1. I am not aware of any special orders having been issued on write-off and disposal procedure, although your files on the subject shew that you have repeatedly asked for these from Disposals Branch, Supply Div. III.

2. The only order on the subject is E.R.O. No.A.201 dated 20th March, 1946. Para. 8 of this Order lays down that Admin. property will be accounted for in accordance with the Admin. Prop. Accountability Manual. The procedure to be followed for "write-off" is outlined in para. 3 M of this manual. According to this para. the Property Survey Committee is the final authority for "write-off".

3. Having been written off charge as a serviceable vehicle, the casualty should be reported on the monthly census return. It is at this point that confusion arises. The vehicle "carcass" still remains on charge of the Mission as a condemned (unserviceable) vehicle until disposed of by sale or cannibalisation.

4. I consider sub-para. (5) para. 3 M of the Manual vests the Property Survey Committee with complete authority to lay down method of disposal. There has, however, been correspondence on the interpretation to be put on sub-para. (1), viz. what is the source from which the Committee derives its authority? You have copies in your files of these letters or letter.

5. I would like to discuss this matter further and arrive at some "drill" whereby all concerned may be made aware of what condemnations take place.

*Ref min. 3 :-*

1. There is still no firm policy. I have hopes that something may be finalised at the Supply Conference.
2. & 3 agreed. I think you should therefore tell Tirana you must have their Survey Report before you can authorise write-off. Disposal instructions would follow.
4. I think this is debateable. Responsibility rests with Washington and/or London. Anyhow we know that both are now preparing a disposals policy.
5. It has been laid down that disposals is a Supply responsibility. Write-off authority is an O. & M. responsibility, and its procedure should conform to Para. 3M of the Admin. Prop. Accountability Manual.

I suggest therefore that when our members return from the Supply Conference, we should arrange a meeting to agree implementation of its findings.

In the meantime, there would appear to be no reason to interfere with the existing Survey Board and Monthly Census procedure.

It is desired to establish a procedure whereby the Vehicle Census Records of all Administrative Property Vehicles held by Missions shall be complete at the closure of U.N.R.R.A. operation.

Your attention is directed to the instructions contained on No. 2 Copy of the Vehicle Numbering Card which is retained by Missions holding the vehicle on charge, and the disposal of the card when that particular vehicle is transferred from one Mission to another.

In the closure stages of U.N.R.R.A. operations the Chief Disposals Officer E.R.O. will be authorising the transfer of Administrative vehicles from Missions to Governments, and in certain cases directing the disposal by sale within countries concerned.

It is essential that all vehicle numbering cards applicable to vehicles that have been transferred to Governments, successor International Organisations, or sold, are suitably endorsed showing the final disposition, and returned to this office immediately the transaction is completed.

Upon further investigation we have found that the  
two Station Wagons which were consigned to us on the "NAILSEA MOOR"  
as AA 153 and AA 155 were discharged at Trieste in error, along  
with 10 Station Wagons for the Yugoslav Mission. As we have no  
Port Representative at that office we requested the Yugoslav Mission  
Port Officer to send the two vehicles by road to Brindisi for ship-  
ment to Albania. They were received here March 1946.

Inasmuch as Yugoslav Mission records show that vehicle  
AA 155 was received by them, we no doubt have received a vehicle  
which was intended to be for them. No vehicle has been transferred  
by us to the Yugoslav Mission.

A census return has now been received from the Yugoslavian Mission which includes the following vehicle on their strength.

You will observe that the chassis number of this vehicle is the same as that for AA 155 and it would seem that at some time or another AA 155 was transferred from you to the Yugoslavian Mission.
