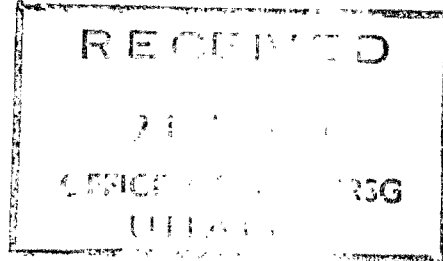





1. It has been observed that most returns from the sectors on the situation of the returnees are vague. For example, it is not enough to state that "returnees are facing housing problems". This is stating the obvious.

2. Rather, point like "at Commune xyz, 30 families of 65 people are still waiting to be accommodated etc" would suffice. This, no doubt paints a precise but adequate picture of the situation rather than generalising. The advantages of precision need not be over-emphasized.

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

C I have written this letter to you begging assistance of 34 Iron sheets. I came from Uganda where I was born. my parents went there in ~~195~~ 1959. In 1979 my father died during Idi Amin Dada's war. From that time we faced a lot of problems with our mother say getting school fees, clothing, shelter and food in order to survive though we had no relative. I was born with two sisters and five brothers.

When we reached in Rwanda as our mother country, we were ~~given~~ sent a house of a certain refugee who is in Zaire now and we are expecting him to come any day.

C I decided to stop schooling and work for the time being so that mammy, brothers and sisters can survive. So now I have managed to buy a land of three acres where I can build a house and plant crops. So now I want to go back to Uganda for further studies but please beg your help in order to make that house before going back to Uganda.

If that refugee comes back as a must we have to hand him his land and house but when I think of that I feel something wrong on my head.

Please have mercy when passing through this letter. Hope to get a nice reply from you.

SUBMISSION OF FIGURES FOR BLANKETS


Ref: 5000.1 (HAC)/A/1 dated 20 Oct 95


1. Sector 4 assessment is as follows:

- a. There are now 797 orphans in four (4) orphanages in the Cyangugu Préfecture. The orphans in the best situation are from the Kamembe and Nyamasheke orphanages. In Nyamasheke orphanage all the children have beds. At the Kamembe orphanage, 1/3 of the children have to sleep on mattresses lying on the floor. In Rusayo and Kibogora orphanages the situation is much worse in terms of beds as the majority of the orphans sleep on mattresses lying on the floor.
- b. The lowest figure of blankets needed is approximately 200 but it should be noted that the children sleeping on the floor need two blankets: one to cover the mattress to keep out the humidity and the other to cover the child. Moreover, usually two children sleeping in a bed share the same blanket. For all children in the orphanages the standard should be two blankets per child, even for those sleeping in beds.

2. Therefore, if possible 500 blankets are needed to meet the present needs of the orphanages. During the distribution of the blankets all factors will be considered to ensure the most efficient allocation possible.



NO SMALL ARMS WERE REPORTED AS BEING FOUND HOWEVER THE RPA INDICATED THAT THE LEAD MAN HAD A GRENADE. THIS WAS SUBSEQUENTLY SHOWN TO THE PATROL (US M26 TYPE). WE DID NOT VIEW THIS GRENADE ON THE BODY BUT AT THE PATROL BASE. THE NAME OF THE DEAD MAN IS KABANOZA, REPORTEDLY A ZAIRIAN CITIZEN, A DISTANT RELATIVE OF MR UTUMWE YATUBWIYE WHO RESIDES WITHIN SITE OF THE BORDER ON THE RWANDAN SIDE. WHEN THE LOCALS WERE QUESTIONED AS TO HOW THEY KNOW SO MUCH ABOUT THIS INDIVIDUAL, HE STATED THAT IT WAS COMMON THAT THE BORDER VILLAGES EXCHANGED VISITS AND THAT INTERMARRIAGE WAS NOT UNCOMMON. THE RPA REPORTED THAT THEY HAD INFORMED THE ZAIRIAN AUTHORITIES TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR REMOVAL OF THE BODY BACK TO ZAIRE. ALSO PRESENT DURING OUR INVESTIGATION WERE TWO INDIVIDUALS FROM THE LOCAL PRESS. NO STATEMENTS WERE GIVEN BY UNAMIR PERSONNEL.


SUBJECT : IDENTIFICATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF WATER POINTS

1. A large number of natural springs are available in the hills of Rwanda and are being used by the local population for collection of drinking water. No water points presently exist at these springs, a number of them having been destroyed during the war. Presently the same places are being used for washing, bathing and collection of drinking water. This is leading to health and hygiene problems.

2. A requirement to construct a few simple water points across the country was considered and approved at the UHAAG meeting of 19 Sep 95. The project is to be undertaken by the contingents under the direction of the FEO and the Force Engineer Company. Each water point is to consist of a simple stone and cement receptacle for collection of clean water and a small steel pipe.


3. You are requested to identify and propose ten spring fed water points in each of your sectors. The proposals should reach HAC before 01 Oct 95.

SUBJECT: Terms of Reference for the CAO Appointed Representative on the HAC

As we discussed yesterday, the following are your terms of reference for all requests for humanitarian assistance. In general, surplus military labour and equipment time should be used to the extent possible. UNAMIR may have to reject requests based on these criterion, however I see no other options available to us at this time.

1. No equipment (vehicles, generators, computers) shall be handed over to any organization outside UNAMIR until there is a clear understanding of what the new mandate will include.
2. Any humanitarian task undertaken should be a one-time only event. Continued support to any organization is to be avoided.
3. Third line transport should be used only in emergency circumstances.
4. There is no provision in the budget for humanitarian water deliveries or septic tank pumping.
5. All government requests should come through the Minister of Planning.
6. Cargo space on UNAMIR's aircraft may be used, on a one-time basis, by humanitarian organizations with an urgent need for supplies, on a space-available, non-interference basis.


1. I was most enlightened to read the Briefing Notes provided under cover of ref. I now perhaps understand a little better the role of HAC and their liaison function with UN and NGO agencies. I would like to comment on the proposed organization as outlined in para 7.

2. As I understand the function, the HAC is a coordinating cell for humanitarian assistance. That being the case, the CHAO has at his disposal all the resources of UNAMIR to assist him in achieving his mission. For example, the SO Log and FEO are available to assist in the provision of logistics and engineering support. These staff officers have the resident expertise to support the HAC through the provision of advice, conduct of recces and assessment of resources required. I would disagree that the HAC need duplicate these functional staffs. As well, I question the need for 18 MILOBs in HAC Sectors. Why, quite simply, can the MILOB Sectors as established not take on this function on behalf of the HAC in the course of their normal duties and visits to communes?

3. I believe that we are starting to lose sight of the aim, which is natural enough given the major changes the force is undergoing. At the same time, I see the focus of UNAMIR as contributing to the reconstruction of the country and the humanitarian assistance where such can be made available. With limited resources, we cannot afford to continue to create new unwieldy structures which duplicate those currently in place. What is needed is the ability to gather information, process it and develop a workable solution. This is the function of the HQ and the Force at large. Humanitarian aid is but another aspect of the job which must be shared equally by all. If I am only half correct, then the HAC should be a small coordination cell within the HQ to which the central staffs and agencies work provide advice, assistance and ultimately action requests within the capabilities of UNAMIR.

4. Sorry to bang on so. I do think that the HAC and UHAAG satisfy a necessary need. The need is coordination of humanitarian aid and that should involve using the resources available within the existing structures, not through creating another hands on organization. As the UNAMIR Mandate has changed so must our approach. I think it goes without saying that our approach must be to maximize the resources of the staff, contingents and UNMOs to achieve the FC's aim.

2. This hospital has attempted to have this generator repaired or replaced through their normal administrative channels without success for the past one year. MSF and SDR are the NGO's which run this hospital.




The main hospital of the Prefecture of Kibuye, state owned Kibuye hospital, has been supported by SDR (a Swiss governmental organisation) for the last 9 months with expat surgical and nursing staff responsible for the departments of Surgery, Obstetrics/Gynecology and Radiology.

The generator now in place at this hospital has not been working most of the time and with its 16 KVA is too weak to allow simultaneous use of the X-ray machine and of the autoklave. We tried to get spare parts from Germany, but promised for months they unfortunately have still not arrived in Kibuye.

When, for many days during weeks electricity from the net was only available in the early morning hours, X-rays had to be taken at 5 a.m. and surgical instruments had to be autoclaved during the night shift. Sometimes, operations at night had to be done under an improvised light.

If a generator with 45 KVA and a silencer left behind by Unamir could be donated to that hospital, everybody there would do a deep sigh of relief for the patients including the Medical Director of the health region of Kibuye, Dr. Camille Munyangabe, representative of the Ministry of Health in Kibuye, whose official letter will follow. A Swiss technician arriving on November 6th could then take care of the technical installation.

1. As we agree this morning, I am to prepare this paper regarding the assistance of a local patient Mr JEAN CLAUDE UWIZEYE of 19 years old that need a cornea transplant like only chance to save his vision since he has a progressive illness.

2. His mother Ms Speciose MUTUYIMADA came to my office for assistance, mother of 5 and widow since 7 years ago, she has got the necessary money to carry out the surgery in Pretoria, Republic of South Africa but not to travel and live there for 2 months.

3. I explained to her that the only exceptional support from UNAMIR could be the travel from Kigali to Nairobi and back, but I started an immediate search asking for support from Embassies and NGOs. I had the tremendous happiness to find in the US Embassy a positive answer, they cannot bring aid to individuals because of the administrative restrictions but they got the humanitarian side of the problem like us and through an American Doctor, they found in Pretoria the person that offered the requested support to help the mother and the young man the necessary time. It was a wonderful answer.

4. The mother already sent the son to South Africa with a trader that came to Kigali some days ago, and actually the only need is about travel tickets for the lady from Nairobi to Johannesburg and back, and for the son from Johannesburg to Nairobi.

5. The estimated costs of the tickets is around US \$900 to US \$1000. We consulted the lower price in a Kenyan Agency.

6. Since many people spontaneously made efforts to save the vision of this Rwandan student and we are very near of a happy end, I am to request from SRSG an additional help about the above mentioned travel tickets that could be the final knot to tie and coordinate everything.
