1. CRABBE HAS JUST HAD A LONG CONVERSATION WITH MULUMBA, GIZENGAS CLOSEST ASSISTANT, ON HIS MISSION TO LEOPOLDVILLE THE MISSION HAS THE FULL APPROVAL OF GIZENGA. MULUMBA MADE IT CLEAR, HOWEVER, THAT IT IS A QUOTE PRIVATE MISSION UNQUOTE WITHOUT ANY NEGOTIATING POWERS, AS HE FEELS (AND BOTH CRABBE AND I AGREE WITH HIM) THAT ANY FORMAL LINK WITH THE PRESENT STANLEYVILLE AUTHORITIES WOULD ONLY RESULT IN HAMPERING THE MISSIONS WORK IN LEOPOLDVILLE. FOR THE SAME REASON, AND IN ORDER FURTHER TO STRESS THE MISSIONS INDEPENDENCE AND ITS PURELY INFORMATIVE CHARACTER, GIZENGA WOULD PREFER THAT CRABBE AND AUTRIQUE TRAVEL BY COMMERCIAL AIRLINE. THEY PLAN THEREFORE TO TAKE THE AIR CONGO PLANE WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO LEAVE STANLEYVILLE TOMORROW

2. MULUMBA WAS CAREFUL TO POINT OUT TO CRABBE THAT HIS RECOMMENDATION REGARDING THE NON-UTILISATION OF A ONUC AIRCRAFT WAS NOT DUE QUOTE TO ANY ANIMOSITY TOWARDS THE UN UNQUOTE BUT ONLY TO THE REASONS STATED ABOVE. ON THE OTHER HAND, MULUMBA STATED THAT HE SHOULD BE GRATEFUL FOR ANY HELP WHICH YOU MIGHT GIVE CRABBE TO FACILITATE HIS CONTACTS

3. CRABBE, WITH WHOM I HAVE HAD SEVERAL CONVERSATIONS, STRIKES ME AS ONE OF THE MOST INTELLIGENT AND RESPONSIBLE BELGIANS I HAVE MET IN THE CONGO. HIS VIEWPOINT IS BOTH SENSIBLE AND IMAGINATIVE AND HIS REALISTIC APPROACH TO CURRENT PROBLEMS DOES NOT SHOW ANY TRACE OF CYNICISM. I WOULD LIKE TO RECOMMEND HIM TO YOUR ATTENTION

1. LUNDULA HAS PASSED ON TO US A RADIO MESSAGE FROM BUKAVU RECEIVED TODAY BY JOSEPH AMUNDALA, 'SECRETAIRE DE LA SURETE NATIONAL', ACCORDING TO WHICH 500 ANC OFFICERS AND MEN HAVE BEEN RECENTLY 'PARACHUTED' IN USUMBURA BY MOBUTU WITH THE ACQUIESCENCE OF (AS THE REPORT COLOURFULLY PUTS IT) 'LES INCOMPREHENSIBLES ET ECREVELES BELGES'

2. WE HAVE TOLD LUNDULA THAT WE DO NOT THINK THAT THERE ARE 500 PARATROOPERS IN MOBUTUS ARMY AND THAT IT IS MOST UNLIKELY THAT THE BELGIAN GOVERNMENT WOULD CONSENT AGAIN TO THE UTILISATION OF RUANDA URUNDI AS A BASE OF DEPARTURE FOR ANOTHER MISCONCEIVED MILITARY AGGRESSION AGAINST ANY OF THE CONGOLESE PROVINCES, PARTICULARLY AT A TIME WHEN THE SHANGUGU BLUNDER IS BEING DISCUSSED BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL. LUNDULA INSISTED, HOWEVER, THAT ANYTHING CAN BE EXPECTED FROM 'UNE NATION D'ECERVELES' AND WOULD APPRECIATE GETTING A FORMAL ASSURANCE FROM NEW YORK THAT THE REPORT IS TOTALLY WITHOUT FOUNDATION. SHOULD THERE BE ANY BASIS FOR IT, HE REQUESTS THAT THE MATTER BE IMMEDIATELY REFERRED TO SECURITY COUNCIL

1. THE MISSION COULD BE COMPOSED OF MR B AUTRIQUE, DIRECTEUR GENERAL DE LA BELGIKA AND PRESIDENT DE L ASSOCIATION DES ENTREPRISES DE LA PROVINCE ORIENTALE (THE LOCAL BRANCH OF THE FEDERATION DES ENTREPRISES CONGOLAISES) AND MR J CRABBE, DIRECTEUR DE L ASSOCIATION

2. THE PURPOSE OF THE MISSION IS TO DISCUSS WITH THE LEOPOLDVILLE AUTHORITIES AND BUSINESS GROUPS CONCERNED THE ECONOMIC PROBLEMS CREATED BY THE EXISTING POLITICAL CONFLICT BETWEEN LEOPOLDVILLE AND STANLEYVILLE WITH A VIEW TO THEIR AMIABLE SOLUTION IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE REPUBLIC AS A WHOLE. 1. I HAVE INFORMED LUNDULA OF THE CONTENTS OF YOUR SIGNAL STRESSING THE FACT THAT IF THE SECRETARY GENERAL HAD NOT ACTIVELY INTERVENED IN THE MATTER THE BELGIAN TROOPS OF RUANDA WOULD CERTAINLY HAVE ACTED IN LESS NEUTRAL FASHION. I ALSO POINTED OUT THAT THE INCIDENT OF SHANGUGU, BY EXPOSING A SITUATION WHICH UNTIL NOW HAD REMAINED MOSTLY UNDERGROUND, WILL POSSIBLY MAKE CERTAIN COLLUSIONS MORE DIFFICULT IN THE FUTURE
2. LUNDULA WAS SO HAPPY TO HEAR OF THE ARREST OF MOBUTUS TROOPS BY THE BELGIAN GARRISON OF RUANDA THAT HE SANG A PAEAN OF PRAISE OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL WHOM HE DESCRIBED AS "THE HEAD OF THE WORLD". I EXPLAINED TO HIM THAT ALTHOUGH THE POWERS OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL WERE NOT AS GREAT AS HE BELIEVED IT WAS THROUGH HIS PERSONAL INTERVENTION THAT THE DANGER OF CIVIL WAR IN ORIENTALE HAS BEEN AVERTED FOR THE TIME BEING.
