1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

b. BORDERS.

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD. ON 27 JUNE 95, 232 REFUGEES CROSSED FROM BURUNDI. 197 OF THEM WERE TAKEN INTO BIRENGA CAMP WHICH WAS TEMPORARY OPENED AND 35 LEFT FOR THEIR HOMES.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS. NORMAL BORDER TRAFFIC BETWEEN UGANDAN / RWANDESE BORDER AT CYANIKA BORDER POST. TRAFFIC WAS STILL CLOSED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID TO GOMA CAMPS.

(5) BOTH BORDER POSTS AT SECTOR 4B (KANYARU - HAUTE AND

KANYARU - BAS) WERE OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) IN SECTOR 3A THE KIBUYE PREFECT HELD THE MEETING WITH NGOS AND MILOBS REGARDING THE VEHICLE ROBBERIES. HE STATED THAT THIEVES OF SWISS DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAM VEHICLE WERE ARRESTED ONE WEEK AGO.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) IN SECTOR 4B TWO TOYOTA L/CRUISERS WERE MET BY MILOBS HEADING TO KANYARU BAS BORDER POST PRESUMABLY WITH HIGH RANKING RPA OFFERS.

(b) SECTOR 6 REPORTED THAT THE RPA SOLDIERS TRAINING WAS STILL GOING AT THE KIGALI STADIUM.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO THE AOR. THEY REPORTED

UN RESTRICTED

THAT DURING THE NIGHT 20/21 JUNE 95, FIVE ARMED BANDITS ATTACKED AND WOUNDED MR NSENGIYUMUA, A FARMER AT NKANA GR 1345. THEY TOOK 12000 FRW AND SOME PERSONAL BELONGINGS. IT WAS BELIEVED THE BANDITS HAVE COME IN ACROSS UGANDAN BORDER.

THERE WERE 399 RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE, TANZANIA AND BURUNDI IN KIBALI COMMUNE GR 0424 AS WELL AS 8 IDPS FROM GIKONGORO.

THE QUESTIONING OF THE LOCALS IN VISITED COMMUNES REVEALED THAT MANY OF THEM WANTED THE UNAMIR STAY FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS MORE TO ENABLE THE COUNTRY STABILIZE. THEY CLAIM IT WOULD BE CHAOS IF UNAMIR WITHDRAW IN DECEMBER.

(3) THE DFC/CMO VISITED SECTOR ON 28 JUNE 95.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO.

(1) SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED IN THE AOR AND REPORTED THAT IN RWINKWAVU THE MILOBS WERE INFORMED THAT "MEDICINE CATASTROPHE" LEFT ON 27 JUNE 95 FOR KIGALI WITHOUT ISSUING DRUGS TO THE PARA-MEDICAL STAFF WORKING AT THE HOSPITAL. UNCONFIRMED REPORTS INDICATE THAT RWANDAN GOVERNMENT HAD LOST CONFIDENCE IN THE NGO AND HAD ASKED THEM TO LEAVE THE AREA. THE ISSUE WAS REPORTED TO UNHCR FOR INVESTIGATION

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA/KIBUYE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN THE AOR. MILOB TEAM WENT

UNCONFIRMED REPORTS INDICATE THAT RWANDAN GOVERNMENT HAD LOST CONFIDENCE IN THE NGO AND HAD ASKED THEM TO LEAVE THE AREA. THE ISSUE WAS REPORTED TO UNHCR FOR INVESTIGATION

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA/KIBUYE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN THE AOR. MILOB TEAM WENT

UN RESTRICTED

TO NYARUTUDURA SECTOR GR 3289 TO VERIFY RUMORS THAT FRGF ELEMENTS HAD INFILTRATED THE SECTOR. THE TEAM MET THE COUNSELLOR WHO TOLD THAT HE HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH RUMORS. THE RUMORS WERE DENIED BY SEVERAL LOCALS TOO. IN KABULIRO PRIMARY SCHOOL GR 1650 THE MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT THE PUPILS WERE STARVING BECAUSE WFP WAS GIVING FOOD TO ADJACENT COMMUNE AND LEAVING THEM SAYING THAT THEY WERE IN CYANGUGU PREFECTURE. THERE WERE ALSO PROBLEM WITH POTABLE WATER.

AT RUGABANO GR 4367 AND MUGUDA GR 4468 THE RETURNEES HAD NO FOOD, AGRICULTURAL TOOLS AND WATER.

(3) THE FC VISITED GITARAMA AND WAS BRIEFED ABOUT THE SITUATION.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN THE AOR AND REPORTED THAT IN NYAMAGABE COMMUNE GR 5427 THE POPULATION FACED THE SHORTAGE OF WATER AND FOOD AND RE-REGISTRATION HAVE STARTED IN THE COMMUNE.

f. SECTOR 4B - BUTARE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED VARIOUS COMMUNES AND REPORTED IN RUNYINYA COMMUNE GR 6012 THE BURGOMASTER REQUESTED MILOBS FOR TRANSPORT TO PICK AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS UP FROM KIGALI GIVEN BY GOVERNMENT TO THE COMMUNE. IN NDORA COMMUNE GR 8112 THE BURGOMASTER INVITED MILOBS TO ATTEND THE REBURIAL CEREMONY DUE ON 08 JULY 95. HE ALSO INFORMED AS FOLLOWS: POPULATION BEFORE WAR WAS 33000, CURRENT

POPULATION 20000, RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI 635, REGISTERED ORPHANS 400, PRISONERS 34, FUNCTIONAL PRIMARY SCHOOLS 06, REGISTERED PUPILS 2300, NUMBER OF TEACHERS 37. NGOS WORKING IN AREA - UNHCR, ICRC, FEED THE CHILDREN, UNICEF AND OXFAM.

(3) AT KIGEMBE GR 7093 MANY BURUNDIANS WERE OBSERVED AT THE MARKET SELLING FOOD. FOUR UNHCR TRUCKS BROUGHT IN 226 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI'S NGOZI CAMP ON 27 JUNE 95. 218 OF THEM WENT TO BUTARE. 43 OTHER RETURNEES WERE REPORTED TO CROSS ON FOOT AT KANYARU BAS' BORDER POST. THE BURGOMASTER INFORMED: NUMBER OF SECTORS IN THE COMMUNE 12, POPULATION BEFORE WAR 54000, PRESENT POPULATION 17500, PRISONERS 55, REGISTERED RETURNEES 5216, REGISTERED EX-IDPS 3794, REGISTERED ORPHANS 504, PRIMARY SCHOOLS FUNCTIONAL 07, PUPILS 1500, TEACHERS 43 (ONLY FOUR QUALIFIED). NGOS ACTING IN THE AREA - UNICEF, UNHCR AND MSF.

(4) RPA SOLDIERS WERE STILL DEPLOYED AT BUTARE WAY STATION FOR IDENTIFICATION OF GENOCIDE SUSPECTS. UNHCR REPORTED 204 RETURNEES ON 27 JUNE 95 OUT OF WHICH 34 FROM ZAIRE, 113 FROM BURUNDI AND REMAINING WERE EX-IDPS.

(5) THE DCMO ARRIVED TO THE SECTOR ON 28 JUNE 95 AND VISITED THE PREFECT OF BUTARE.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM. HOWEVER THREE UNIDENTIFIED AIRCRAFT WERE SPOTTED ON 28 JUNE 95. AT 0925 HRS AN AIRCRAFT WAS SEEN GOING IN THE GENERAL DIRECTION WEST-EAST ABOVE NYAMASHEKE GR 9840. THE TYPE OF AIRCRAFT NOR THE NUMBER OF ENGINES COULD BE IDENTIFIED. THE ALTITUDE WAS APPROX 3500 FT. AT 1455, ANOTHER AIRCRAFT WAS SEEN FLYING DIRECTION WEST-EAST BEFORE

MAKING A TURN TOWARDS THE NORTH. THE ALTITUDE WAS APPROX 3500 FT. AT 1615 HRS, A THIRD AIRCRAFT WAS SEEN IN KAMEMBE GR 792252 FLYING IN DIRECTION NORTH-SOUTH AT APPROX 3500 FT. IT WAS BELIEVED THE AIRCRAFT WAS A BN-2 ISLANDER (TWIN ENGINES).

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED OVER THE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY INCLUDING THE BORDER POSTS.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED THE KIBILIRA COMMUNE AND OBSERVED THAT A NUMBER OF PERSONS HAD BEEN ARRESTED IN THE PAST DAYS. IN NGANZO GR 5988 IT WAS REPORTED THAT FIVE PEOPLE HAD BEEN KILLED ON 04 JUNE 95 ALLEGEDLY BY RPA SOLDIERS CARRYING WEAPON BUT USING MACHETES TO KILL THE PERSONS. IN SHAKA GR 5890 FIVE PERSONS WERE REPORTED TO BE ARRESTED. IN GASEKE COMMUNE THE FREQUENT CATTLE THEFTS BY THE RPA WERE REPORTED. IN GICIYE GR 8411 ONE PERSON WAS ARRESTED AND ACCUSED TO BE INTERAHAMWE. FOUR OTHER PERSONS WERE ALLEGEDLY ROBBED BY RPA. THERE WERE ALSO REPORTS OF CATTLE THEFTS AND RPA EXTORTION BY RPA.

(3) ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED KORA GR 3822, KABATWE GR 3327, BUTAKA GR 3329 AND REPORTED FREQUENT RPA PATROLS DURING THE DAY AND INTENSIFIED RPA PTLs DURING THE NIGHT.

j. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND SUBURBS WAS REPORTED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE VARIOUS SECTORS OF THE AOR.

* k. AIR OPS.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIA WAS NORMAL DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) A TOTAL OF 18 FLIGHTS WERE OPERATED TODAY. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

(1) IN SECTOR 1 IN MUVUMBA COMMUNE GR 2547 THE CLINIC BEING RECONSTRUCTED BY ARC AT TABAGWE. IN KIBALI COMMUNE GR 0424 WORLD VISION AND PAM SPONSOR THE URUMULI ORPHANAGE WHICH HAS 126 CHILDREN. WORLD VISION PAYS THE SALARIES OF THE STAFF AND PROVIDES MEDICINE FOR CLINIC ATTACHED TO THE ORPHANAGE. PAM SUPPLIES FOOD. IN KIYOMBE COMMUNE GR 0940 CARITAS HAS SUPPLIED 460 CORRUGATED ROOFING SHEETS FOR THE RENOVATION OF TWO SCHOOLS AT KIYOMBE GR 0946 AND NGABIRA GR 1041. GOAL RUNS THE HEALTH CENTRE AT RUSHAKI GR 1138. THE CHEST DEPARTMENT ADMITTED 18 PATIENTS. THE FOUR SCHOOLS AT KIYOMBE GR 0946, KIRAHURA GR 0738, NGABIRA GR 1041 AND KABARE GR 15439 HAVE BEEN SUPPLIED WITH SCHOOL UNIFORMS AND BOOKS BY CARITAS.

(2) IN SECTOR 2 PAM DISTRIBUTED MAIZE, BEANS AND OIL IN RWINKWAVU AREA. AFRICAN COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE SUPPORT TEAM DONATED WHEEL BARROWS, HOSES, INSECTICIDES AND SPRAYING MACHINES TO GROUPS OF 5 - 50 PERSONS AS FOLLOWS: BIRENGA - 45 GROUPS, KIGERAMA - 35 GPS, SAKE - 22 GPS, KABARONDO - 30 GPS.

(3) IN SECTOR 3 A KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN TEAM AND NGOS ATTENDED A MEETING WITH PERFECT AND DISCUSSED RETURNEES WHO WERE STRANDED AT RUSIRO COMMUNE GR 3183. THIS REFUGEES WILL BE RESETTLED IN BWIZA SECTOR GR 3694.

(4) IN SECTOR 4C THE FOLLOWING NUMBERS WERE THE RETURNEES IN THE NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMPS: 25 JUNE 95 - 10 ARRIVED, 56 DEPARTED, 26 JUNE 95 - 13 ARRIVED, 69 DEPARTED, 27 JUNE 95 - 56 DEPARTED. 64 RETURNEES WERE CURRENTLY IN BUGARAMA AWAITING TRANSPORT TO THE NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP. 34 RETURNEES ARRIVED FROM BURUNDI AND 30 FROM ZAIRE DURING 26-28 JUNE 95.

(2) SECTOR 4C REQUESTS A FIELD SERVICE COMMUNICATIONS TECHNICIAN TO INSPECT THE RADIO AND PRESENT SET UP BECAUSE THE MOTOROLA BASE STATION IS UNSTABLE AND OPERATES WITH INTERMITTENCE.

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(a) SECTOR 5 MILOB REPORTED THAT TUN COY UN NUMBVA REPORTED AUTO WPN FIRING YESTERDAY AT 261930 AT NEMBA TRG CENTRE GR 765164. MILOB TEAM WENT TO THE SPOT BUT COULD NOT LOCATE THE GUN POSITION AS WELL COULD NOT FOUND OUT THE REASON FOR FIRING. HOWEVER THEY HAVE CONFIRMED THE FIRING.

(b) SECTOR 4B MILOB REPORTED THAT THE PRESENCE OF LARGE NUMBER OF RPA AT BUTARE UNIVERSITY IS DUE TO A GOOD NUMBER OF RPA OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS ARE STUDYING THERE AND REQUIRE SECURITY.

(2) FRGF.

a. SECTOR 3 MILOB REPORTED THAT SOME FRGF ELEMENTS HAVE INFILTRATED IN KAYOVE SQ 2792 AND TWO WERE CAPTURED YESTERDAY AT AROUND 261730 JUN 95. TEAM ALSO STATED THAT IT IS A RUMORED.

(3) OTHERS.

a. MILOBS FROM SECTOR 4C REPORTED THAT AT 0825 HRS, A TWIN ENGINE AC FLYING AT APPROX 5000 FT WAS SPOTTED GOING IN DIRECTION NORTH WEST I. E. FROM THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF KIBUYE TOWARDS GAFUNZO

PENINSULA SQ 9139. AT AROUND 1320 HRS, ANOTHER AC WAS SEEN AT THE TIP OF ISHARA PENINSULA SQ 0143 GOING IN THE DIRECTION WEST TO EAST. AT 1405 HRS, A THIRD AC WAS SEEN EAST OF RWESERO SQ 9938 FLYING IN DIRECTION NORTH - SOUTH. IN ALL THE CASES THE TYPE OF THE AIR CRAFT COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED.

(1) SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

(2) ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED AT KIBUNGO - KAYONZA SQ 5784 - RWAMAGANA SQ 4881 - MUHAZI SQ 4590 AND GATI. MR NYABUTSITSI AGED 26 YEARS WHO SOUGHT REFUGEE AT GHANBATT LOCATION AT GASHILI WAS TODAY HANDED OVER TO THE MUHAZI

UN RESTRICTED

COMMUNE AUTHORITIES. REPRESENTATIVE FROM ICRC AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WERE PRESENT ON THE HANDING OVER CEREMONY.

(3) MILOB ALSO CARRIED OUT PATROL IN VARIOUS PLACES WITHIN THE SECTOR AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA/KIBUYE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROL AT KIGOMA COMMUNE SQ 7750 - NGWA SQ 7248 AND GAHOMBO SQ 7949 SECTOR. THERE ARE 1641 ORPHANS AND 1550 WIDOWS LIVING IN THE COMMUNE. 



(b) IN SECTOR 3 RPA SOLDIERS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE INTENSIFIED SECURITY ALONG THE SHORES IN AREA GR OF RWARAMBA GR 2063.

(2) FRGF.

(a) AN UNCONFIRMED REPORT FROM AN INTERPRETER ATTACHED TO THE ETHIOBATT PLATOON AT GAHINGA GR 760215 STATES THAT SOME FRGF MEMBERS HAVE BEEN VISITING CERTAIN LOCALS AT MURURU SECTOR GR 7521. THESE VISITORS HAVE TOLD LOCALS TO RUN TO THE ETHIOBATT PLATOON POSITION SHOULD THERE BE AN ATTACK BY THE FRGF COMING FROM ZAIRE. THE OPERATION OFFICER REMINDS THAT AN "AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL" REPORT DATED 13 JUNE 95, CITES COL THEONESTE BAGASORA, FORMER LEADER OF "INTERAHAMWE", THAT A "DESTABILISATION INSURGENCY CAMPAIGN AND A SMALL SCALE INCURSION INTO RWANDA WAS BEING PLANNED FOR MID-JULY". 19 JULY 95 WILL BE THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE RPF VICTORY.

(3) OTHER.

a. IN SECTOR 4C AT CYETE GR 7618 IT WAS REPORTED THAT A 36 YEAR OLD LOCAL NAMED EVARISTE NYANDWI WAS SHOT TWICE IN THE ARM ON THE NIGHT OF 22/23 JUNE 95 WHEN ARMED BANDITS ROBBED HIM OF THREE COWS AND THREE SHEEP AND TWO GUNS (CALIBER AND TYPE UNKNOWN). THE VICTIM HAD LEFT FOR THE HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT WHEN THE MILOB TEAM VISITED HIM ON 24 JUNE 95 AT APPROX 1200 HRS. MORE DETAILS WILL FOLLOW IN THE NEXT SITREP.

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN THE AOR INCLUDING THE BORDERS. PRISONERS WERE FOUND IN RUTARE COMMUNE.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO.

(1) SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE AOR AND REPORTED THAT AT GAHINI GR 5397 ORPHANAGE, SECONDARY SCHOOL AND HOSPITAL HAD THE SHORTAGE OF WATER DUE TO INCREASING NUMBER OF ORPHANS. THE NGOS - WATER SUPPLIERS REQUESTED FOR FUEL CONTRIBUTION FROM OTHER AGENCIES TO MEET THE DEMAND. THE HOSPITAL ALSO REQUESTED FOR A TRUCK ONCE A WEEK TO TRANSPORT FOOD FROM KIBUNGO TO GAHINI.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA/KIBUYE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) A JOINT MILOBS/HUMAN RIGHTS/CIVPOL TEAM CONDUCTED PATROLS TO RUGALIKA SECTOR GR 9574 OF RUNDA COMMUNE GR 9882 AND REPORTED THAT THE ORPHANS WERE ALSO CONCENTRATED IN THE FOLLOWING CELLULES: NYARUBUYE GR 9572, RUHOGO GR 9475, MUSAVE GR 9472, RUTOVU GR 9374, KABARAMA GR 9671, REMERA GR 9772 AND NZANGWA GR 9674. ACCORDING TO THIS INFORMATION THE TOTAL OF THE ORPHANS WAS 4640 AND WERE IN AN URGENT NEED OF HUMANITARIAN AID OF ANY KIND.

(3) MILOB TEAM VISITED KIGOMA COMMUNE GR 7649 AND MUKINCO GR 7346 AND REPORTED THAT ABOUT 120 FAMILIES WERE IN ARDENT FOOD RELIEF. TEAM REPORTED THAT 120 WIDOWS WERE LIVING IN THAT AREA. TEAM FOUND OUT THAT SOME PEOPLE (FORMER IDPS) WERE ARRESTED IN THAT AREA.

(4) MILOBS WENT TO MUSHUBATI COMMUNE GR 6970, MWAKA GR 6569, GATIKABISI GR 6672 AND GIKOMERO GR 6472. THEY REPORTED THAT IN ALL THAT AREAS THE MILITIA ARRESTED SOME THIEVES.

(5) ONE TEAM CONDUCTED THE HELI PATROL TO MWENDO GR 4558, SYEMBE GR 5458 AND CYANANZA GR 5465. MILOBS WERE TOLD THAT RETURNEES WERE FACING THE PROBLEM OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS. THE ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE WITH WFP TO RESUPPLY.

(6) TEAM PATROLLED NABINGA GR 1451, RWAMATAMU GR 1557 AND FOUND OUT THAT 05 LOCALS WERE ARRESTED LAST WEEK NAMELY: UWIMANA, NTAKARIMARA, JERIME, RWAMIHIGO AND BUCYANA FOR ALLEGEDLY HAVING PARTICIPATED IN GENOCIDE.

THE RPA SOLDIERS ESTABLISHED THE PRISON IN THE AREA OF KIGARAMA GR 1757. THE HOSPITAL STAFF AT KARENGERA REQUESTED UNAMIR FOR TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE TO BRING DRUGS FROM KIBUYE.

(7) MILOBS PATROLLED RUTSIRO COMMUNE GR 3183 AND REPORTED THAT THERE WERE 700 REFUGEES WHO CAME FROM GISENYI TWO WEEKS AGO AND WERE IN NEED OF FOOD, WATER AND ACCOMMODATION. THE BURGOMASTER OF RUTSIRO REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT TO CARRY THIS REFUGEES O BWIZA GR 3694 WHERE THEY WERE TO BE SETTLED.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO VARIOUS AREA OF THE AOR AND REPORTED THAT RPA HAS A PLATOON COLLOCATED WITH ZAMBATT PLATOON AT RUKONDO. THE PLATOON CDR WAS S/SGT JOHN RWEMA.

f. SECTOR 4B - BUTARE.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED AREAS IN THE AOR AND REPORTED AT NTYAZO GR 8631 ORPHANAGE SISTER BRIDGET INFORMED ABOUT THE NIGHT FIRING OF SMALL ARMS BY UNKNOWN PEOPLE. AT GISHAMVU GR 6505 LOCAL RPA CDR INFORMED THAT EX-IDPS WERE SETTLING DOWN WELL 138 PERSONS WERE BEING HELD IN AT THE COMMUNE PRISON.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM.

(3) MILOB TEAM PATROLLED A KILLING INCIDENT AT MUBONA GR 2721 ON 23 JUNE 95. THE HUMAN RIGHTS, CIVPOL AND RPA LO WERE INFORMED FOR INVESTIGATION.

a. IN SECTOR 5 THE HUMAN RIGHTS KEPT THE SEMINAR IN GISENYI. UNHCR WAS TRYING TO REACH THE COMMUNES WHICH WERE DIFFICULT TO REACH. UP TO NOW ONLY 5 OUT OF 12 COMMUNES WERE SUPPLIED BY UNHCR IN GISENYI PREFECTURE.

b. IN SECTOR 4B THE MBAZI PAM (NGO) WAS FOUND DISTRIBUTING FOOD TO FAMILIES OF SCHOOL TEACHERS AS THEY DID NOT GET ANY PAYMENTS.

c. IN SECTOR 1 ICRC WILL CEASE TO SUPPLY DRUGS TO THE RUTARE HEALTH CENTRE BY THE END OF JUNE 95. IT WAS ALLEGED THAT THE GOVERNMENT WOULD TAKE OVER THE MANAGEMENT. GAOL IRELAND NGO WAS FOUND OPERATING IN MUKARANGE COMMUNE GIVING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AND SUPPLYING FOOD TO THE LOCALS.

d. THE KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN TEAM VISITED MUGONERO ORPHANAGE AND NGOMA HOSPITAL GR 2195 AND REPORTED THAT THERE WERE NO POTABLE WATER DUE TO THE BROKAGE OF PIPING SYSTEM.

e. IN SECTOR 4C MILOB TEAM WENT TO SAINT-FRANCOIS DISPENSARY GR 770247, NEAR RUSIZI I. THERE WERE 50 BEDS AND 54 PATIENTS, THE MOST CASES WERE MALARIA WHICH WAS SAID BEING ON AN EPIDEMIC LEVEL.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS.

a. IN SECTOR 4C DUE TO INCREASING BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN THE CYIMBOGO COMMUNE GR 7820, THE LOCALS MADE A REQUEST TO THE RPA THROUGH THE BURGOMASTER TO HAVE SOME LOCALS ACCOMPANY AND ASSIST THE RPA SOLDIERS DURING THE FOOT NIGHT PATROLS. AGREEMENT HAS BEEN REACHED TO ASSIGN TO EACH RPA PATROL TWO

UN RESTRICTED

LOCALS FROM EACH COMMUNE CELL. THIS WAS TO BEGIN ON 19 JUNE 95 BUT ACCORDING TO THE COUNSELLOR AT MURURU SECTOR THE SYSTEM WAS NOT YET IMPLEMENTED. THE LOCALS HAVE SUSPECTED THE RPA OF BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR PART OF THE BANDITRY IN THE CYIMBOGO COMMUNE.

ON 18 JUNE 95 DURING THE MEETING WITH LOCALS AT MURURU SECTOR AN UNARMED RPA CAPTAIN WAS ALLEGED TO HAVE TOLD LOCALS TO DESIST FROM GIVING OUT ANY INFORMATION TO UNAMIR PERSONNEL ABOUT COMMUNAL INCIDENTS. THIS BEHAVIOR APPEARED TO BE A REACTION TO LOCALS WHO REPORTED A MOTORCYCLE STOLEN FROM A LOCAL, TO CYANGUGU SUB SECTOR MILOBS (SITREP NO. 011 OF 10-11 JUNE 95, PARA 4B) AT BURONGA GR 760220. (COMMENTS WERE INCLUDED IN SECTOR 4C SITREP 23-24 JUNE 95)

IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR THE "GERMAN EMERGENCY DOCTORS" CONSIDERABLY REDUCED THEIR EFFECTIVE STRENGTH AT THE NYAMASHEKE HOSPITAL. THESE MEASURES WERE MADE ACCORDING TO A CLOSURE OF THE GED MISSION TO RWANDA PLANNED FOR EARLY AUGUST 95.

6. LOGISTICS.

a. IN SECTOR 4C IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR THE BASE STATION WAS UNSTABLE AND OPERATED WITH INTERMITTENCE. SECTOR WAS REQUESTING A TECHNICIAN FROM FORCE HQ TO INSPECT THE RADIO AND PRESENT SET UP. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO BRING THE RADIO TO KIGALI AS IT WOULD DEPRIVE THE SUB SECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS.

7. MISC.

a. SECTOR 5 APPLIED THE REQUEST FOR THE WEEKLY UPDATE OF THE SITUATION IN ZAIRE FROM UNAMIR INFO CELL TO CALM DOWN THE PSYCHOLOGICAL TENSION.

b. IN SECTOR 1 THE SECTOR COMMANDER WAS VISITED BY MRS. MUKAYIREGE JULIANA, DIRECTRICE DE L'ECOLE SOCIALE DE BYUMBA

AND MR. MAMENERO DENIS WHO INFORMED HIM ABOUT THEIR INTENTION TO REOPEN THE SCHOOL ON 03 JULY 95.

THE SAME NGO IS CONSTRUCTING A SIX CLASWROOM BLOCK AT BISIKA SQ 1126 AT THE COST OF 5,42,000 RFR. THE B/ MASYTER REQUESTED MILOB TO ASSIST WITH BUILDING MATERIALS.

(e) SECTOR 2 MILOB REPORTED THAT UNAMIR ENGINEERS CLEARED AN AREA AT BIRENGA FOR UNHCR TO CONSTRUCT A TRANSIT CAMP TO REPLACE ASPEK TRANSIT CAMP NOW USED AS A SECONDARY SCHOOL.



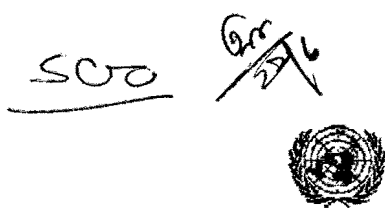

(3) MILOBS REPORTED THAT IN GITINDA SECTOR GR 5959 THE LOCALS STILL SUFFER FROM ARMED BANDITRY. IT IS BELIEVED THAT BANDITS COME FROM KIBUYE PREFECTURE AND USING NYABARONGO RIVER AS THEIR HIDEOUT DURING THE DAY. THE DISPENSARY IN MUYUNZWE IS IN NEED OF BEDS AND APPEALING TO UNAMIR TO PROVIDE ABOUT 20 BEDS. THERE IS ALSO A PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL WHICH HAS 132 STUDENTS HOUSED IN 8 CLASSES. THE DIRECTOR OF THAT SCHOOL INFORMED THEY LACK OF SPORTING, TEACHING AIDS AND ELECTRICITY AND HE WAS SEEKING UNAMIR ASSISTANCE IN THIS. HE ALSO MENTIONED THERE WERE 38 ORPHANS STUDENTS WHOM THE GOVERNMENT PROMISED TO MEET THEIR SCHOOLING EXPENSES BUT UP TO NOW THERE WAS NOTHING DONE.

(3) A JOINT HUMAN RIGHTS/MILOB TEAM WENT TO RUHANGO COMMUNE GR 7653 AND REPORTED THAT MR. ELIAS MBARUBUKEYE,

UN RESTRICTED

58 YEARS OLD, WAS ARRESTED AND SENT TO GITARAMA PRISON. IT IS BELIEVED THAT HIS SON WHO IS STUDYING IN USA ADDRESSED A PRESS CONFERENCE IN USA AND MADE SOME STATEMENTS THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA IS VIOLATING THE HUMAN RIGHTS. THEN THE TEAM WENT TO MUKINDO CELLULE GR 8551 AND NYARURAMA SECTOR GR 8751 AND REPORTED THAT THE SCHOOL IN THE AREA WAS IN NEED OF TEACHING MATERIALS AND UNICEF HAS PROMISED IT BUT UNTIL NOW UNICEF HAS NOT SHOWN UP.

(4) THE SUB SECTOR CDR HELD A MEETING WITH PREFECT, RPA BN CDR, SECURITY OFFICER AND THE HEAD OF LOCAL GENDARMERIE REGARDING THE STOLEN VEHICLE. THE FOLLOWING MEASURES WERE INSTITUTED:

- a. RPA PATROLS IN THE CITY OF KIBUYE WILL BE INCREASED AND REINFORCED.
- b. RPA CHECK POSTS IN THE PREFECTURE WILL BE INCREASED AND REINFORCED.
- c. ALL NGOS AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL WILL LIMIT THEIR MOVEMENTS PAST MIDNIGHT TO ONLY THOSE FOR REASONS OF DUTY.
- d. AS SOON AS THE INCIDENT OCCURS THE SECURITY OFFICER IS TO BE CONTACTED SOONEST.
- e. A SECURITY MEETING PRESIDED BY THE PREFECT WILL TAKE PLACE ONCE A MONTH.

(5) IN RUKOKU SECTOR GR 4772 MILOBS LEARNT THAT FOUR TEACHERS WHO WERE ARRESTED SIX WEEKS AGO WERE STILL UNDER CUSTODY. IN MBOGO SECTOR GR 1555 THE LOCALS COMPLAINED OF HARASSMENT BY RPA SOLDIERS. THEY CLAIMED THAT TUTSIES WERE COLLABORATING WITH RPA SOLDIERS IN STEALING LIVESTOCK FROM THE HUTUS. THEY ALSO INFORMED MILOBS THAT BANDITS FROM ZAIRE LOOTED UNDISCLOSED AMOUNT OF MONEY AND RADIO SETS FROM LOCALS LAST WEEK.

RPA LAUNCHED AN ATTACK WHICH KILLED ALL SIX PERSONS RESIDING IN THAT HOUSE. IN ADDITION THE LOCALS REPORTED THAT INFILTRATORS HAVE BEEN CROSSING WITH REGULARITY AND STEALING LIVESTOCK. THE CELLULE HAS REQUESTED THE RPA TO ESTABLISH A POST IN THAT AREA.

(3) RUHENGARI MSF AND PREFECTURE HAVE AN URGENT NEED FOR THE SERVICES OF THE SEPTIC VEHICLE. SECTOR 5 HQ REQUESTS FOR THIS VEHICLE TO COME TO RUHENGARI AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY. THE CONTACT FOR THIS TASK IS C/S CYH ON CH10.

(b) SECTOR 3 PATROLS WERE INFORMED THAT RPA SOLDIERS ARREST LOCALS AND ASKED FOR BRIBES TO RELEASE THEM. THIS EXTORTION WAS CONFIRMED BY ONE MARTIN BIZIMANDA OF KIGESE SECTEUR (9880), WHO WAS ARRESTED ON 21 MAY 95. HE WAS BEATEN SEVERELY AND ASKED TO PAY 2,000 FRW BEFORE HE COULD BE RELEASED. HE IS STILL AT THE COMMUNE HOSPITAL SUFFERING FROM HIS WOUNDS.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE CHIEF OF HAC TODAY PAID A WORKING VISIT TO THE SECTOR.

(2) A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO GIHARA SECTEUR (9585) ON A FOLLOW-UP TO THE CASE IN WHICH MRS NYABUSHISHI WAS SEVERELY BEATEN AND RAPED IN THE RUNDA CACHOT (9882). THE TEAM COULD NOT LOCATE THE VICTIM AS SHE WAS TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI FOR FURTHER TREATMENT.

(3) MILOBS FROM KIBUYE CONDUCTED PATROLS TO GISHALI (4462) IN THE NWENDO COMMUNE AND GISOVU SECTEUR (2952). AT GISOVU COMMUNE, 25 PRISONERS ARE IN THE PRISON AND SOME UNKNOWN NUMBER OF LOCALS ARE HELD AT THE RPA GARRISON FOR UNKNOWN REASONS.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO AKABUGA (4988) AND REMERA (4289) BORDER POSTS AS PART OF OPERATION RUBY. SURROUNDING AREAS WERE ALSO VISITED. OTHER PATROLS WENT TO MURAMBI (3538) AND NYARWUNGO (3540) SECTEURS IN MUSEBEYA (4038) COMMUNE. THEY REPORTED THAT CARE INTERNATIONAL DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO WIDOWS AND ORPHANS ONLY.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED HUYE (6815), MUGANZA (8407), GISHAMVU (6505) AND NYAKIZU (5696) COMMUNES. SITUATION WAS CALM. TWENTY REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI CARRIED OUT THE HOME VISITING PROGRAMME TO NYARUHENGARI YESTERDAY AND RETURNED TO BURUNDI TODAY THROUGH EFFORTS OF UNHCR.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU.

(1) THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM. SEVERAL OVERFLIGHTS WERE REPORTED IN THE NYAMESHEKE SUB-SECTOR. IN ALL CASES, THE AIRCRAFT COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED EVEN WITH THE HELP OF BINOCULARS AS THEY WERE FLYING HIGH. THIS HAPPENED BETWEEN 1000 AND 1700 HRS. AT 1000 HRS, A SMALL TWIN ENGINE AIRCRAFT ORBITED THE NYAMESHEKE SECTEUR

(9841) AND KIRAMBO COMMUNE (0444) ON TWO OCCASIONS. THIRTY MINUTES LATER, TWO SMALL AIRCRAFT (POSSIBLY RECCE AIRCRAFT), WERE SPOTTED. ONE FLEW NORTH TO SOUTH AND THE OTHER SOUTH TO NORTH. THEY CROSSED EACH OTHER ON A PARALLEL COURSE. AT 1530 HRS AND 1700 HRS, ANOTHER SMALL AIRCRAFT WHICH APPEARED TO BE A " CESSNA " ORBITED THE SAME AREA AGAIN. RPA LOCAL COMMANDER WENT TO MILOBS AT KIRAMBO TO ASK IF THE AIRCRAFT BELONGED TO THE UN. RPA DID NOT ENGAGE ANY OF THE AIR CRAFTS.


