

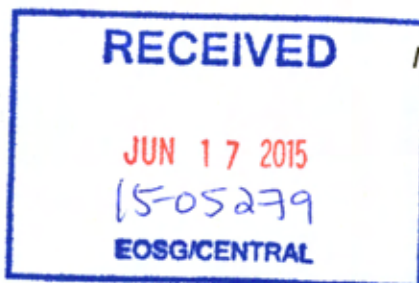



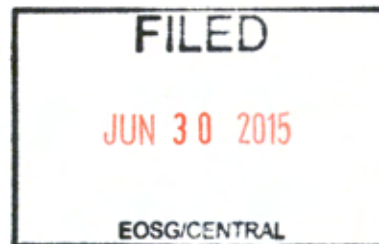
*I have the honour to address you in order to inform that the Government of Peru is nominating President Ollanta Humala for co-chairing the interactive dialogue on "Protecting our planet and combating climate change" to be held during the United Nations Summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda. The nomination has been formally submitted to the Latin American and the Caribbean Group, following-up on General Assembly's resolution 69/244.*

*The Peruvian nomination takes into account its current presidency of the Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP); the linkage of the latter with the post 2015 development agenda established by the proposal of Sustainable Development Goals through SDG13; and the consequent need to further build a momentum, along with the incoming Presidency of the COP, for an ambitious agreement to be reached in December 2015 in Paris, France, following-up on the Climate Summit organized by your Excellency in September 2014.*
