KALONJI TROOPS HAVE ARRIVED PANIA THE NIGHT OF 10 MAY. THEY ARE MASSACRING THE POTULATION MERCILESSLY. ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN EXPELLED FROM THEIR POSTS. AUTHORITIES KABINDA LEFT 11 MAY. WE LACK NEWS. WE DEMAND IMMEDIATE INTERVENTION KALONJI ALBERT WITHDRAW HIS TROOPS. IF NOT THE POPULATION WILL INTERVENE ENERGETICALLY AGAINST THE KALONJISTS. TROOPS ON THE SPOT ARE NOT AGREEABLE TO INTERVENE. AWAITING APPROVAL OF COLONEL NATIONAL ARMY LULUABOURG.

Texts of Demole and Kalala messages were shown to Kiembe. The falsity of allegations were pointed out to him. He agreed in the first instance to send a message to Demole requesting him to clarify situation by contacting Commander UAT troops in Lulubang. It could not be ascertained if message was in fact sent. The move of paracommandos from Lusamba to Leopoldville has been delayed because of airlift difficulties. Kiembe has asked that troops be airlifted by UAT A/Cs. He has offered to send Comdt Bache to assist in organizing this move. He feels that troops should ~~be~~ moved ~~to~~ from Lusamba to Lulu by road and immediately airlifted to Léa. They should not be allowed to spend anytime in Lulu. Your views on this proposed move

TRANSLATION

From time to time I get news that the Ghanaians and Lulus are attacking Civilians in the village of KINDA (30 Km EAST of MWEKA)

The Congolese soldiers of MWEKA have fled in order to go to PORT FRANCOUI because they are afraid of the Ghanaian soldiers. Because the number of Ghanaians and Lulus is greater than that of the ANC. It is necessary to arrange to prevent troubles. They are killing the Balubas, Bashilele and the Balubas. UNO at LULUABOURG and the ANC should prevent these troubles and act as agreed at the conference in LULUABOURG on 5 May under the Chairmanship of the Vice-President at LULUABOURG. It is necessary that UNO and ANC prevent troubles of this kind. UNO should not help one race and abandon another. UNO is in CONGO to help everybody. How can that be done if UNO fills its trucks with Lulus to attack Baluba, Bakuba and Bashilele. That is not at all its duty. It is necessary that ANC and UNO stop these troubles immediately. Here at PORT FRANCOUI there are not enough soldiers. Send more ANC soldiers to PORT FRANCOUI with the Administrator.

Subject: STATEMENT OF HAPPENINGS AT PORT FRANQUI END OF APRIL 1961

Sir,

24/4. Bable to UN representative Port Francqui (which was in fact Boettiger and Ralph) from ONUC Leo M. Fournier telling that two ministers were to arrive on Wednesday and were to be protected by UN. They were to be lodged at Hotel des Palmes Port Francqui which was entirely taken over by UN. There lived 2/Lt Scott, 3 Swedes, one British doctor, one Polish doctor and about 20 Ghana ORS. No Congolese. All Lulua personnel had left Sunday.

26/4. In the morning ANC put up roadblocks between Airfield and town and Ghana answered by setting up roadblocks between harbour and town. At around noon the two ministers arrived and were met at Airfield by Capt Ralph and Lt Boettiger and an UN escort of 1 + 3. They were driven across airfield and bypassing the roadblocks they were taken to the hotel.

At about 1300 hrs a truckload of ANC commanded by an ANC-officer surrounded the hotel and wanted to speak to the ministers. After a chat in the lobby the ANC withdrew but doing so they caught sight of a BCK flag hanging on a balcony and were very annoyed. ANC declared that they were to come back next day and take the hotel by force at 0900 hrs. The hotel was guarded by 3 UN-sentries.

The Swedes noticed that tension rose in town and expected something to happen in the near future.

27/4. In the morning one ANC-officer and some men arrived at the hotel and wanted to talk to the ministers, who escorted by UN under Capt Ralph went to the Congolese Camp. UN-escort returned but Capt Ralph stayed on for a while with the ministers. After a while Capt Ralph returned in his own car, his shirt having been damaged. Shortly afterwards the ministers were brought back by the ANC. At about noon the UN-soldiers took up positions in the hotel-building on the balcony around the groundfloor and first floor.

Assembled in the hotel were 3 British officers, 1 British and 1 Polish

doctor, 3 Swedes and around 25 UN ORS.

At about 1300 hrs there was some noise around the 300 meters distant HQ and the 3 British Officers went there by car and got arrested on the way. Before going Ralph told Boettiger to take command and not shoot unless in danger. About 150 ANC now surrounded the hotel. The ANC shouted at the Ghana troops that they did not want them but the white ones.

ANC entered the hotel, took out the 3 Swedes and a British doctor in the yard. The doctor immediately released. When the ANC officer in command heard that the Swedes were Movement Control people the Swedes were taken into the hotel again but the ANC-soldiers took them out again and took away their UN-barrets and stripped them of their insignias and took all their personal belongings from them. The Swedes were forced into a Land-Rover, at this moment Boettiger got a severe blow in his head by a rifle-butt. They were taken to an ANC building some 250 meters away and were put on the veranda. There they met with the 3 British officers, who were in rather bad shape having been beaten like Boettiger. At the balcony were also six Belgians from BCK. After a while the two ministers arrived and were first placed at the balcony but soon brought to another room. Two ANC-soldiers now gave first-aid to Capt Ralph, a British Lt and Lt Boettiger. Soon Boettiger lay down on the floor conscious but shocked. Aaberg fainted after some hours and fell on the stonefloor and got hurt in his back-head. After about three hours Capt Ralph, Lt Brown, Lt Boettiger and Aaberg were taken to the BCK-hospital where they were well treated by white nuns.

Lt Scott and W/O Liedgren were left behind on the balcony.

28/4. At around 1100 hrs shooting was heard around the hospital. Five ANC took Capt Ralph, Lt Brown, Lt Boettiger and W/O Aaberg out. Ralph in pyjamas, the others in trousers. Just outside the hospital Boettiger got a heavy riflebutt-blow and got his skull fractured and bled heavily and barely managed to walk. Two nuns were also taken out. They now walked some 200 meters over to the Congolese hospital where they sat down and were tied together. Aabergs right arm to Capt Ralphs right arm to Lt Boettigers right arm to Lt Browns right arm. They walked and turned right towards the Portuguese bar. Half way and over the open grass the party was joined by WO Liedgren guarded by a Congolese police or gendarm. Liedgren was not tied together with the 4 others. Having passed the Portuguese bar they stopped behind a roadblock and stood in order from left to right Liedgren, Aaberg, Ralph, Boettiger and Brown. Liedgren now was ordered to walk a small path

leading into the bush. Just before he got out of sight he turned and seeing the police, rifle in shooting position, Liedgren shouted "Don't shoot". After that Liedgren went out of sight and the police shot the first round and Liedgren yelled. At that moment Aaberg was ordered by his ANC-guard to loosen himself from the rope and to walk the same way as Liedgren. Aaberg, however, now observed that his ANC-soldier started to load his rifle, took his chance, and passing between his guard and Liedgren's police fired his second round after Liedgren. Capt Ralph now shouted to Aaberg "good sergeant-major, run away." Aaberg ran for some 20 meters into the bush and threw himself on the ground. Some 5 shots now were fired after Aaberg and he heard some more shots being fired but not in his direction. When Aaberg heard voices nearing he went up and ran further into the bush.


He hid in the jungle and was the whole time hunted. Some shots now and then.

29/4. Saturday morning he went to Officer's Mess to call on doctor, but saw ANC and Police there when he was hiding in the grass.

Saturday afternoon hid near river, was observed by Police and he climbed a palmtree to hide himself. Jumped from palmtree, ran down to river, jumped in got shot at 5 shots, swam to other side, saw Police there, hid in the weeds in river, searched by one motor-boat and one canoe. Three hours in water. Police disappeared. Police-sergeant found him and told him to come out. He was taken to Congolese Camp. Brought up with 20-25 Ghanaians in Commandant's house over night. Food and beer given to him.

Sunday UN-DC 3 took him to Luluabourg.

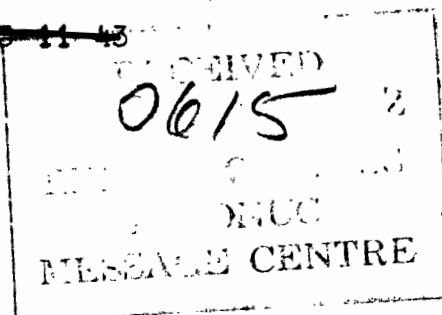

Warrant Officer AABERG arrived at Leo at 20.00 hrs 1st May 61 and was admitted to ONUC Hospital Leopoldville. His condition is stated to be good.

AABERG reports that on Thursday 28 April, following the visit of ministers to Port Francqui, 4 whites including Swedish and British officers with Ghana troops were arrested and beaten and then taken to local hospital. On Friday 29, the day of the ambush, the four were taken out and tied together and brought by the ANC to the edge of the jungle. Warrant Officer LINDGREN who was not with the party in the hospital was also brought to this place. Lindgren was released and told to run along a path into the jungle. AABERG last saw Lindgren appealing to a ANC soldier not to shoot him. LINDGREN then run and AABERG heard 3 shots - he did not see him again. AABERG was then released and also told to run into the jungle. But the ANC soldier who was detailed to look after him did not have his gun loaded and whilst the soldier was reloading AABERG fled into the jungle where he remained in hiding and frequently escaped detection until Saturday. A Congolese Police sergeant who found him persuaded him to come back to Port Francqui where he remained under arrest until rescued and taken to Luluabourg.

AABERG states that when he last saw Lt BOETTIGER he was bleeding profusely from a severe skull injury which he received when first beaten on Thursday.

Six Belgians and some nuns were also present at Port-Francqui on Thursday but AABERG is not clear if they were interfered with by the ANC.

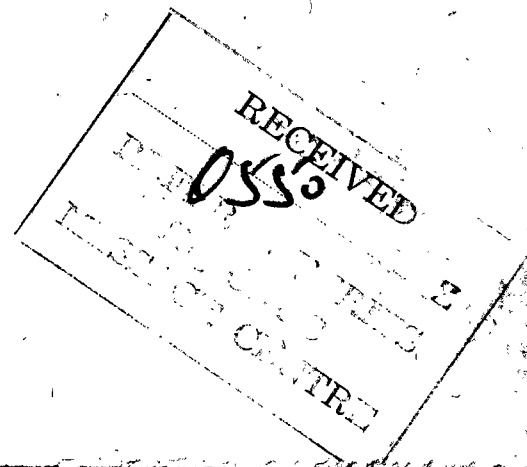

Confirmed casualties are as follows:

- 2 British officers, Ghana Brigade
- 1 Swedish Officer
- 1 warrant officer of Movement Control

These are known to be shot and are almost certainly dead. The incidents started by the arrival of the Minister of Interior and the Minister of Education of the Luluabourg Provincial Government on a visit to attempt to sort out present tribal troubles in Port-Francqui. ANC at Port-Francqui resented this being done with UN cooperation. There were other small irritations about accommodation. In addition reinforcements from Luluabourg which were sent originally to sort out tribal troubles was also a factor. The ANC officer in Port-Francqui had been absent in Luluabourg during this time. He only returned to-day. Yesterday 27 April, the ANC succeeded in disarming UN detachment by swamping ~~there~~ positions. Casualties at that stage was nil. This morning 28 April a patrol from Mweka was sent to investigate and was ambushed and forced to withdraw after a considerable shooting. Probably some ANC casualties at this stage. This incident appears to have inflamed the ANC in the town who then ~~returned~~ turned on the UN prisoners which they had and shot them. This latter is a supposition and will be confirmed later, but appears to be correct. We are sending in to-morrow morning by air to Luluabourg from Leo one Liberian Company as a reinforcement.
