SUBJECT: STEALING OF MDM VEHICLE

1. MR. WIL FRED, A TEAM LEADER OF MDM CYANGUGU, DRIVING AN MDM PICK UP (PLATE MDM RWA 928 (938) ON THE WAY BACK TO HIS LOCATION FROM A FUNCTION AT ETHIOBATT HQ ON THE OCCASION OF OUR NATIONAL DAY WAS STOPPED BY 5 CIVIL DRESSED ARMED PEOPLE AT A NEW CHECK POINT WHICH HAS NOT EXISTED BEFORE AT 2130 HRS YESTERDAY AFTER PASSING THE CHECKPOINT AT KAMEMBE WITH OUT PROBLEM.

2. THESE BANDITS FIRST SEARCHED THE AND LATER FORCED HIM TO LEAVE THE VEHICLE. WHEN THE LEADER OF THE BANDITS STARTED DRIVING THE VEHICLE BEING ESCORTED BY ONE OF HIS MEN, THE VICTIM FELT THAT HIS LIFE IS IN DANGER AND RUN AWAY TO THE NEAREST BUSH AND HID HIMSELF FOR 1 HOUR IN THE RIVER AROUND.

3. THE BANDITS LOOKED FOR HIM AROUND AND LEFT WHEN MISSING HIM.

4. HE CAME TO OUR HQ AND REPORTED THE INCIDENT. HE TOLD US THAT THEY DROVE THE TOWARDS THE DIRECTION WHICH WAS DIFFICULT FOR HIM TO KNOW.

5. AFTER RECEIVING THIS REPORT, WE FORMED A TEAM FROM OUR TROOP, MILIB & RPA TO ASSES THE SITUATION WITH THE VICTIM AT THE PLACE OF INCIDENT.

AFTERWARDS A CHECK POINT WAS SET UP TO SEARCH THE VEHICLE AT THE MAINROAD TO KIGALI AND BURUNDI BORDER.

6. 2 VEHICLES WERE NOT STOPPED AT THE CHECK POINT TOWARDS KIGALI, SO THIS VEHICLE WAS NOT ALSO STOPPED AT CHECK POINTS. THEREFORE, THE TEAM HAS A COMMENT THAT RPA MIGHT HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN THE INCIDENT.

7. WE ARE ALSO SEARCHING THE VEHICLE TO SEARCH THE VEH. IN THE OTHER SECTORS, THE VEH. IS A DOUBLE CABIN TOYOTA PICKUP (WHITE COLOR) WHICH 1 VHF & 1 HF ANTENNAS MOUNTED ON IT.


