Subject:-Relief of Indian Armoured Car Troop at MANONO

Reference - HQ Sector B signal O 2113 of 1 Dec (attached).

1 Decision of the Force Commander is required as to whether this troop now at MANONO should be brought to AVILLE with a view to being airlifted to EVILLE. The following factors may please be borne in mind:-

- (a) Even if it is decided to pull out this Troop from MANONO the Troop along with its armoured cars will not be able to reach AVILLE by 6 Dec because armoured cars will have to move partly by road, partly by barge and then by train from KABALO to AVILLE; The present American airlift is due to be completed by 7 Dec and hence USAF planes cannot be utilised in this trip.
- (b) There is a requirement to have atleast 4 armoured cars at MANONO and hence if it is decided to pull out the Indian Armoured Car Troop from MANONO, 4 UNIMOGS from AVILLE will have to be sent there immediately. This will not be a wise step because the UNIMOG Sqn is doing intensive training now and at present is not in a fit state to be parcelled out into two separate parts. Besides, we have not received any ammunition yet.
- (c) I discussed this problem with the Chief of Staff yesterday and we suggest the following steps be considered for adoption:-
 - (i) The Irish Ferret Sqn be airlifted from LEO to EVILLE to make up for the loss of C Sqn 2 Recce (Malay). With the induction of the Irish Ferret Sqn into EVILLE we shall have the following recce element available there:-

Irish Ferret Sqn

Indian Armoured Car Sqn less one troop.

These two units should be sufficient for any future operation.
