winners of a global contest arranged by the United Nations Academic Impact inviting students to "imagine" a speech delivered by the Secretary-General to the General Assembly, and a representative of Brookings Institution, our partner in this endeavour. The student winners will have a photo-op with the Secretary-General prior to the luncheon.

I would be grateful to receive your confirmation that this proposal has the Secretary-General's approval and that the EOSG would, as in the past, allocate funding to cover the expense of the luncheon.
